The introductory pages in a set of thin ledgers, one for each township in one Indiana county, give a brief history of the 'Laws Regulating Enumeration of Male Inhabitants.'

In the year 1866, and again in the year 1871, and at the end of each successive period of six (6) years after the last mentioned year, an enumeration of the white male inhabitants, over the age of twenty-one (21) years, of this state, shall be made in obedience to the requirements of the constitution and according to the provisions hereinafter contained. (Citation, Acts 1865.)

Further information on these enumerations is found in the *Inventory of County Archives*, *No. 18, Delaware County*, a 1940 W. P. A. publication. Under the section of the county clerk the following appears:

Formerly when there was an enumeration of the white male inhabitants over the age of 21 years, lists showing such enumeration were delivered to and kept by the clerk, and the clerk certified to the auditor of state the results of each enumeration. Since 1845 the auditor has performed these duties, to which was added in 1877 the enumeration of colored males over the age of 21 years.

In the section for the county audit is the following information:

Once every six years the township trustees and their assistant enumerate all white male inhabitants of the state over 21 years old. Books and blanks, together with copies of the law requiring such enumerations, are furnished to the township trustees by the auditor. The trustees' returns are filed in the office of the auditor. The auditor examines the returns and, by orders recorded in a separate book, corrects any errors, mistakes, or omissions discovered. For this purpose, he may subpoena and question witnesses. The auditor then certifies the correct enumeration to the auditor of state. Likewise there is a similar enumeration of colored male inhabitants.

A few of these enumerations have survived in various counties. Currently, only one Delaware County enumeration, that for the year 1907, has been located by our most experienced researcher. In an effort to make this material more accessible, a project to alphabetically index, by last name and first name, this enumeration of over 15,000 names was begun near the end of 1998. The town of Albany was treated separately from the surrounding townships, presumably because of its size and status as a town. Some 439 names (one listed twice, but spelled differently each time) appeared on this list, indexed below.

The section pages of the ledger describe it as, "Auditor's Copy, Alphabetically Arranged." This alphabet is by first letter of last name only, an arrangement not nearly as difficult to use for Albany's 439 names as it is for Center Township's 9,387 names. The project currently proposes two alphabetical sequences for Delaware County, one to consist of Center Township names (including Muncie) and the other to consist of the other townships and Albany.

As may be imagined, the reading of the handwriting is not always easy. Two very different hands can be seen in the Albany list, the second one beginning with a flourish at the letter 'M.' In fact, the flourishes are a problem in this hand, with two entries having flourishes that this decipherer could not decipher. Certain characteristics are established fairly readily, as the closing of the small 'k' at the bottom as a small 'b' would be made and the forming of the small 'c' with a loop at the top, in the style of a printed 'e.' In the later case, the small 'e' is made with the standard loop crossed at the bottom and is readily distinguishable.

Seeing a name a second time is sometimes very helpful, as it may be clearer the second time. However, seeing 'Sinmons' a second time merely confirmed that it really was that combination of 'hills.' It was also noted that the 't' and the 'l' in Casterline were made correctly, but the cross mark appeared above the 'l.'

Making this second copy for the Auditor by hand must have been a tedious job and probably not particularly well paid. The number 165 appears both its usual order and again between

One Thing Leads to Another! An Incidental Note


In the WPA publication mentioned above, there was another interesting paragraph under the section on the duties of auditor, as follows:

Scalps of woodchucks, heads of owls, hawks, and crows, and the eggs of crows are presented to the auditor with the statutory affidavits for the purpose of obtaining bounties thereon.

We believe this law long defunct. It certainly shows how times have changed. The winged predators mentioned were a menace to open range chickens, young ducks, etc. In this age of cage-bred chickens, the chickens are safe from owls, hawks and crows.

The Delaware County Agricultural Agent, Harold Brown, tells us that groundhogs, officially known as woodchucks, are still a nuisance on modern farms. Their holes have been known to break tractor axles and their voracious appetites as they prepare for their hibernation leads them to destroy many bushels of soybeans. But don't take the scalps to the auditor's office-they don't do that anymore!

The following index list of Black males over the age of 18 in Center Township, including Muncie, was compiled from the same township trustees enumeration as the list for Albany, which appeared in the Spring 1999 issue.

Many of the comments made about the Albany list pertain to this list also. The age of individuals apparently was not always recorded, and a question mark was in the age column. Occasionally a first name was not recorded. Sometimes only a first initial or what appears to be a nickname was recorded.

Every effort has been made to list names exactly as they appear in the Auditor's Copy. At times, when the name appears similar to another spelling <[sic]> is used to indicate that it was checked and this reflects the original list. Two names were listed with the designation "Dr." before the first name. The index uses

The township section and the number under which the name appeared in the Auditor's Copy are given in case persons want to look at the original Auditor's Copy. This will save looking through whole letters of the alphabet. In those numbers with a small "a" after them, that number was used twice, with this note indicating the second appearance of the number.

GENEALOGICAL SOCIETY Delaware County Pioneer Recalls Early Experiences

A Letter from The Muncie Morning News March 5, 1901

Editor, Muncie Morning News

After reading the obituary notice in The News of February 20, 1901, of the death of my sister, Elizabeth Boltin, the late wife of John L. Hopping, of Wheeling, in Delaware county, my dormant memory waked up and began a running race over some the scenes, events and incidents of seventy-five years ago, located but a few miles up White river, from the now beautiful city of Muncie, then known as Muncytown.

On the 14th day of March, 1826, your very humble follow traveler was born in a new, unfinished log cabin standing in the midst of a bit of very heavy white oak timbered land, with not one-half acre cleared land upon it. It was a portion of what is known as the old Boltin farm in Liberty township. So you see that on the 14th day of the coming March (1901) I am going to jump down from the barren waste of my 74th year into the beautiful dale of my 75th year.

Please bear in mind, that seventy-five years ago, the now noble, grand state of Indiana was a wild, heavy timbered forest. Inhabited by bears, wolves, buffalo, deer, millions of small game animals, and some portions of it, by wild roving bands of Indians, and during Black Hawk's time, [1767-1938, Sauk Indian, Illinois] many of those hair raisers, were very anxious to take a hand with him, in his scalping amusements.

It would be a challenge unanswered to attempt to locate a good and wise man in your state, although he may be the lawful owner of as strong and keen an imagination, as a first class romance writer, who could have the genius to either paint or draw a pen picture, that will perfectly portray or present the one half of the daily hardships, inconvenience, deprivations, as well as the entire absence of luxuries, as well as the want of variety in the food supplies, also including the distressing scarcity of the supply of clothing materials, both for daily wear, as well as covering for the rude beds of the brave army of pioneers who penetrated into the wild wilderness of Indiana, and set down to hew out for themselves future homes. If any genius imagines he can successfully do this picture, let him gather up his materials and at once set to work, and then throw away his painting before it is half finished and say it is one of the cant's [sic] that can't be done. My beloved friends I have been there, and I want to tell you, that when a fellow is compelled to work from sun to sun each twenty-four hours, and day after day feed on coarse cornbread, and muly [sic] cow's milk, he is quite soon helped to the conclusion that he has previous little to eat, and its variety is equal to one, multiplied by two.

There is no rule by which a professor can compute the amount of solid, daily, hard labor my father performed the first twenty years he was engaged in clearing up his farm, and providing the necessary building on the same. He began with forty acres of land, and by selling the small surplus of his little farm at, pork, 1.50 per 100 pounds, wheat at 25 cents per bushel, corn at 12-1/2 cents per bushel, potatoes at 12-1/2 cents per bushel, butter 5 cents per pound, eggs at 5 cents per dozen and coon skins at [20?] cents a piece, he finally succeeded in raising money enough to enable him to add 20 [?] more acres to his 40, equal to 60 [?] in all. Nature had entirely deprived Henry Boltin of the genius of a speculator, the fruits of the toils of his hands and the natural increase in the value of [h]is land, gave him all the wealth he every [sic] possessed, which was very much less than \$1,000,000 and the history of Henry Boltin's pioneer experience furnishes a perfect copy of the history of a very large majority of the first brave pioneers of Indiana.

Jo[h]n Smith, who lived so near to my father that King David might have stood in the door yard of one and cast one of his smooth stones into that of the other, also started with but forty
