This is William Akins, who was living in East Armuchee in 1860 with a farm of 160 acres valued at \$300 and \$1,850 personal property; his age in 1860 was stated as 34.

Altom, J. D., 38 yrs., Tanner, b. Greenville Dist., SC; Exemption: Tanner

Bolt, John, 17 yrs., Farmer, b. Walker Co., GA

J. W. Bolt is buried in the White Cemetery (Walker County Cemeteries, Vol. 2, p. 72)

Burke, W. H., 17 yrs. 9 mos., Farmer, b. Hamilton Co., TN

Cannon, J. M., 30 yrs., Farmer, b. Spartanburg Dist., SC; Exemption: Substitute

This is John Madison Cannon, who was farming in East Armuchee in 1860 with no stated land holdings or personal property; in 1860 his age was given as 26. John Madison Cannon (1832-1880) is buried in the Talley Cemetery (Walker County Cemeteries, Vol. 1, p. 47)

Cape, John, 47 yrs., Farmer, b. Elbert Co., GA

Carpenter, John, 45 yrs., Blacksmith, b. Lincoln Co., NC

John T. Carpenter (1823-1895) is buried in the Old Bethlehem Cemetery.

Catlett, L. A., 47 yrs., Farmer, b. Franklin Co., GA

This should be Lanson A. Cattlett, who was living in East Armuchee in 1860 with no stated land holdings and \$75 in personal property; his age, however, was given in 1860 as 38 and his birth place was stated to have been South Carolina instead of Georgia.

Cavender, J. H., 51 yrs., Farmer, b. Jackson Co., GA

This is John H. Cavender, who was in East Armuchee in 1860 with a farm of 600 acres valued at \$5,000 and \$1,050 in personal property; his age was given as 48 in 1860; he was also in Walker County, GA in 1850, 1870 and 1880. J. H. Cavender (1812-1879) is buried in the Ben Hill Pope Cemetery.

Clements, A. C., 25 yrs., Farmer, b. Walker Co., GA; Exemption: Disability

This is Adolphus C. Clements, who was living in the household of his father Adam Clements in East Armuchee in 1860. Adolphus C. Clements (1839-1912) is buried in the Macedonia Cemetery.

Clements, W. F., 38 yrs., Farmer, b. Spartanburg Dist., SC; Exemption: Disability

Cudd (Cadd), Carter, 46 yrs., Farmer, b. SC

This is Carter C. Cud, who was living in East Armuchee in 1860 with a farm of 160 acres valued at [\$1,000] and \$400 personal property; his age in 1860 was given as 40; he was also in Walker County, GA

Cudd (Cadd), J. T., 17 yrs., Farmer, b. Cobb Co., GA

This is John T. Cud, who was living in the household of his father Carter C. Cud in East Armuchee in 1860; in 1860 his age was given as 13.

Davis, J. N., 17 yrs., Farmer, Birthplace not shown

This is John N. Davis, a son of Adam Davis, who was living in 1860 in East Armuchee in his father's household; his age was stated in 1850 as 3 and in 1860 as 12.

Evans, Elijah, 43 yrs., Shoemaker, b. Anderson Dist., SC; Exemption: Disability

This is Elijah Evans, who was living in 1860 in East Armuchee with no stated land holdings and \$300 personal property; his age was stated as 34 in 1860, and his occupation was given as shoemaker.

Fisher, John, 56 yrs., Farmer, b. Lincoln Co., GA

This should be John Fisher, who was living in 1860 in East Armuchee with no stated land holdings and \$300 personal property, except that his birthplace was stated as NC instead of GA in 1860; his age was stated as 52 in 1860.

Goodson, Jacob, 57 yrs., Farmer, Birthplace not shown

This is Jacob Goodson, who was living in 1860 in East Armuchee with a farm of 240 acres valued at \$2,000 and \$500 personal property; his age in 1860 was given as 54; he was also in Walker County, GA in 1840, 1850 and 1870. Jacob Goodson (1805-1882) is buried in the Goodson Cemetery.

Griffin, Jesse, Jr., 20 yrs., Farmer, b. Walker Co., GA; Exemption: Disability

This is Jesse Griffin, Jr., a son of Jesse Griffin, who was living in 1860 in East Armuchee in the household of his father; his age was given in 1850 as 7 but incorrectly given in 1860 as 7, a mistake this militia census helps to correct. Jesse D. Griffin (1843-1915) is buried in the White Cemetery.

1864 Griffin, Thos., 47 yrs., Farmer, b. Union Dist., SC

This is Thomas Griffin, who was living in 1860 in East Armuchee with a farm of 320 acres valued at \$1,000 and \$300 personal property; his age in 1860 was stated as 43. Thomas Griffin (1817-1894) is buried in the Concord Cemetery.

Griffin, W. H., 17 yrs., Farmer, b. Walker Co., GA

Gunn, E. C., 59 yrs., Carpenter, b. Iredell Co., NC

Gunn, W. W., 17 yrs., Miller, b. Iredell Co., NC

Guyer, J. G., 16 yrs., Farmer, b. Union Co., GA

This is John G. Guyer, a son of William Guyer, who was living in 1860 in East Armuchee in the household of his father; his age in 1860 was stated as 14.

Guyer, Wm., 50 yrs., Farmer, b. Burke Co., NC

This is William Guyer, who was living in 1860 in East Armuchee with no stated land holdings and \$100 personal property; his age in 1860 was stated as 47; he was also in Walker County, GA in 1850.

Hammontree, W. N., 22 yrs., Farmer, b. Walker Co., GA; Exemption: Disability

This should be William M. Hammontree, who was living in East Armuchee in 1860 with his parents Harris and Sarah Hammontree; in 1860 his age was given as 20.

Harris, N., 16 yrs., Farmer, b. Walker Co., GA

This is John Heffner, who was living in East Armuchee in 1860 with a farm of 220 acres valued at \$1,600 and \$600 in personal property; in 1860 his age was given as 44; he was also in Walker County, GA in 1850, 1870 and 1880. John Heffner (1816-1905) is buried in the Pocket Cemetery.

Hunt, L. W., 16 yrs., Farmer, b. Walker Co., GA

This is Louis W. Hunt, a son of Benjamin Franklin Hunt, who was living in 1860 in East Armuchee in the household of his father; his age in 1860 was stated as 12.

Jones, R. A., 42 yrs., Blacksmith, b. Rutherford Co., NC; Exemption: Blacksmith

This is Robert A. Jones, who was living in East Armuchee in 1860 with no stated land holdings and no stated personal property; his age in 1860 was stated as 38. R. A. Jones (1821-1898) is buried in the Woodstation Methodist Church Cemetery.

Knnymore, N., 50 yrs., Farmer, b. Pendleton Dist., SC

This is Needham Kinneman, who was living in East Armuchee in 1860 with a farm of 80 acres valued at \$300.

Kimsey, D. J., 16 yrs., Farmer, b. Cherokee Co., GA

Kimsey, R.C., 43 yrs., Blacksmith, b. Blount Co., AL; Exemption: Blacksmith

This is Roland Cornelius Kinsey, who was living in East Armuchee in 1860 with no stated land holdings and \$250 personal property; his age was listed as 39 in 1860; he was also in Walker County, GA in 1840, 1850, 1870 and 1880. R. C. Kinsey (1820-1904) is buried in the Old Ben Hill Pope Cemetery.

Little, Q., 16 yrs., Farmer, b. Walker Co., GA

Love, J. R., 19 yrs., Tanner, b. Gilmer Co., GA; Exemption: Tanner

Jasper Love (1851-1907) is buried in the Macedonia Cemetery.

Lowery, A.T., 49 yrs., Farmer, b. TN

Lowery, H. T., 16 yrs., Farmer, b. Walker Co., GA

Martin, A. J., 17 yrs., Farmer, b. Floyd Co., GA

Miller, B., 50 yrs., Farmer, b. Laurens, SC

Miller, I., 31 yrs., Farmer, b. Forsyth Co., GA; Exemption: Disability

Odom, J. M., 46 yrs., Farmer, b. Edgefield, SC

Owensby, D. M., 43 yrs., Laborer, b. Lumpkin Co., GA; Exempt: Contract for wood for W & A RR

This should be David M. Owenby, but both the 1850 and 1860 Censuses state that he was born in North Carolina, not Georgia.

Phillips, E.C., 52 yrs., Farmer, b. Sullivan Co., TN

Pope. M., 55 yrs., Farmer, b. Edgecomb Co., NC

This is Micajah Pope, who was living in East Armuchee in 1860 with a farm of 533 acres valued at \$7,000 and \$11,000 in personal property including 10 slaves; in 1860 his age was given as 52; he was also in Walker County, GA in 1850.

Price, D. N., 17 yrs., Farmer, b. Walker Co., GA

Daniel N. Price (1846-1920) is buried in Concord Methodist Cemetery.

Puryear, A. S., 52 yrs., Farmer, b. Greenville Dist., SC

Puryear, John, 43 yrs., Farmer, b. Clarke Co., GA; Exemption: Justice of Peace

This is John Puryear, who was living in East Armuchee in 1860 with a farm of 310 acres valued at \$2,000 and \$5,650 in personal property including 2 slaves; in 1860 his age was given as 38; he was also in Walker County, GA in 1850, 1870 and 1880. John Puryear (1822-1907) is buried in the Puryear Cemetery.

Richardson, J. R., 30 yrs., Farmer, b. Spartanburg Dist., SC; Exemption: Disability

This is probably James Richerson, who was living in East Armuchee in 1860 with no stated land holding and \$500 in personal property. J. R. Richardson (1841-1908) is buried in Armuchee Cemetery.

Roach, W. H., 30 yrs., Farmer, b. Anderson Dist., SC; Exemption: Disability

Roberson, Jos., 30 yrs., Farmer, b. Murray Co., GA; Exemption: Disability

This is almost certainly Joseph Roberson, who in 1860 was living in the Spencer Bomar household in West Armuchee as a hatter and boarder; in 1860 his age was given as 30; he married Mary M. Bomar. J. Roberson (1831-1904) is buried in the McWilliams Cemetery.

Roland, J. H., 47 yrs., Farmer, b. Pulaski Co., GA

Roland, W. S., 17 yrs., Farmer, b. Columbia Co., GA

Sampson, F. M., 24 yrs., Farmer, b. Habersham Co., GA; Exemption: Disability

This is Francis M. Sampson, who was living in East Armuchee in 1860 with his mother Catherine Sampson, who had a farm of 40 acres valued at \$400; in 1860 his age was given as 22; he was also in Walker County, GA in 1870.

Shahon., J. H., 16 yrs., Farmer, b. Sevier Co., TN

James Alexander Shahan (1846-1929) is buried in Macedonia Cemetery.

Sprayberry, W. L., 26 yrs., Farmer, b. DeKalb Co., GA; Exemption: Disability

A son of W. L. Sprayberry is buried in the Wesley Chapel Cemetery.

St. Johns, James, 50 yrs., Farmer, b. Union Dist., SC

This is Riley Stansell, who was living in East Armuchee in 1860 with a farm of 1,062 acres valued at \$3,460; in 1860 his age was given as 47; he was also in Walker County, GA in 1840 and 1850. Rial Stansell (1814-1886) is buried in the White Cemetery.

Stowe, Wm., 55 yrs., Farmer, b. Franklin Co., GA

William M. Stowe (1810-1898) is buried in the Old Bethlehem Cemetery.

Tate, A., 48 yrs., Farmer, b. Pendleton Dist., SC

This is Andrew Tate, who was living in East Armuchee in 1860 with no stated land holdings and \$200 in personal property; in 1860 his age was given as 45.

Tate, C. N., 18 yrs., Farmer, b. Anderson Dist., SC; Exemption: Disability

This is Columbus M. Tate, a son of John Andrew Tate, who was living with his parents in 1860, when his age was given as 15. Columbus M. Tate (1844-1877) is buried in Concord Cemetery.

Tate, John, 59 yrs., Farmer, b. Anderson Dist., SC

This is John Andrew Tate, who was living in East Armuchee in 1860 with a farm of 358 acres valued at \$3,000; in 1860 his age was given as 55; he was also in Walker County, GA in 1870 and 1880. John Andrew Tate is buried in Concord Cemetery.

Tate, J.W. N., 16 yrs., Farmer, b. Anderson Dist., SC

This is Jesse W. N. Tate, a son of John Andrew Tate, who was living with his parents in 1860, when his age was given as 13.

Trapp, Albert, 28 yrs., Farmer, Birthplace not shown; Exemption: Disability

Treadaway, J. M., 20 yrs., Hatter, b. Chattooga Co., GA; Exemption: Hatter

Treadaway, Wm., 40 yrs., Farmer, b. Hall Co., GA

Vandever, J. A., 16 yrs., Farmer, b. Elbert Co., GA

This is John A. Vanderver, a son of Lorenzo D. Vanderver, whose age was given as 14 in 1860. His father owned a farm of 170 acres valued at \$1,000 and personal property valued at \$600.

Vick, Yancy, 48 yrs., Farmer, b. Abbeville Dist., SC

This is Yancey Vick, a son of Howell Vick, who was living in East Armuchee in 1860 with no land holdings and no stated personal property; in 1860 his age was given as 45; he was also in Walker County, GA in 1850.

Warnock, A.J., 48 yrs., Farmer, b. Abbeville Dist., SC

This is A. J. Warnock, who was living in East Armuchee in 1860 with a farm of 125 acres valued at \$2,000 and \$1,200 in personal property; in 1860 his age was given as 44; he was also in Walker County, GA in 1850. His son John A. Warnock died in Atlanta on 18 May 1862 while a member of Company K of the 39th Regiment Georgia Volunteer Infantry.

Warnock, C. N., 16 yrs. 2 mos., Farmer, b. Cobb Co., GA

This is Charles N. Warnock, a son of A. J. Warnock, whose age was given in 1860 as 12; he was also in Walker County, GA in 1850.

White, J. E., 35 yrs., Farmer, b. Anderson Dist., SC; Exemption: Disability

This is James Elijah White, who was living in East Armuchee in 1860 with \$300 in real estate and \$200 in personal property.

White. W., 45 yrs., Farmer, b. Anderson Dist., SC

This should be William White, who was living East Armuchee in 1860 with a farm of 200 acres valued at \$1,200 and \$400 in personal property, but his age was given in 1860 as 37 and in 1850 as 29; he was also in Walker County, GA in 1840 and 1850.

Willbanks. W. H., 31 yrs., Physician: Birthplace not shown; Exemption: Physician

This is William Henry Willbanks, who was living in East Armuchee in 1860 with a farm of 80 acres valued at \$800 and one slave among his personal property of \$1,800; in 1860 his age was given as 28; in 1850 he was living with his parents in Chattooga County, GA.

Williams, George, 16 yrs., Farmer, b. Gilmer Co., GA

George E. D. Williams (1850-1911) is buried in Rock Spring Cemetery.

Wood, C., 58 yrs., Farmer, b. Spartanburg Dist., SC

This is Constantine Wood, who was living in East Armuchee in 1860 with a farm of 660 acres valued at \$5,500 and 7 slaves among his personal property of \$10,700; in 1860 his age was given as 54 years; he had also been in Walker County, GA in 1840 and 1850.

This is probably Ira L. Bennett, who was living in West Armuchee in 1860, with a farm of 160 acres worth \$2,000.

Berges, W. G., 17 yrs., Farmer, b. Walker Co., GA

This is William G. Burgess, a son of William Burgess, who was living in his father's household in 1860

Berges, Wm., 50 yrs., Farmer, b. Lawrence Co., KY

This is William Burgess, who was living in West Armuchee in 1860, with a farm of 220 acres worth \$2,500; in 1860 his age had been given as 48

Bomar, Spencer, 53 yrs., Farmer, b. Spartanburg Dist., SC

This is Spencer Bomar, who was living in West Armuchee in 1860, with a farm of 480 acres worth \$6,000; he owned 2 slaves in 1860 and had also been in Walker County, GA in 1850; he may have been in Walker County, GA in 1840

Cargill, John, 54 yrs., Farmer, b. Spartanburg Dist., SC

WALKER COUNTY, GEORGIA 1864 CENSUS

This is John Cargall, who was living in West Armuchee in 1860 with \$150 in personal property; in 1860 his age was given as 50

Carr., N. F., 45 yrs., Farmer, b. Marshall Co., TN

Carter, Benj., 38 yrs., Shoemaker, b. Spartanburg Dist., SC; Exemption: Shoemaker

This is Benjamin C. Carter, who was living in West Armuchee in 1860 with a young wife; his age was given as 33 in 1860, and his occupation was given as Shoemaker

Cleckler, Jacob, 57 yrs., Farmer, B. Putnam Co., GA

This is Jacob Cleckler, who was living in West Armuchee in 1860 with a farm of 400 acres worth \$5,000; his age was given as 53 in 1860

Cleveland, Jerry, 48 yrs., Farmer, B. Greenville Dist., SC

Cox, Robert, no information

Glasener (not given), no information

This is probably Stephen Glazener, who was living in West Armuchee in 1860 with no stated land holdings but 9 slaves

Huggins, Joseph, 16 hrs., Farmer, b. Walker Co., GA

Keeling, Pryor, 42 yrs., Mail Contractor, b. Orange Co., NC; Exempt: Mail Contractor

This is probably Price Keeling, who was living in West Armuchee in 1860 with a farm of 67 acres worth \$350; his age was given as 38 in 1860

Kilpatrick, A., 52 yrs, Farmer, b. Rutherford Co., NC

This is Alexander Kilpatrick, who was living in West Armuchee in 1860 with no stated land holdings and \$300 in personal property

Lanier, J. M. 17 yrs., Farmer, B. Chattooga Co., GA

Masteller, George, 53 yrs, Millwright, b. Lincoln Co., NC

He was not living in either East Armuchee or West Armuchee in 1860.

Masteller, J. O., 18 yrs, Miller, b. Lincoln Co., NC; Exemption: Miller

He was not living in either East Armuchee or West Armuchee in 1860.

McWilliams, G. W., 50 yrs., Farmer, b. Spartanburg Dist., SC

This is George W. McWilliams, who was living in West Armuchee in 1860 with a farm of 320 acres worth \$2,200; his age was given as 46 in 1860; he was also living in Walker County, GA in 1850 and probably living in Walker County, GA in 1840. George W. McWilliams (1815-1884) is buried in the McWilliams Cemetery.

McWilliams, H.C. 16 yrs., Farmer, B. Walker Co., GA

This is probably Harvey C. McWilliams, a son of George W. McWilliams, who was listed in 1860 as 13 years of age. H. C. McWilliams (1847-1913) is buried in the McWilliams Cemetery.

McWilliams, W., 46 yrs, Farmer, b. Spartanburg Dist., SC

WALKER COUNTY, GEORGIA 1864 CENSUS

This is probably William McWilliams, who was living in West Armuchee in 1860 with a farm of 240 acres worth \$3,000; his age was given as 40 in 1860, so there is a significant age discrepancy. William McWilliams (1818-1878) is buried in the McWilliams Cemetery.

Neal, J. B., 21 yrs, Farmer, b. Walker Co., GA; Exemption: Disability

This is Joseph Benson Neal, who was living in 1860 in the household of his mother Rebecca Pickens Neal in West Armuchee; in 1860 his age was given as 17; he was also in Walker County, GA in 1850.

O'Neal, T. A. 35 yrs, Shoemaker, b. Telfair Co., GA; Exemption: Shoemaker

Patterson, Robert, 58 yrs, 4 mos., Farmer, b. York Dist., SC

This is Robert Patterson, who was living in East Armuchee in 1860 with a a farm of 230 acres valued at \$2,250 and \$1,500 in personal property; his age was given as 54 in 1860; he was also in Walker County, GA in 1850.

Patterson, W. L., 25 yrs, Farmer, b. Monroe Co., TN; Exemption: Disability

This is William L. Patterson, a son of Robert Patterson who was living in his father's household in East Armuchee in 1860.

Ponder, T. J., 52 yrs, Farmer, b. Greenville Distr., SC

This is Thomas Jefferson Ponder, who was living in East Armuchee in 1860 with a farm of 160 acres valued at \$1,800 and \$10,255 in personal property including 8 slaves; in 1860 his age was given as 48; he was also in Walker County, GA in 1850 and 1870. T. J. Ponder (1811-1873) is buried in the Talley Cemetery.

Ray, W. T. 47 yrs, Miller, b. Henry Co., VA

Reeves, L., 49 yrs., Farmer, b. Gwinnett Go., GA

Tweedell, A. W. H., 50 yrs, Farmer, b. Clarke Co., GA

"Be it further enacted, that in making the enrollment provided for by this act, the enrolling officers shall report by name all persons having efficient guns, describing the gun, whether rifle, musket, or shot-gun, and those who have not; also such persons who can furnish their own horses, saddles and bridles, and serve as mounted men."

The Joe Brown Census, Walker County, 1863

A special census of the 953rd and 1053rd Districts, Walker County, 1863.
Contributed by Robert S. Davis, Jr

As Georgia faced invasion in 1863, the state government ordered a census of all men old enough for military duty but not serving in the Confederate or state forces. Known as the " Joe Brown Census" (after Georgia's Civil War governor) and as the militia enrollment list, these records have NOT survived for Burke,Catoosa,Chattooga,Dade,Dooly, Emanuel, Irwin, Johnson, Laurens, Montgomery, Pulaski, Telfair, and Wilcox counties. Of the other counties, except for Bulloch County, place of birth is given-- that is at least the state of Butts, Calhoun, Cherokee, Clarke, Fayette, Floyd, Forsyth, Franklin, Gordon, Gwinnett, Habersham, Henry, Milton, Murray, Newton, Stewart, Thomas, Walker, Walton,Warren and Whitfield counties, however, county of birth is also often given.

These records are on microfilm at the Georgia Archives and indexed in their Alphabetical Card File to the Confederate Pension Office (also on Microfilm). Reproduced below is the genealogical information from what has survived of the list of Walker County.

Also included in this record, but not given below, is information on weapons and horses.


