



In the 1940's the United States Government purchased 280,000 acres of land in Southeastern Georgia, and created Fort Stewart Army Base. The Fort encompasses parts of Bryan, Evans, Liberty, Long and Tattnall Counties.

None of the towns and villages formerly located within this area are in existence today. lowever, forty-seven cemeteries have been left indisturbed scattered throughout remote areas n which military tactical maneuvers are now peing conducted, making public access to them lifficult.

CEMETERIES

I found myself interested in all areas of genealogy, but as the mother of two pre-school children I can't spend time visiting court-houses or researching in libraries without a baby sitter. Problem - how to keep my interest alive (and even help others if possible) without the sitter's expense? Solution - cemeteries.

Many cemeteries are completely fenced in, quiet and shaded, almost like a park for little ones to play in. In the middle of a large city cemetery my then two-year-old found some mallard ducks who had taken refuge there and spent her time talking to the waddling birds. She also talked to (and petted and hugged) the stone lambs sometimes found on children's tombstones. Smelling the flowers, pointing out flags and visiting the photographs some of the tombstones bear has also occupied her.

There are two approaches I can take towards a cemetery - research or copying.

Research can be for my own missing ancestor or I can do something for others (possibly in exchange for the research I need done at the courthouse or library), or a combination of the two.

Once while searching for someone's relative - who had no stone it was later discovered - I literally walked into my greatgrandfather's tombstone.

I can merely copy the desired information or go into more detail, such as making rubbings, taking pictures or even planting flowers for

people who are far from their neglected ancestors.

Copying can be for donation to a state or local library, archives or (as in my case) the State Cemetery Society, and/or for publication in a genealogical publication or separate booklet form as in the case of large cemeteries or all cemeteries in an area.

I find it easiest to start by making a map on a piece of graph paper with an X for each stone. Then I copy each stone exactly as written, one row at a time. A cemetery which is divided into sections is copied one or two sections per visit. I try to set aside one morning a week for the entire summer.

I carry a "cemetery kit" in the trunk, just in case. I once found a tombstone in someone's backyard while visiting their neighbor's rummage sale.

My kit includes chalk for hard to read stones, crayons and plain paper for rubbings, a notebook and pens for copying, graph paper for mapping out cemeteries, local map for location, a camera with film and copies of the local cemetery society's membership blanks for other researchers I meet.

I save the typing of the finished copy and the indexing till after the snow falls and our cemetery outings are over till next spring.

An added benefit of cemetery searching with children is while my Mom doesn't really care where her grandmother is buried, my girls have visited (and come to love and respect) their great-great-grandma.

The only drawback I've experienced is a little child who shouts "stones, stones!" everytime we pass a cemetery and expects to stop.

As a young man in Germany John Gottlieb WURST worked as a forester, cutting down trees and floating them down the Elbe River where they would be sold.

In 1872 he got a job as a blacksmith on a ship going to America. After landing in New York, he decided to stay. He found a job in Pittsburg, PA. at a steel mill and boarded with the RUPP family. That is where he met and married Rosine. They moved to Thomas County, Georgia in 1879 out in the country north of Ochlocknee where he became a farmer.


