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ALLEN'S GROVE CEMETERY, located in Section 8, directly opposite St. Luke's Lutheran Church. It is maintained by the township. Many Allen's Grove families utilize cemeteries in adjoining townships. The principal cemetery for San Jose is located southeast of town in adjacent Logan County.
