

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**ABSTRACTS OF BOND AND FAYETTE COUNTY MARRIAGES
FOUND IN MADISON COUNTY, ILLINOIS**

The following list of marriages was among the papers of the former Editor, Alenia McCord, turned over to the Society upon her death. The records were copied by Lloyd Bockstruck, a former Fayette County resident, from materials in the John Nowland papers in the Greenville Public Library and have not been compared against the original. These records have never been published through the pages of *Fayette Facts*. The records begin 1813.

Quoting from Mr. Bockstruck, "Originally marriage licenses and certificates in Bond County were entered in a volume labeled 'County Records', covering the period June, 1817 to March, 1823. In a typed copy of this record in the county courthouse occur two lists: one for marriage licenses granted between March 1817 and January 1821 and another for marriages solemnized from September 1817 through November 1820. Thereafter the entries were made in a separate register. Because the records have been copied at least three times, the chance for errors has been increased proportionately".

Fayette County was not formed until 1821, so many marriages of people living within the current environs of our county would have their marriages filed in Bond or Madison counties.

Information in parenthesis has been added by Mr. Bockstruck and/or Miss McCord.

living with his parents Joseph (born about 1800 in England), Laetitia (born about 1808 in England) and his siblings: John (born about 1838 in England), Martha (born about 1844 in IL) Thomas (born about 1847 in IL) and William (born about 1850 in IL)¹²³. Henry was among the earliest to volunteer to serve in the army. He enlisted on 25 Jun 1861 in Company K of the 13th IL Infantry¹²⁴. When he joined the army he was employed as a mason and described as being 5'11" tall with dark hair, blue eyes and a fair complexion¹²⁵. Henry was mustered in for three years as a Private on the same day he enlisted in Caseyville, IL¹²⁶. The 13th IL Infantry saw significant combat while Henry was with the unit, including the actions at Arkansas Post, AR and Chickasaw Bayou, MS as well as the sieges of Vicksburg and Jackson, MS¹²⁷. The severity of active service caught up with Henry. He died in a hospital in Memphis, TN on 21 May 1864¹²⁸. *[Note: There is some controversy concerning Henry's exact burial location. The 1956 IL Honor Roll has listings for him in both the Wayne Center Cemetery in Wayne Township and the Oakwood Cemetery in Winfield Township¹²⁹. Headstones for Henry are also in both cemeteries. The headstone in the Wayne Center Cemetery is old and appears contemporary with his death. The headstone in the Oakwood Cemetery is considerably newer and was apparently cut and installed at the same time as similar markers for members of the extended Standidge family buried there. Correspondence with the Wayne Township Clerk confirmed that Henry was buried in the Wayne Center Cemetery¹³⁰. There is no record of a re-internment. The marker in the Oakwood Cemetery is likely a cenotaph.]*

I have noted when a date was given by the bible owner, but not seen by my eyes. The reason for alternate spellings is that the owners probably gave the accepted ones, whereas I transcribed what the original spelling appeared to be. klg.]
