Located in the east central part of the state, Delaware County was organized in 1827. It has had no boundary changes. There are twelve townships: Center, Delaware, Hamilton, Harrison, Liberty, Monroe, Mount Pleasant, Niles, Perry, Salem, Union, and Washington.

The Paul Revere Chapter of the D.A.R. at Muncie has contributed to the library the inscriptions from many of the cemeteries in the county, together with indexes. Elizabeth and Eugene Wierbach copied some inscriptions in the 1940's, Mr. Cecil Beeson of Hartford City copied one cemetery just south of the Blackford-Delaware County line, and in recent years the Church of Latter Day Saints (Mormons) have copied inscriptions from several cemeteries. In instances where a particular cemetery was copied by more than one individual or organization, it will be well for the researcher to check each record. The location of the cemeteries was not always clear, but your editor has tried to list them in the township in which they are located.

DUBOIS AND ELKHART COUNTIES

Dubois County in the southwestern part of the state was organized in 1817. The Genealogy Division has inscriptions from only one cemetery, Hobbs, west of Ireland. Miss Thelma Murphy listed the Harbison family inscriptions found in two farm cemeteries east of Haysville and five inscriptions from the Hope cemetery. The Hoosier Genealogist for July-August, 1965, listed inscriptions from the Dr. William A. Line and Burton family cemeteries in Columbia Township. John H. Teder's History of Dubois County (1964) gives the names of those buried in the James Dillman family graveyard, 3 1/2 miles southeast of Ireland, and family names in the Shiloh Cemetery.

Elkhart County in the northern part of the state was organized in 1830. Two cemeteries from this county are recorded in the Genealogy Division: Jackson in Jackson Township, 2 pp. (only pioneers listed), and Stutsman, in Harrison Township, 3 pp.

Correction. In Scott County Marriage Records, 1831-40, published in HG, Vol. 6, No. 1, p. 5: John L. Favers-Jane Haze, 11-26-1833 should read John La Favour-Jane Hays. John was the son of Thomas and Esther (McNew) Favour; Jane was the daughter of Samuel and Sarah (Thompson) Hays.

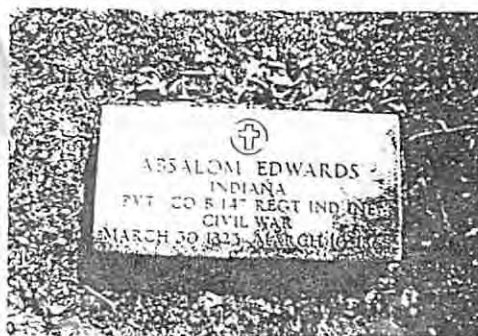

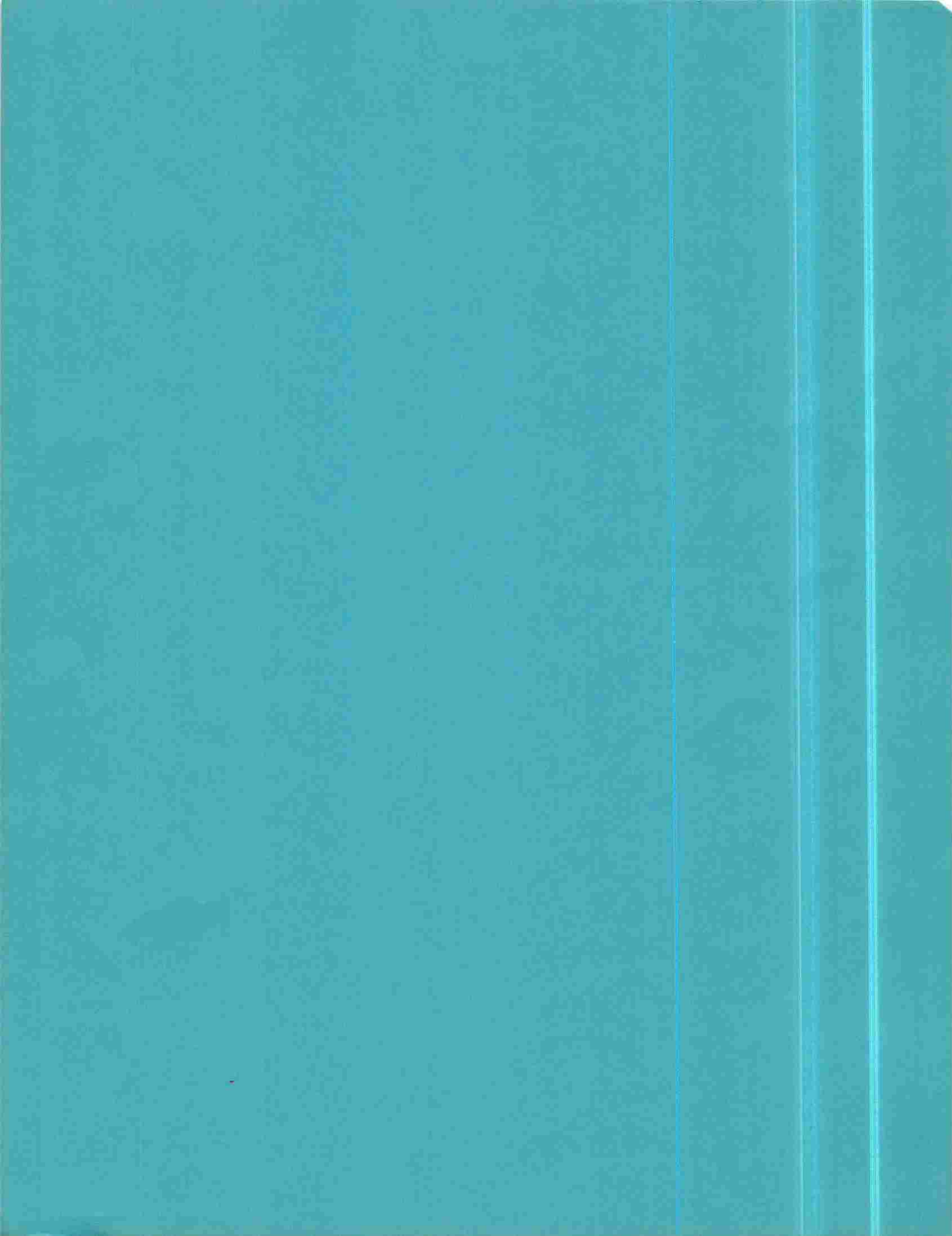

Delaware County Probate Packet Data Base, B.S.U.

In an interview with Mr. John Straw from Archives and Special Collections at Bracken Library, Ball State University, it was discovered that 15,000 probate packets [files] housed there, are being indexed into a huge data base. At this time only 8,000 have been incorporated. Straw indicated that this data base can be searched upon request. Requests may be addressed to : Room 210, Archives and Special Collections, Bracken Library, Ball State University, Muncie 47306. Letters are preferred to phone calls. Variant spellings of the name and an approximate death date should be included.

Mr. Straw stated that although they are able to search the data base, usually they cannot take time to copy material from the files since many are lengthy and involve many pieces of paper. They will try to locate the name and file and let the researcher know how much material is in it. Due to limited staff it probably will be necessary to hire a researcher to do copying if the individual is unavailable to the library. [Note: Volunteers at the DCHA do research upon request.]

The hours during the summer are M-F 7:30 to 4:30, but during the fall and spring semesters the room is open from 8 to 5 M-F and 7:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. on Wednesday evening. Parking is available on the top level of a parking ramp at minimum cost. This facility is located almost in the middle of the campus and is one block east of Bracken Library.

The time range of these packets begins with the start of county records in 1827/28. The smaller packet [file] numbers generally are the earliest estates probated in the county. Researchers should keep in mind that when there were minor children and a guardian appointed, the estate may have been probated several years later. In that case, there may be a second packet or file under the same name and date with a larger file number. The date on the file is usually the date that the probate began which was soon after death.

The estate settlements were placed in packets and numbered by the W.P.A. in the 1930's. A few years ago the Delaware County courthouse gave them to Ball State University. They are now in files in boxes. All slips of paper have been carefully preserved. It is really a genealogist's dream to discover an ancestor who has one of these files! Ball State University is offering a unique service with the data base and the preservation of these packets that few counties can offer. The project is ongoing by Jack Carmichael and students.

Lists of the earliest estates were shown in DCGH, Volume 5, No. 4, p. 96, files #1-120 and Volume 6, No. 1, p. 8, files #121-225. The current list is part of Archives and Special Collections' data base and begins with #226 and ends with #499. These names represent the earliest settlers to our community. It was they who tamed the wilderness and began to build the society we know today.

These probate packets or files contain the original documents compiled at the time a person died and his/her estate was probated. One can expect to find the inventory taken of the deceased's personal property usually with the names of the individuals who purchased items at the sale—some of whom were relatives. If there was a will it will likely be included. The names of the administrators, appraisers, creditors, debtors, guardians and securities bonded in the estate will be shown. The file is likely to contain many small slips of paper which are mainly receipts of funds disbursed, the names to whom it was disbursed and the nature of the expense. A file may contain promissory notes the deceased signed before his death. There may have been suits filed against the estate and they will be there. Examples of information follow :

"Received of Asbury Allegre, Admr., of the estate of George Smith the sum of seventy-five cents for crying the sale of the above George M. Smith deceased 17 May 1847." [#233]

"Received 15 Jan 1835 of Mary Jane Van Matre widow of Isaac Newton Van Matre one dollar being the amount the Estate is indebted to us for helping thrash his wheat Signed: Hugh Walker, Hugh Shields." [#235]

An Indiana law required and still requires notices be placed in a newspaper when an estate is being probated. It requests creditors make their claims against the estate. When there was a petition to sell or partition the land a notice was to appear in a newspaper. The following clipping for John McCallister's estate [#234] could have great value to the researcher. In the absence of a will the two daughters below could have been unknown :

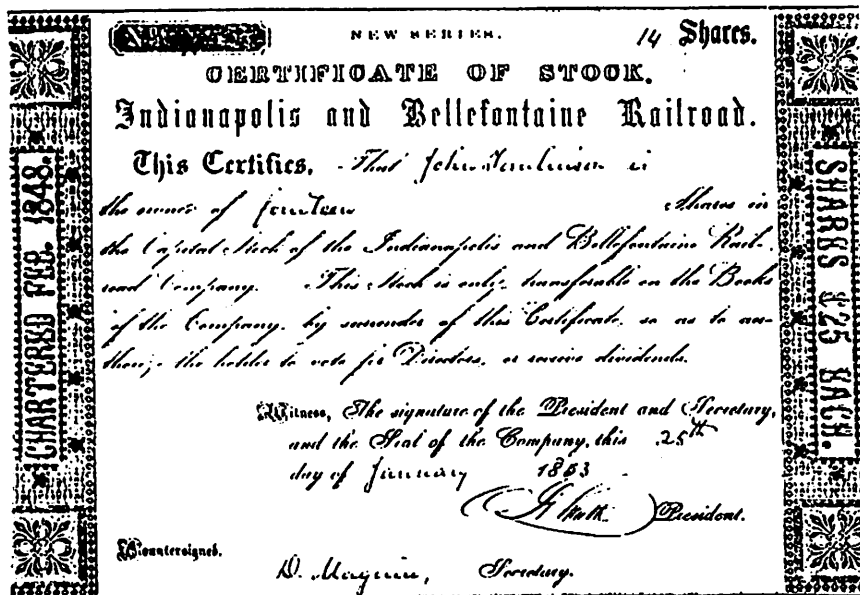
"In the Delaware County Probate Court, August term, 1852. PETITION FOR PARTITION. John Cline, Hannah Cline and Andrew Kennedy versus The unknown children of Nancy Bier, formerly Nancy McCallister and the unknown children of Mary Crout, formerly Mary McCallister.

"THE above named defendants will take notice that the above named petitioners have filed their petition for partition of the real estate, of John McCallister who died seized, which petition will be heard at the next August term of said Court, where said defendants may attend on the first day of said term and defend, or judgment of said partition will be given by default. Attest THOMAS J. MATTHEWS. clerk. June 28, 1853 38w3 pf\$2.00"

John C. Osborn stated on the sheet of paper to which the clipping was attached that the advertisement was published three weeks successively at least thirty days before the present term of court in the MUNCIE CRESSET of which he was the proprietor and Editor. It was signed by Thomas J. Matthews Clerk. [Note: It may have been MUNCIE CURRENT]

The packets sometimes contain a summary of the doctor's visits , medicines prescribed and bill owed the estate. In the estate of Moses Breese [#256] quinine was shown. One would guess malaria was suffered by someone. On Jun 15, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24 and 25, 1846, the doctor made visits "to the lady." Night visits were \$2.00 and day visits were \$1.50.

The estate papers of [Judge] John Tomlinson [#279] included his stock certificates for two railroad lines! One was the "Newcastle and Richmond Rail Road Extension" [Cincinnati and Chicago Route] issued in 1852 at \$50.00 a share. The other is shown here.



The estate papers of [Dr.] Levi Minshall [#251] showed he died 6 Mar 1836 and his only heir, Juliet S. Minshell, was age 3. At the time of Levi's death he owned Out Lot #6 in Brown's donation to Muncietown with a one story frame house on it valued at \$800.00 and personality totaling \$3,000.00. The widow was Ellen who filed a report 23 Feb 1838 of the articles she had chosen from the estate totaling \$107.05. She signed her name with a flourish. [Note : Ellen would have had a dower interest in the estate, so she would have been an heir.]

The estate was in chancery court. Juliet by her attorney accused the administrator of squandering and wasting the estate for two years. Ten pages of handwritten notes describe the estate year by year. A wealth of information awaits the researcher in situations like this.
