forest, without seeing a single dwelling. I am eleven miles from Troy, the nearest port, and six miles downstream from Cannelton. The region is very healthy, without fevers or cholera. Shipping products out is difficult, but my land is five or six times cheaper than on the river bank, and this isn't really a disadvantage anyway, for people here mostly raise livestock. Water is abundant, something that's hard to find in this region. Moreover, in several places there is coal; I cook my soup with some from my own land. I'm about twenty-five miles from Rockport, the county seat. To the east, the land is inhabited by German Catholics, to the south by German Lutherans, to the west and the north by American Methodists, who two years ago built the tiny town of Santa Fe, about twenty wood houses two miles from here. There still is very little land that has been cleared, almost everywhere there is the forest of oaks and walnuts, excellent for raising pigs. Except when I was sick and my neighbors came to see me, often several days pass without my seeing a soul.

In Santa Fe, there is a mill driven by two horses, and a wool carding factory. These two big concerns work night and day. There is also a general store, which sells practically everything. At Fulda there is even a two-horse mill, and two shops, one of which is also an inn, and the other the post office. There is a public school, a carriage-builder, a blacksmith and cobbler. And yet the town has only six houses.

Elijah visited Thomas in March of 1875. He described the farm where Thomas lived:

The old man has lived for more than half a century and raised a large family among the Hills of this Grand Old River Ohio... He is living at the foot hills, six miles from Rockport on the Boonville Road, his farm is fifty years old, lives in the same cabin (sic) he first built on the farm, a fine spring water gushes out of the bank a few feet from the House, surrounded with persimmon trees, his house is what is called a double cabin, (sic) that is two rooms with porch on the North side... on the hill on the West side of the Boonville Road one hundred yards from the house is situated the family cemetery, where Graves Hackleman was buried.

Thomas (1790-1878) was the 12th child of Jacob, yet he outlived all of his brother and sisters. Thomas died nine months after his wife of sixty-five years, who died in 1877.

VADM Jerry O. Tuttle was born in Hatfield, Indiana; awarded the American Spirit Honor Medal upon graduation from Enlisted Recruit Training in March 1955; selected for the Naval Aviation Cadet (NAVCAD) Program; and designated a Naval Aviator and commissioned in October 1956.

His career has included assignments to the staff of the Commander Naval Air Force, U.S. Atlantic Fleet; Attack Squadrons FORTY FOUR, FIFTEEN, ONE TWELVE, ONE SEVENTY FOUR and EIGHTY ONE; Fighter Squadron ONE TWELVE and the Office of the Chief of Naval Operations. He has served as Aide and Flag Lieutenant to the Commander in Chief, U.S. Pacific Fleet. He has commanded Attack Squadron EIGHTY ONE, Carrier Air Wing THREE, replenishment ship USS KALAMAZOO (AOR 6), aircraft carrier USS JOHN F. KENNEDY (CV 67), Carrier Group EIGHT and Carrier Group TWO/Battle Force SIXTH Fleet. He has served as Special Assistant to the Chief of Naval Operations and as Deputy Director for Intelligence and External Affairs at the Defense Intelligence Agency. VADM Tuttle was the Naval Inspector General from August 1984 to November 1985, after which he was Deputy and Chief of Staff for the Commander in Chief, U.S. Atlantic Fleet. In May 1987, he was assigned as Director, Command, Control and Communications Systems, The Joint Staff. In May 1989, he assumed his present assignment as Director, Space and Electronic Warfare.

VADM Tuttle received a Communications Engineering degree from the Naval Postgraduate School in 1963 having attended the undergraduate and postgraduate schools simultaneously. He graduated with honors from the Naval War College, and concurrently received a master's degree in International Relations from George Washington University in 1969.

VADM Tuttle's personal decorations include the Defense Distinguished Service Medal; Distinguished Service Medal; Defense Superior Service Medal; Legion of Merit (4); Distinguished Flying Cross (3); Meritorious Service Medal (2); Air Medal (23) - five individual and 18 strike/flight awards; Navy Commendation Medal (4); and various campaign awards. He flew over 220 combat missions over North Vietnam and has more than 1,000 arrested carrier landings. He received the 1978 Navy League's John Paul Jones Award for inspirational leadership, the 1983 Association of Old Crows' Award for his contributions to electronic warfare, the 1984 Annual Tailhook Award for his contributions to Naval aviation, the 1989 AFCEAN of the year in recognition of his contributions to the Armed Forces Communications and Electronics Association (AFCEA), and the 1991 American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics (AIAA) Command, Control, Communications and Intelligence Award for his contribution to the overall effectiveness of C3I Systems, and the AFCEA 1992 Jon L. Boyes award for major contributions to that international organization. He was chosen as one of Federal Computer Week's "1991" and "1992 Federal 100" for his impact on government computer systems.

VADM Tuttle is married to the former Barbara Bonifay of Pensacola, Florida. They have five children: Michael, Vicky, Mark, Stephen, and Monique.

*WILLIAM BARKER SR.*

William Barker was born in Nelson County, Kentucky in 1795, came to Indiana in 1819 and settled in Clay township in 1831, where the town of Buffaloville now stands. He married Sallie Crawford, a sister to "Uncle" Cyrus Crawford, who was spoken of in a former article. To this marriage were born ten children, eight boys and two girls, named as follows: Hardin, Hamilton, Silas, Elijah, William, Isaac, Abraham, Thomas, Millie, and Sarah. All the children grew to manhood and womanhood and settled within a radius of two to four miles of Buffaloville. Millie married Lieut. John W. Lamar, Sarah, married Jacob Varner who died in 1863. She then married Thomas Littlepage near Rockport. Hardin and Silas were members of Old Pigeon Church, and were considered able defenders of the old Regular Baptist doctrine. Silas had two sons in the Union army and Hardin had one.

Of those ten children eight are dead. Elijah and Thomas are living. William Barker Sr., was a very strong Union man and a great friend and admirer of Lincoln. He and six of his sons voted for Lincoln and stood by his administration, while two- Silas and Hardin- voted against Lincoln and opposed his Emancipation Proclamation. Many of the descendants of William Barker Sr., are living in Spencer County and are considered very worthy men and women.

one year at a time but since most of them were unmarried, moving was not the task it has become today. The Quarterly Conference record for 1859 indicates that there were 8 preaching points on the Grand View Circuit as follows: Grand View, Hammond School house, Chancellors School house, Oakland, Cross Roads, Harters School house, Bluff School house, and Union School house. A Quarterley Conference committ reported that \$ 160 would be needed for the "table expense" of the preacher that year. The Presiding Elder's apportionment was \$ 40.

In January 1861 the record drops the name Harter school house as a preaching point and the name Newtonville is first recorded. About the year 1875 Newtonville was separated from the Grand View circuit and was made the head of another circuit with Collins Chapel, Turners Chapel, Buffaloville, and Friendship.

The first pastor of this new circuit was William B. Collins. Since he was a very young man some fear was expressed lest the circuit might fail, but when the year ended he had held a gracious revival in each preaching point with 160 conversions, of which 100 became members of the church.

In 1879 a frame building was erected on a parcel of ground, the present church site, deeded to the Methodists by Levi and Mahala Hainesto the trustees J.G. Rumpel, Marvin A. Jones, and William H. Sutton. \$ 400 was also raised for a parsonage. The parsonage purchased is still the property of the church in Newtonville.

In 1891 during the pastorate of Rev. John D. Jeffrey the original church was removed and the present church was built in its stead. It was heated at first with two coal burning stoves and the first illumination was oil lamps. Later an acetylene gas system was used for lighting. Some later gasoline lights were installed and came near to burning the building. During the pastorate of Rev. Barthol Rogers, about 1933 a basement was dug under the church and a furnace was installed and electricity became available for lighting. The large bell which still calls the faithful to worship was installed in 1906 and the first bell was given to the Newtonville school.

ROCKPORT JOURNAL, FRIDAY JANUARY 11, 1895

How an Irish Lad Traveled Four Thousand Miles Without  
a cent.

Hid Away in the Hold of a Ship and Then Came out and Worked  
His Passage Across the Ocean on His Way to Rockport.

Without a cent in his pocket, Thomas McDonald traveled four thousand miles and arrived in this city last night and was sent to the Wayfarers' Rest last evening by Capt. Bossung, the keeper of the Central police station.

The story is quite a remarkable one, McDonald lived in the county Claire, Ireland, with his father and mother. There was not much work going on there and they had heard so much about the new world that the father decided to come to this country and try to make a home for his loved ones.

He started, and the mother and her son were left behind. They recieved one letter from him in Rockport, Indiana saying he had a place in a mill, but that he did not make much money and it would probably be some time before he was able to send for them. This was the last letter they recieved from him. The mother was afterward taken sick, and the son worked in a tannery and supported her. His pay was very small and it took all he made to keep them alive.

Finally, the mother died and then the son sold their few belongings to pay the funeral expenses. It barely sufficed. He was penniless and homeless. With no longer any tie in the old country, he concluded to come to America and seek his father. He made his way to Liverpool and went down to the docks, where the big steamer City Of Berlin was loading. When no one was looking, he slipped into the hold and hid among some boxes. The vessel was far out at sea before he was discovered. Then he was forced to come out on account of hunnger. The cook took him into the kitchen and he worked his passage over. The ship landed at New York, and when the crew went ashore McDonald went with them. He did not remain with them long though. At the first opportunity he slipped away from them and began making inquiries about the direction to take for Rockport. Sometime he walked and sometimes he rode but he managed to make his way as far as Louisville. When the snow came up he was in Cincinnati, and he was taken in and kept by a man to whom he told his story. McDonard is about about eighteen years old and has the genuine Irish brogue. He arrived at the station house about 9:30 o'clock last night and told his story to the station keeper, who sent him to the Rest for the night. This morning he says he will resume his journey to Indiana.

BITS OF SPENCER COUNTY HISTORY

Facts Concerning Citizens of Spencer County, as Shown by Their Death Notices,  
Published in The Umpire, a Newspaper Printed at Rockport, Indiana, by Danial Hayford  
From 1865-1867

On July 5th 1866, Samuel D. Smith, a well known citizen of Rockport. On June 28th he was assisting some men in his employ to put up some rafters on a barn which he was building two miles from town. A board on which he was seated broke and he fell twenty feet, striking on his head and right shoulder. He was paralyzed by the fall and died a week later.

Samuel Alley settled in Clay township about 1836. He came from Kentucky. He had three sons, Frank, Vanderman, and Joseph; they were soldiers in the Civil War. He had one daughter that married Isaac Varner.

Jacob Varner settled on the south side of the township in 1834 on the farm known as the Vanderman Alley farm. He had two sons, Isaac and Jacob, and four daughters. Two of his daughters married Frank and Vanderman Alley; a third married William Barker. One daughter never married; Mr. Varner was born in Kentucky.

William Barker settled near Buffaloville in 1835. He was from Nelson County, Kentucky. He had eight sons; Harden, Silas, Elijah, Abraham, Hamilton, William, Isaac, and Thomas, two daughters, Milly and Mary. Milly married John W. Lamar and Mary married Jacob Varner.
