## My Civil War Ancestor: Andrew Tretter Submitted by Paul Tornatta

In the 1860 Federal Census Andrew is 17 living with his parents George and Christina Trater and his sisters, Mary L. age 10 and Barbara age 7. They are living in Fulda, Harrison Township, Spencer County, Indiana. Andrew's occupation is Farm Labor. At the same time Catherine (Klueh) age 10 is living nearby with her family, John and Loucinda Kluh and her siblings.

Based on records obtained from the National Archives, Andrew was drafted and entered service in Company H as a private on September 29, 1864 at age 23. He was honorably discharged on July 25, 1865 at Chattanooga, Tennessee.

After the war Andrew married Catherine Klueh on February 18, 1868 in Spencer County, Indiana. She was 21 and he 27.

In the 1880 census, Andrew and family are in Harrison, Spencer County, Indiana. Living there is Andrew & Catherine plus the children, Barbara, John, Elizabeth, Mary, Francisca and Margareth. Also living there is Frank Goebel and Peter Burns.

Their first 6 children born between 1868 and 1880 were born in St. Meinrad, Spencer County, Indiana and the last 2, Edith and Cecilia were born in Evansville, Indiana.

Andrew appears in the 1882 Evansville Directory living "e s Bland Ave, b Ballard and Lincoln Ave" - east side of Bland Ave., between Ballard and Lincoln Ave.

In "A History of Evansville and Vanderburgh County Indiana - 1897" written by Joseph P. Elliott there is mention of the Farragut Post No. 27 in the Department of the Indiana G.A.R. (Grand Army of the Republic) for veterans of the Civil War. Andrew is part of the descriptive record listing every one who ever belonged to the post. His entry indicates he entered into the service on September 29, 1864 as a private in Company H in the 44 Indiana Infantry. He was discharged July 25, 1865 from the same company after 9 months of service.

Andrew also appears in "Abstracts of the 1890 County Enrollment of Persons Who Served in the Armies of the United States - Vanderburgh Co., IN" - Folder 33 Ta-Tw. He is living at 1107 W Indiana Street in Pigeon Twp. And was a Private, Co H 44th Indiana. This lists 5 children under 16: Mary, Francis, Katie, Ida, Celia. It also indicates Deafness of both Eres (Ears), near Chattanooga, Tenn. about Dec 1864 or Jan 1865.

As shown in the 1895 thru 1901 city directories, Andrew and family live at 1431 W. Franklin St.

There is a Surgeon's Certificate written for Andrew on April 24, 1911 stating his deafness was caused by being in close proximity of heavy artillery. He was living at 1511 West Franklin St. in Evansville at the time. Andrew claimed a pension because of rheumatism and deafness in both ears. Katherine also claimed a Widows Pension after Andrew's death.
