PIGEON RUN PRESBYTERIAN CEMETARY

Located one half mile from Red Lion, Delaware.
I first learned of this cemetery through reading "Little Known History of Newark, Delaware, and it's Environs", by Francis A. Cooch. I found an address for Mr. Cooch and went there. Mr. Cooch was deceased, but his widow was kind enough to try to help me. She suggested that I contact Alma Porter Johnston, who had gone on some of the excursions with them. I finally located Miss Johnston, who said she would try to help me find Pigeon Run Cemetery, altho it had been many years since she had been there. We drove from Newark, Delaware, toward Red Lion, when we got within one half mile of Red Lion, we stopped. Looking across the field to the right, we saw a woods, with tall trees. We crossed the field toward the woods, which was overrun with vines. Alma said to look for vines and flowers that may have grown wild, after having been placed on the graves. We pulled the vines away and found many tombstones. I am not sure that we saw all of them, but I copied those I could find. These inscriptions were copied by, Margaret (Miller) Murray, 1819 North Western Avenue, Los Angeles, California, a member of the Milly Barrett Chapter, Daughters of the American Revolution.
