JAMES R. JACKS, Pvt Co. K Regt 24 Inf, MISS, enlistment dates 16 Aug 1861 - Apr 1865, per FL pension file #6568. Born 14 Mar 1835 Fayette Co., TN, died 3 Apr 1915 Pasco Co., FL. Interred Anclote Cemetery Tarpon Springs, FL. Grave is marked. Married 5 Oct 1879 Lafayette Co., MS to .... (unknown).

ALBERT A. KEITH (Rev.), Pvt G 9<sup>th</sup> Regt Inf KY, enlistment dates 1 Nov 1861 - May 1865, per FL pension claim #6701 approved 8 Feb 1908 and widow's pension file #2864, 27 Dec 1928. Born 18 Oct 1843 Breckenridge Co., KY, died 27 Dec 1927 (where not shown). Interred Cycadia Cemetery, Tarpon Springs, FL. Grave is marked. Married 5 Aug 1871 Henderson Co., KY to ANNIE HAYNES .... (no further information).

A. S. LEACH, Capt Co E 21<sup>st</sup> Regt Inf, VA, enlistment dates unknown. Vol 12, "Confederate Veteran" shows Clerk of Circuit Court 1904, Muster Rolls of Rockingham Co., VA. Born ..?, died 25 Dec 1915 (where not shown). Interred in Cycadia Cemetery, Tarpon Springs, FL. Grave is marked. He was married but her name, and information not shown.

Born 20 Mar 1835, Todd County, KY, died 20 May 1903, Tarpon Springs, FL. Interred Cycadia Cemetery, Tarpon Springs, FL. Grave is not marked. Marriage information unknown.

JOHN A. SUTTON, Pvt. Munnerlyn's Battalion Vol Cav, FL, enlistment dates Jan 1864-Apr 1865, per widow's FL pension file #9987/6268, approved 22 Jan 1908. GEORGE D. WOOD, Pvt Co. B Regt 19 Inf AR., enlistment dates Nov 1861 - Apr 1865, per FL pension file #6326. Born 1834, Arkansas - died 12 Nov 1904 Ozona, Hillsborough Co., FL. Interred Curlew Creek United Methodist Church Cemetery, Palm Harbor, FL. Grave is marked. Married 28 Jul 1859 Howard Co., AR to MARGRET (sic) ELIZABETH ...(?), born 18 Jul 1840 Jefferson Co., AL. Died 1919.
