Lincoln's Mother

From the *Evansville Journal*, 21 May 1888

Gentryville, Ind. - In a neglected piece of woodland in the outskirts of Lincoln City, two miles from this place, in Spencer County, is the grave of President Lincoln's mother. A marble slab four feet in height and almost buried in a dense growth of weeds and dogwood, bears this inscription:

NANCY HANKS LINCOLN

Mother of

PRESIDENT LINCOLN

Died October 5, A.D. 1818, aged
85 years. Erected by a Friend
of Her Martyred Son,
1879.

At the foot of the grave is a small marble foot-stone with the letters "N.H.L." engraved upon it. Surrounding this grave are the graves of seven other persons, but there are no stones or monuments to identify the occupants of any of them, and all are sadly neglected. The deserted spot is but a short distance from the highway, but is so situated that it can be reached only by crossing cultivated fields. With the proper efforts, the place might be made very attractive, however, and there is some talk among the people here of beautifying it and erecting a more costly stone over the Lincoln grave. The place is seldom visited by strangers and rarely by the people living hereabouts.

Not more than 200 yards north of the grave is the spot upon which stood the house in which lived President Lincoln while a young man. It was made of logs, of course, and was situated on a small rise of clayish-looking ground. Not a vestige of the old structure remains.

The writer frequently visited the house before it succumbed to the ravages of time and the elements, as his uncle lived on and cultivated for years that which has passed into history as the Lincoln farm. Just back of the spot where the house used to stand runs the Cannelton branch of the road.

Time has nearly obliterated all traces of the Lincolns here, save the lonely grave in the deserted wood.

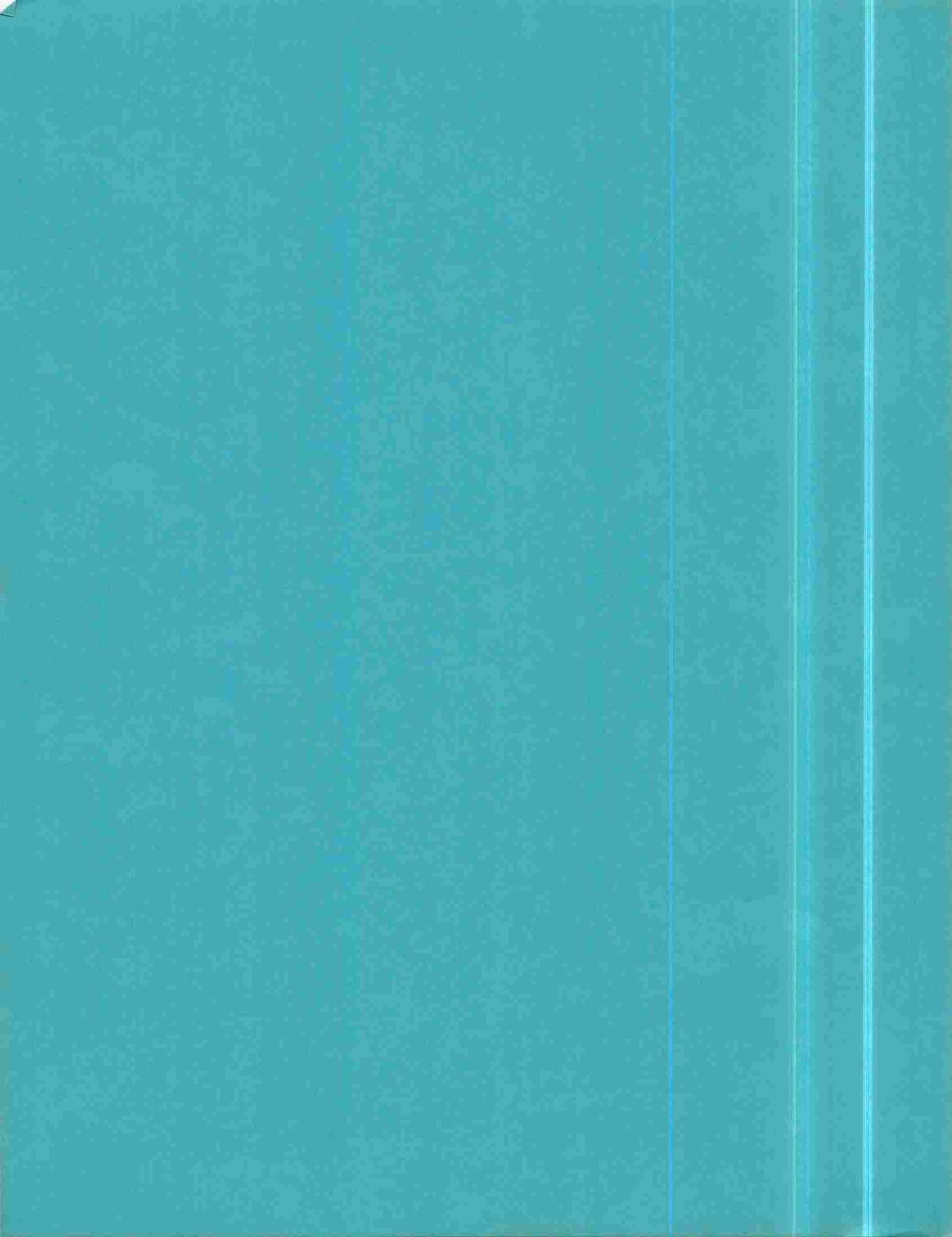
J. W. Messick Expires at His Residence Yesterday Morning

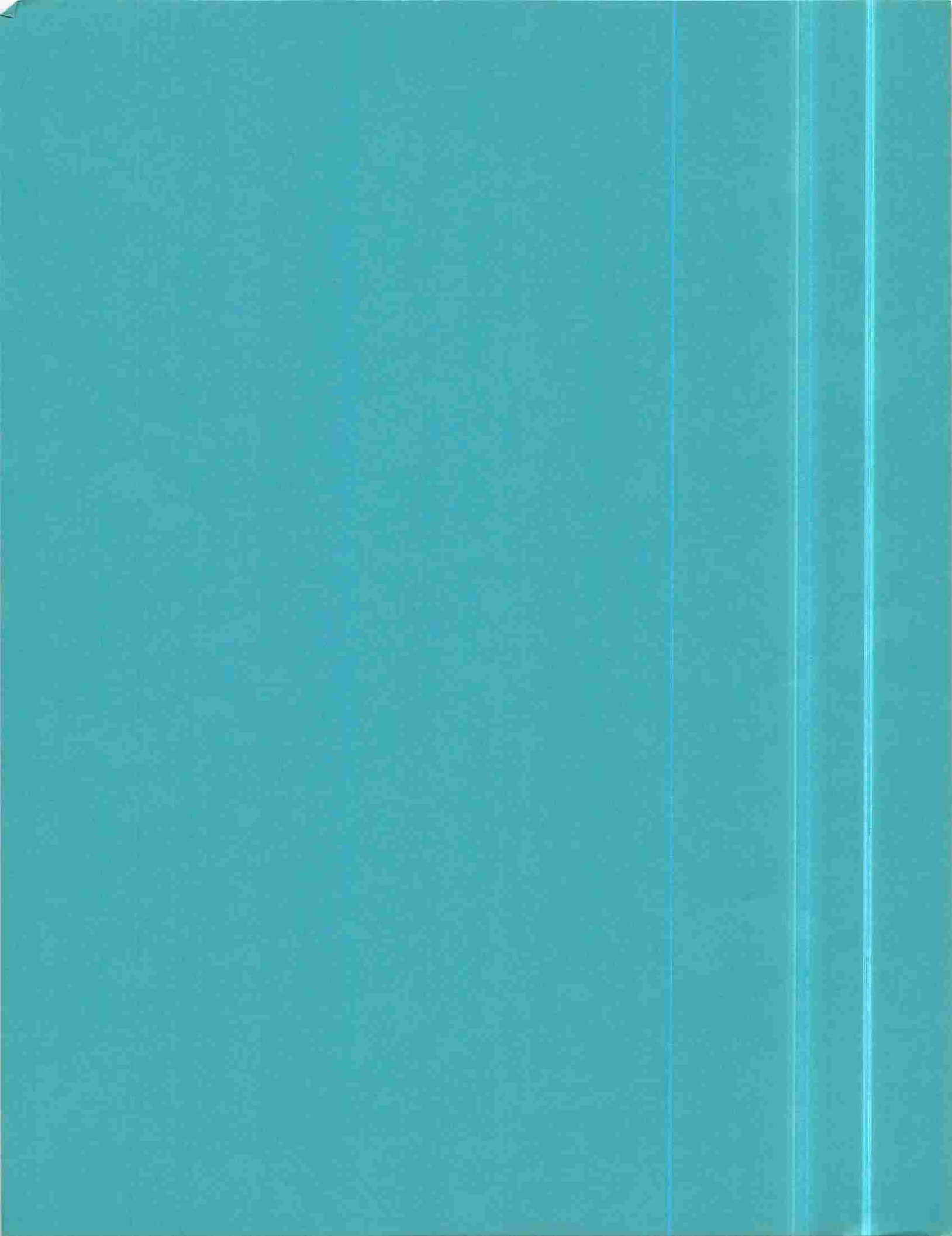

From A Grave Digger's Journal: Days of Celebration

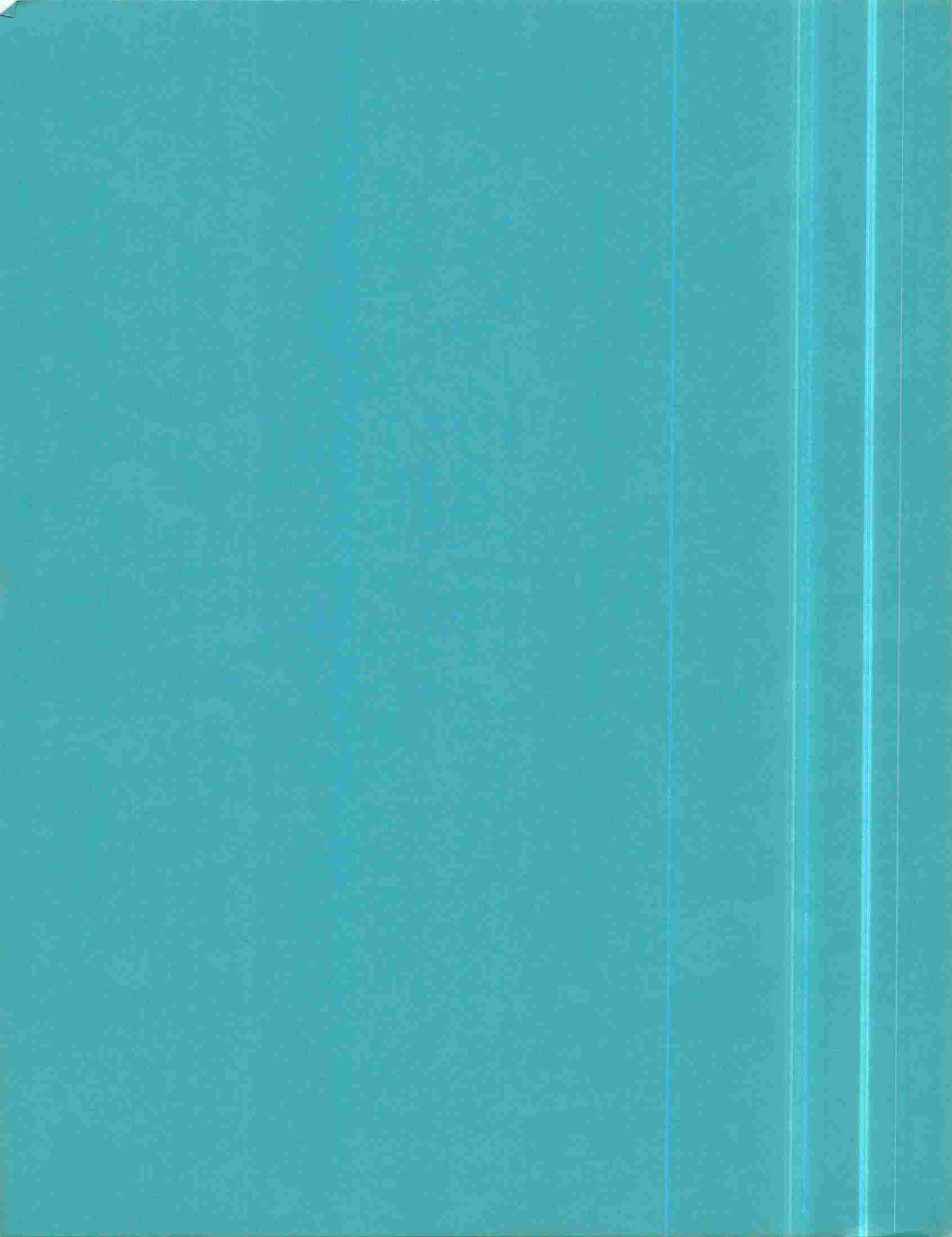
In March we celebrate St. Patrick's Day, the most widely celebrated Saints Day in the world. The day when everyone is Irish, no matter who you are or where you are from. In places like Ireland it is a national holiday and in the US it might as well be. Parades and beer drinking and even coloring a river or two green. Some will even color their beer green though this is frowned upon by those who really appreciate beer for what it is. Some will go to church and most will wear green or be pinched and have something to say that sounds Irish. Anyway you celebrate enjoy the day.

Patrick was said to have been born in the 4th century in Roman Britain and in his teens was captured by Irish raiders and taken into slavery. He later escaped back to Britain and became a priest in the church in Auxerre in Gaul. In 432 Patrick was call back to Ireland as a Bishop in an attempt to convert the Irish to Christianity. In his teachings he would use a shamrock to demonstrate the Christian doctrine of the Trinity. Patrick died on 17 March 461 and was buried at Downpatrick which means "Patrick's Stronghold", which is South of Belfast in County Down in Northern Ireland. While Rome had more successful missions to Ireland Patrick is held in esteem in the Irish Church as the champion of Irish Christianity.

Blue was the original color of St. Patrick and green gradually replace it due to how St. Patrick used the shamrock in his teachings. Wearing of the green just means wearing a shamrock on St. Patrick's Day. St. Patrick's Day was declared an official public holiday in Ireland in 1903.

Other countries have their ways of celebrating St. Patrick's Day. In Montreal Canada a parade had been held since 1824. It is the longest running St. Patrick's Day parade in North America. Other Canadian cities will have large celebrations by changing lights on monuments to green and some sports teams will be donning all green uniforms for the day. In Argentina there are all night parties where everyone must wear something green or be mocked out of the party. However neither the Irish Community which is the 5th largest Irish population outside Ireland nor the Catholic Church take part in these parties.

In Britain the queen will present bowl of shamrocks to the Irish Guards regiment of the British Army. Birmingham holds the largest St. Patrick's Day parade in Britain while Liverpool has the highest proportion of residents of Irish ancestry. The Irish descent population makes up the majority of the population of Coatbridge Scotland and there is a very large Irish population in Glasgow. The Church of England also recognizes this feast day.

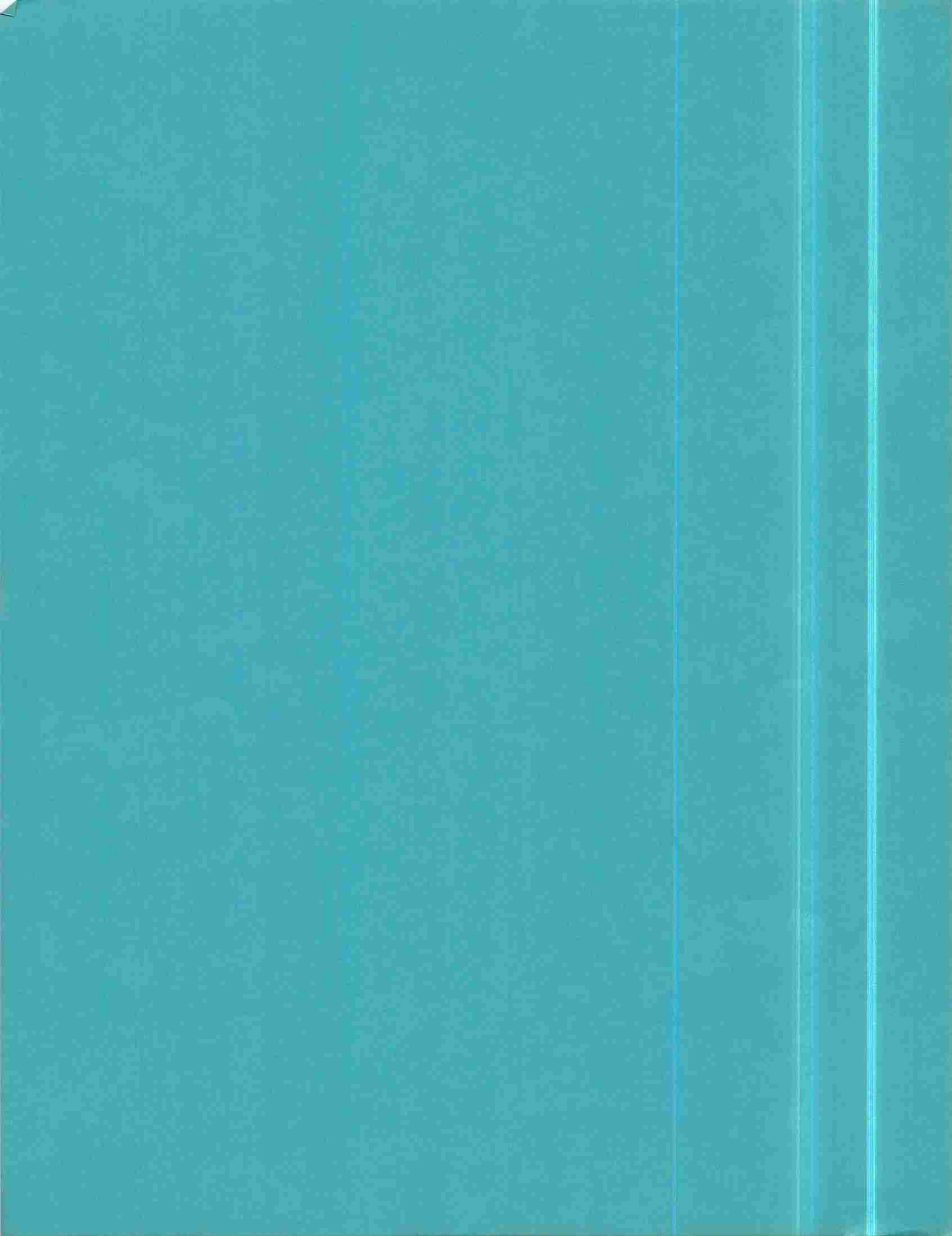
