DEATH ANNOUNCEMENTS

Greenwood Church of Christ, located in Lincoln County, was organized on January 27, 1798. The members met at the Greenwood Meeting House. Minutes of each meeting were kept in a handwritten book now on file in the office of the Superior Clerk in the Lincoln County Court House at Lincolnton, Georgia. The first book covers the years 1798 to 1880.
