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THE WAR OF 1812 BURIALS IN MCLEAN COUNTY

McLean County Genealogical Society board member, Sara Cushing compiled a list of War of 1812 veterans who are buried in McLean County cemeteries. In addition to the information shown below, the full database contains (when known) the cemetery, grave, lot number, block, section, and head stone. The entire database will be made available at mcgs.org.

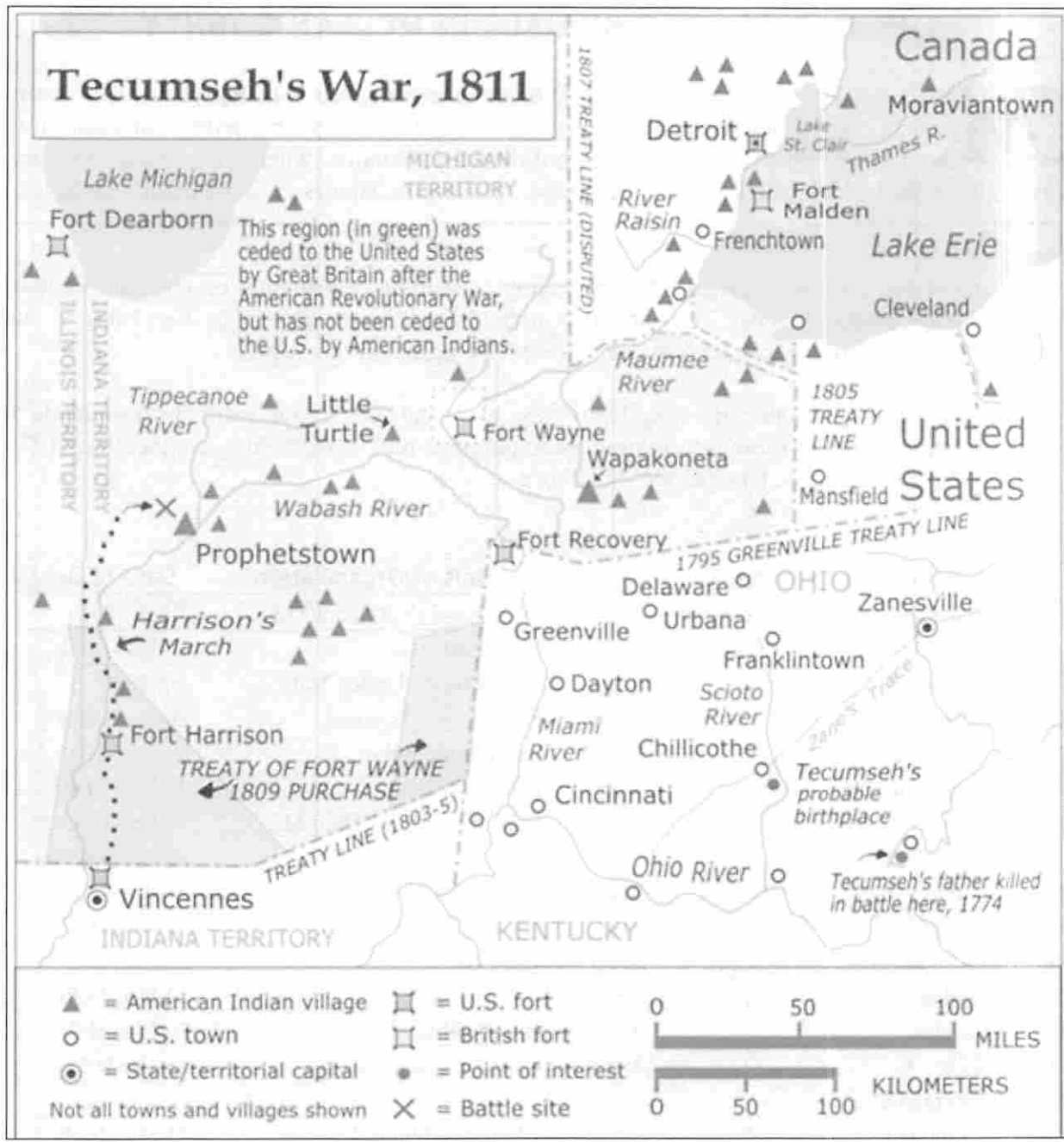

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THE ILLINOIS NINETY-FOURTH INFANTRY REGIMENT

COMPANY D

The 94th Infantry Regiment was made up of McLean County residents and was called the "McLean Regiment". The county gave each enlisted man a bounty of \$50 and presented the Regiment with a flag which cost \$500. There were 945 men at muster-in and 149 joined later, making a total of 1,094. Eleven men were killed in battle, 45 were wounded, 157 died and 164 were discharged. Colonel McNulta had command of the regiment for almost its entire term of service.

Following is the information contained in the Illinois Adjutant General's Report for those listed in the foregoing clothing issue. The town shown is the "Residence". Unless otherwise indicated, all enlisted between 3 and 20 Aug 1862 (inclusive), and were mustered out with the Regiment 17 Jul 1865.

William VanGundy, Padua, enlisted as 2nd Lieut. 20 Aug 1862; was promoted to 1st Lieut. 1 Dec 1862; and resigned to date 2 Sep 1863.

P. W. Bishop, Cpl., "Tonawanda"; discharged 7 Sep 1863 as Sgt. to accept commission in 37th Illinois.

James Butler, 1st Sgt., Bloomington; was promoted to 2nd Lieut. 1 Dec 1862 and to 1st Lieut. 2 Sep 1863.

George Yost, Sgt., Padua.

R. Krum, Sgt., Padua; was discharged 27 Jan 1865 because of disability.

Wm. A. Arrowsmith, Sgt., Padua.
