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The Stanton Roster, Surnames D Through J

This is the second segment of the roster of the Stanton Post of the Grand Army of the Republic. The Stanton Post was the gathering point of over 1800 Civil War veterans during its sixty-plus years of existence, and as such provides a central point for tracing the histories of these men.

The roster numbers in the left-hand column give clues about the order in which these men joined the post. The lower the number, the earlier the man joined. There were several cases in which a man apparently joined, left, came back and was assigned a second number. Unfortunately, the roster gives no explanation of why the second number was issued. The actual roster books include the date of joining the Stanton Post, and in many cases the date of death, as well as somewhat more detailed service information.

In the first segment, what was printed in *The Searcher* was raw data from a published roster from the 1920s, without corrections or annotations, other than a few obvious typographical errors which were corrected. In this second seg-

ment, what you will see is a portion of the roster after it has passed through a series of corrections and elaborations, based on other known information.

It was not uncommon on the rosters to find that men were listed by their last name and first initial, rather than by their full names. In order to make this list more useful for historians and genealogists, I have been comparing the names to such sources as the National Park Service roster of Civil War soldiers. While this is not absolutely perfect, it does have the advantage of listing soldiers by the name that the regimental paymasters used at the time. This has permitted me to fill in many of the missing first names, and to correct spelling and printing errors on several other names, or to provide alternate spellings. In several cases, the Army records indicate variant spellings of first or last name, and when possible, the final version of this roster will indicate those as well.

In this segment of the roster, text entered as *italics* is a correction or addition to the roster information as printed. Unfortunately, a few men are still mysteries. The National Park Service database is only useful for soldiers, and there is no comparable catalog of Civil War sailors. In addition, there are occasional holes in even the NPS database, as well as possible transcription errors on the original roster itself. Some of these have been identified by comparison of possible alternate spellings to the actual regimental rosters, but even this has failed to identify a few men. At this point, probably 98% of the soldiers can be identified on regimental rosters, but the verification of sailors remains uncertain.



membership file cards, and 3) two versions of a transcribed and printed roster that was prepared by the Woman's Relief Corps, the Auxiliary to the G.A.R.

The roster as you see it on the following pages is based primarily on the printed roster and the Descriptive Rolls, to create a unified master list of the membership. In many cases, a veteran's first name was omitted from the printed roster, or he was listed with only partial or incorrect service information. By comparing the printed roster to the handwritten version and to other sources, including the National Parks Service database, we are restoring as much of this data as possible.

There may be further corrections at a later date, but the version to be published here in *The Searcher* over the course of several issues includes information found to date for the listed men. We hope that this information will assist historians and genealogists trying to trace the paths of these Civil War veterans who made great contributions not only to their country but also to the development of Southern California.

Los Angeles, Orange, and San Diego county members of the Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War (SUVCW) have contributed over 500 hours of volunteer work to help inventory and package the material and artifacts of the

G.A.R. and its five Allied Orders in preparation for removal from the Hall during renovation. The Los Angeles County Public Works Department is in charge of the upgrade project, and historic preservation and conservancy consultants have been hired to aid in packaging and storage plans for the historic material.

The County contract also calls for selection of appropriate storage facilities for the material during the 3-year life of the project. The material will be accessible to the SUVCW during storage, and under its auspices some selected specimens may be made available for temporary exhibits at qualified museums or libraries. The long-term plan is to return the historic material to the renovated Hall.

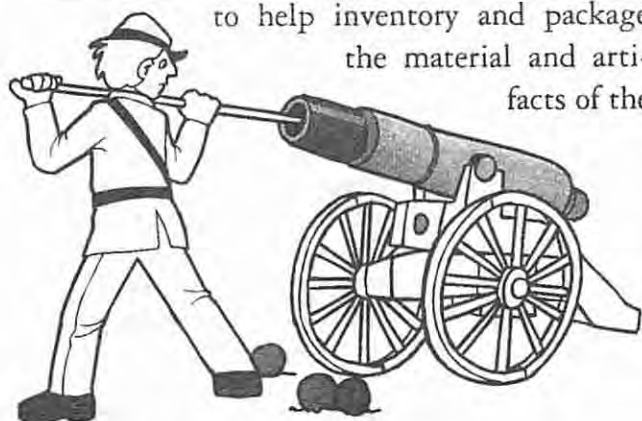

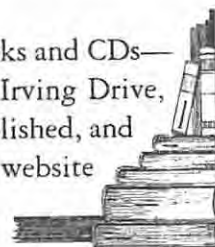

Research in England (Continued)

Parish Records are the most interesting and dating back to 1500. Henry VII established compulsory recording by law in 1535, mostly to determine the number of people in the Parish and therefore how much to pay the Minister. The Parish records included the Christening, Marriage and Burial data. These had a marked influence on the times. Many were recorded in Latin, but in 1733 law forbade this and records to be only in English. Both English script and Latin hard to read and may require help of libraries or consuls.

Gardner & Smith's Vol II, Chapter VIII covers this matter and also changes in the laws and record keeping in the Parishes to the 19th century. The actual information in the P. R. will vary by Ministers. Law did specify kind of data, so some only give name and dates, while others give more complete info on parents, sex, etc. In 1813 government issued a formal book for standardization of records, so complete thereafter. However not all P.R. are complete due to loss, damage weathering and even removal.

In 1831 a Parish Register Abstract was published listing all Parishes prior to 1813 and showing when started, time of no records, etc. On film at Salt Lake. Burke's "Key to Ancient Parishes" made up from the P.R. Abstract giving only a thumbnail sketch of the data. While P.R. are still kept, more accurate data from Vital Statistics after 1837 including more info. So don't request info from Parish minister that can be had elsewhere saving their time for exclusive data.

POST CEMETERY - BUILT IN 1849

"This United States Military Cemetery formerly part of the Benicia Military Arsenal is now under the jurisdiction of the Department of Defense & Interior. Gravestones date from the middle 1840's and in one corner are several graves of German and Italian prisoners from WWII."

Member Queen Berwald made inquiry to the Department of Defense & Interior as to the history of the above cemetery and also asked if there was a registry of the persons buried there available. One other question was: Why are so many listed on the gravestones as "U.S. Soldier Unknown"? Why were these men unknown? -- Below is the reply Queen received:

Dear Mrs. Berwald:

This is in response to your recent letter regarding the Benicia Arsenal Post Cemetery.

Benicia Arsenal Post Cemetery is one of 27 such cemeteries currently administered by the Department of the Army. The cemetery occupies one acre of land and contains the remains of 221 decedents. The first burial was 1st Lieutenant Charles E. Jarvis, 2nd United States Infantry on June 8, 1849. Enclosed for your information is a listing of the individuals buried in the cemetery. Considerable research concerning the cemetery was done in the National Archives, Office of the Chief of Military History, and the public library. Although there is material of record with reference to Benicia Arsenal, only this small amount of cemetery informatioin is documented.

During the Civil War and the years preceeding, soldiers who died on the battlefield, in General Hospitals, or as prisoners of war at or near Benicia Arsenal were originally interred near their place of death. Those graves, if marked at all, were marked with the name and identifying data painted on them. Many of those headboards deteriorated over time. Therefore, when the remains were later disinterred and reinterrred at Benicia Arsenal Post Cemetery, identification could not be made and these graves were marked as unknown.

Your interest in this matter is appreciated, and I trust this information will be of assistance.
