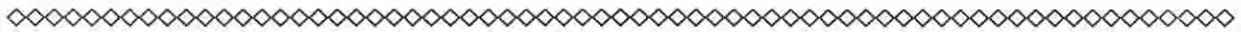

Jim Byrne's Genealogy Tips

Tip #1

Load a bibliography of research Websites and print resources on a flash drive and take it on research trips. Flash drives are small enough to fit a small pocket and inexpensive. With one, you can take the equivalent of a small file cabinet full of material on the road.

Tip #2

Be sure to add the name of the library or archive and the call numbers for print items in your reference bibliography. If you keep the bibliography on a computer, the items can be sorted by place and call number to make an efficient research plan which will save time on a research trip.

Tip #3

Traveling abroad? E-mail yourself a copy of the basic data (names, dates, places) that you will need on the trip. If something happens to your printed copy, you can replace it by going to your hotel business center, an Internet café, or a library with public computer access to get a duplicate copy from your e-mail.

Tip #4

Find a research partner with whom you can brainstorm research problems and who can give a critique of your research results. We all hit walls and

need help. We are never the best analytical reviewer of our own work.

Tip #5

Do you use colored folders to code your files? You can use colored indelible markers to mark the disks on which you save electronic data to match your paper files.

Dollarhide numbering will not be for everyone. Any system that comes close to being able to summarize the complex relationships that appear in our families will itself be complex. For some (even quite serious genealogists), using Dollarhide numbers and remembering how to interpret them will not be worth the effort. For others, it will fill a need and prove very useful. If Dollarhide numbering would aid you in the way you work, then Mr. Smith provides the information you will need to get started.
