course having carried off their dead and disposed of them in some manner. It was universally believed that there was quite a number of Indians killed, and this one they missed by some means.

We now made our selection of a burying ground believing as we did, that we had recovered all our dead. The location was on the south side of Old Man's creek, to the distance of 300 yards, and close to the camp ground of Major Stillman. The wagons conveying the dead were ordered to this spot. the bodies were all placed side by side upon the carpet prepared by nature. Each one was recognized, but oh, in what condition. Could but a loving mother, father or sister have seen their horrid appearance, how their hearts would have sank within them, and such a wail as would have melted a heart of stone. It was well enough that such a sickening sight is never brought to their gaze, for there was stout hearts that Quailed and sickened at this sight, and tears flowed like rain over our comrades who had so woefully become the victims of an infuriated and inhuman foe.

No pen can describe their mad fury. Each man that was totally rid of garments was wrapped in tent cloth and a trench 15 feet long, 7 feet wide and 5-6 feed deep was dug for them. They were carefully placed side by side in the long trench, a tenting thrown over their bodies and the dirt deposited upon them. Poor fellows, a much better funeral did they deserve, but was beyond our feeble power to grant.

We placed a board with each man's name at the head, and this concluded the funeral obsequies of our comrades in the far wild west. no father, mother sister or brother could have the consolation of kneeling in prayer over the grave of him that was so dear in life, and alone their bones were allowed to moulder into dust, and ere this, no doubt, not a sign or vistage remains to mark the spot.

We will now cast a glance at our army and conclude our Black Hawk war experience. While the burying of the dead was going on, a spy company was sent north to find out if three were any Indians in the locality. They penetrated to the distance of 3 or 4 miles, but found no signs, only what they supposed had been done on the evening of the disaster. They reported finding Major Hackleton's horse [as spoken of previously], but the Indian he had killed was gone, which proves conclusively that the Indians hide their dead.

We now made our encampment on the same rising ground where we buried our dead, but about 300 yards west. Our baggage wagons had all been left at Dixon's and having no tents, we were compelled to dump our saddles and haversacks on the ground where our tents ought to be, and turn our horses to the graze. Every Captain now called his roll. This was to ascertain if we had any men courageous enough to fight if the Indians should make war upon us before morning, as they had Major Stillman, and it was fully believed they would. It was commanded and I believe obeyed, that every captain

should give an exhortation to his men, to bouy and nerve them up to the probable task of fighting the blood thirsty foe. at any rate our captain made quite a lengthy speech, he called his men about him and briefly explained the cause of our sudden march to the present spot, stating the cause of civilization and humanity demanded it, that it was scarcely necessary for any explanations to an enlightened people, that the experience of the day was a better explanation than all the combined words of eloquence and the English language could frame, and he asked them if they could view the bodies of their mutilated comrades, butchered, and disfigured in so horrid a manner, without feeling the hot blood of revenge leaping in every vein.......to be continued...

## THINGS I REMEMBER GOING THROUGH LIFE

Tales of long ago.......These stories I remember my father [David Oscar Howell] told of his childhood and on through his life..

Continued from last newsletter......

One day Dad and Uncle Jim and Leslie went duck hunting across the river in a boat. It came up a bad storm and the river was really rough. Dad tied the decoys around Leslie, he wasn't but 10 years old. They made it back to the Locks okay, but that was the day two brothers drown. That was approximately 1908.

When Dad was working at the livery stable, they sent him to Virginia, Illinois with 7 head of horses. He rode one and led 6. It must have been in the spring of the year, for when he got over by Beardstown there was ice over the road in one place. The mare he was riding was shod, but the others were barefoot. He gave a boy some money to whip the ones he was leading to make them cross (the ice). He came back on the train. He took one train to Jacksonville, then changed and came to Mt. Sterling.

One night they had him take the Catholic Priest out north of town to see someone that was dying. On the way back it came up a bad storm. I guess the Priest thought they were going to be killed. He looked at Dad and said, "I'm prepared, how about you?" Dad looked him in the eye and said "I'll take mine as it comes." Dad didn't go to church much, but he read his Bible.

They sent him to Perry with a load of kerosene one day when the roads were muddy. He wanted 4 head of horses, but they said they didn't have them to spare. He got about half way up the Gerrish Hill and one horse balked. An old man came by with a little gray team and said "I think my team can pull it if my harness will hold." He pulled it to the top of the hill for Dad. Went okay until the next hill. He stopped to give the horses a rest. When he released the brake the horse threw his head over the other horse and wouldn't pull. With those oil wagons you set almost over your team. Dad said he had a good whip and wasn't very careful where he hit him. He accidently hit him in the eye. That put the go to him. The next morning the eye was swelled shut and the boss wanted to know what happened? Dad told him and he didn't like it. Dad said, "I would rather have a blind horse than a balky one." The eye got okay. After that when that horse would balk in town, they would send for Dad and all he had to do was pick up the lines and the horse would pull!

There was one horse there at the barn when he lost a shoe all you had to do was turn him loose and he would go to the blacksmith shop. I guess back then they would have certain days to buy horses. Dad tole of one day when an old farmer brought in a nice young mare and all the buyers tried to buy her. He wanted a certain price and wouldn't jew. Two or three buyers got together and decided to take him up to the saloon and buy him a few drinks and maybe he would deal. They all bought a round and one of them taped him on the shoulder and said "Now how much for the little brown chunk?" He says, "Just the same as before I drank your D-- Whiskey."

Doug Vermillion ran a livery barn and traded horses. One day he and another trader were having a few drinks and talking over old times. This one says "Doug, remember the first time we traded horses and I let a little water in your boat?" Doug says "yes, and well you remember the next time we traded horses I came near sinking the whole D- Navy!"

Quite a few of you remember Red Langdon what used to drive for Dr. R.C. McGann back in the 1930's and 40's. When he was just a kid he used to hang around the barn a lot. I don't know what he did, but Pete Peterson tied him in a gunny sack and took him out back of the livery and threw him on the manure pile. I doubt if one could get away with doing that now!
