AND NOW, THE REST OF THE STORY .... That day in Quitman, was a great day! I had found many relatives in Mr. Huxford's "Pioneers of Wire Grass", and I also remembered my paternal grandmother saying her parents were from Quitman. So my late husband reluctantly agreed to a trip there.

There I located many deed records and wills by the ROGERS and DeVANES, including a gift deed of land to "the Primitive Baptist Church" from my g-g-grandfather Thomas F. ROGERS. I asked a man in the hall, who came out of the door to the Judge's office, where to check for location of this property. He turned out to be the Judge - Remer EDMONDSON - his office was across the hall - and he was related to me. He told me which office to go to and then said - "He will help you. He's kin to you, too."

Fuller PEDRICK wasn't in, but I received from a clerk a map plus the information, "The church is no longer in existence. The membership dwindled away so badly a few years back, that they united with a church here in town, but the cemetery is still there and is maintained." So I went back to the motel to get my husband, and met Kathleen REGISTER who was staying there, and had grown up in Quitman ... (yes, she was distantly related to me, too.) - and she volunteered to go with me to the cemetery. The road now goes very close to one side of the cemetery, and the church building with one side removed, has been moved across the road. The farmer who bought it uses it to store hay and farm machinery in.

It sure does pay to follow up on leads you locate in print and the things told to you long ago!
