P R E F A C E

This booklet has been compiled to aid researchers in locating cemeteries in Lake County, Illinois. The number preceding a cemetery name indicates the location of the cemetery on the map. The date in parenthesis (1847) following a cemetery name is the date of incorporation or the date of the earliest burial. For the benefit of those whose ancestors lived near the county line, we have included the cemeteries which lie within approximately two miles of the county line in the three adjacent counties.

An asterisk * following some cemetery names indicates that that cemetery has been read. Two asterisks ** indicates a cemetery was read about twenty years ago and the Society has a copy of the list in its files. These old lists are being rechecked and up-dated before being published. Any reference to milage is only an estimate and all legal descriptions (T42N/R10E) are from the Third Principal Maridian.

The Cemetery Committee continues to read more cemeteries as time and weather permit. As all the cemeteries in any given township are read, the list of inscriptions for those cemeteries will be published in one volume. GRANT TOWNSHIP CEMETERY INSCRIPTIONS and FREMONT TOWNSHIP CEMETERY INSCRIPTIONS will be the first two books published and will be available in the fall of 1980.

LOST LAKE COUNTY CEMETERIES

In the early days of the county some families buried their dead in small plots on their own farms. The majority of these have disappeared over the years although a few still exist. In some cases bodies were later moved to a larger cemetery. In a few instances whole cemeteries were moved to a new location.

The information in this section was obtained from a variety of sources; old county plat maps, county histories and directories and a series of unpublished history essays written in 1918 by the school children all over the county for the Illinois Centennial celebration. These essays are known as the "School Histories" but are really a history of the township in which each school was located and neighborhood of the students attending that school.

55 of these "School Histories" can be found in the Lake County Museum Library. The information in them was gathered by the students by interviewing elderly residents and decendents of early settlers in their immediately area.

If anyone knows of any cemetery not mentioned in this list, the Cemetery Committee would like very much to hear about it.

ANTIOCH Township (East)
