Honey Creek Monthly Meeting of Friends Vigo County, Indiana 1820

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Sketch of Honey Creek Meeting

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At the outset let us clarify a common misconception. There are two meetings in Indiana with the name of Honey Creek, the one here under consideration and one in Howard County. The meeting in Howard County was established as a monthly meeting in 1846 and the name changed to New London Monthly Meeting in 1892.

The original Honey Creek meeting was in Vigo County, Indiana. "The first meetings were held in 1818 or 1819, in a log house in the north part of the town of Prairieton, which was built for a winter school. A log meetinghouse was afterward built in 1820, on the township line between Honey Creek and Prairieton townships."

Nathaniel Newlin of Spring Meeting, North Carolina, in the course of a religious visit in 1819 visited Lick Creek Monthly Meeting (Orange County, Indiana) and most of its subordinate meetings. On "Fifth Day 4th" of the Eleventh month, he writes, "traveled 8 miles and crost the Wabash at McClures abouve McCarters 30 miles, then 9 miles, in all this day 17, and lodged at Moses Hoggetts in the Indiana State.

"Sixth day 5th atended Honey Creek meeting dined at Moses Hoggats traveled 6 miles to Jeremiah Wilsons had a meeting there in the evening and lodged there. this day was remarkable smokey on account of the prairies being so much on fire. it was so smokey at noonday--altho clear--there was no shadow to be seen."

Hugh Judge gives an extended account in his journal of his visit to western Indiana in 1822. Prior to the following narrative, he and a companion had been at the Lick Creek and Blue River settlements of Friends.

"We crossed the east and west forks of White-river, about forty miles apart. On the west side of the west branch, we got into the wet prairies, in some places near a mile of water without intermission, and some of the way, very deep. In passing through one of these, my companion stopped, and immediately his horse sunk in the mud and water up to his body. On going a little further, we stopped to consider what was best to be done, as we appeared to be in danger of losing our lives or our horses; but our guide told us we were past the worst, and had better go on. After wading many rods further, we got to a little spot of solid ground; but this was small, and the prairie around us looked like a little ocean. There were three places so deep that our pilot's creature swam. Thus, wading mostly in water or mud, we got along nearly thirty miles to the settlement of Friends at Honey Creek. Here we attended their first-day meeting which was small, for the creek dividing Friends' settlements, was so high that none could cross it.

"29th (4th month, 1822). The creek being a little lower, we got over on an unfinished bridge, and were taken by a Friend in his carriage about fourteen miles to a settlement of Friends near Spring Creek; most of the way over prairie or glade land that was sandy, dry and rich. After staying a day and two nights with Friends, and having two meetings with them, we returned to Honey Creek, expecting to cross the Wabash to a preparative meeting, called Union, in the state of Illinois. The water being so high, we waited a day and visited some families; then attempted to cross the river which was falling, yet high. In going along the shore in order to get to a ferry, we were interrupted by great sluices of water which flowed out of the bed of the river on the low lands. Having crossed some of them, we came to one that appeared to be very deep, and our guide turned out into the woods where the water spread wider; we followed him, and after getting through two or three miserable places of mud, or rather quicksands and water, we came to one still worse, with limbs of trees in it. Our guide ventured in and got safe through, my companion also got through, taking care not to stir up the quick sand; but my creature sank among the limbs and sticks, threw me off, and in stuggling to get out, fell on me and buried me under the water. Thomas returned in the slough to my assistance, and helped me out; but I was much hurt, and apprehensive that some of my ribs were broken. We found a log on which we crossed the remainder of this quicksand, but soon found there was another before us. Thus we were hemmed in, as on every side; to attempt to go back the way we came was dreadful, and to go forward seemed impracticable. At length, we concluded to get near the bank of the river, and return if we could. Here we found a log that appeared to reach nearly across the main sluice that we had crossed. So we got on it, and our guide, Moses Hogget, on one side, and Thomas on the other, endeavored to steady me across on this log; but I fell off, the log being small and wet, and I wet also; they, however, caught me and with difficulty got me on the log again, and thus we got over safely. Thomas returning for the horses drove one through, and rode the other; and though the water was deep, it was not so bad as the sloughs.

"Thus, being rescued from the dangers of the water, with gratitude to our merciful Preserver we returned about two miles to a Friends house, where we changed and dried our clothes, and then rode about fourteen miles to Joshua Dick's, in a settlement of Friends near Terman's Creek, five miles from the Wabash river. Here we stayed all night, and next morning, the 4th of the 5th month, rode to the river through a heavy rain, with sharp lightning and the thunder rolling awfully over our heads. In this attempt to cross the river, we were also disappointed; for the ferry-man told us that if we got over it, there would be much deeper water for us to wade, or swim through on the other side. We therefore returned to Terman's Creek settlement, and had two meetings there on first-day. After this, hearing that the river had not fallen much, and being furnished with a guide, we returned by another route to Lick Creek..."

Charles Osborn made a trip through southern and western Indiana in 1826 and recorded his experiences in his Journal.

"Fourth-day, 22nd (Second month) --We left Indian Creek and traveled about thirty miles toward Honey Creek, on the Wabash; this day we crossed the west fork of White River.

"Fifth-day, 23rd --We pursued our journey; I having taken a cold, traveling tired me very much. This day we were mostly in the Eel River prairies; we arrived at M. H.'s (Moses Hoggatt's), in the settlement of Honey Creek, about sunset, having rode about thirty miles.

"Seventh-day, 26th --We attended Honey Creek Monthly meeting, I trust, to the satisfaction of Friends, though my mind was not so fully relieved as at some other places.

"First-day, 26th --We were at a public meeting at the above place, in which truth's testimony was exalted.

"From here we proceeded on, and had meetings at the following places, Viz: Union, in Illinois; Termin's Creek, Indiana; Spring Creek, Vermillion, Illinois; Leatherwood, Indiana. These settlements are along the Wabash, and the weather being wet, and the cold I had taken continuing for several days, it was a fatiguing time. We crossed the Wabash four times, and a number of creeks that were deep, being raised up with the great rains which fell.

Fourth-day, the 8th of Third month --We left the settlement of Leatherwood (which was new, the meeting was held in a Friends house) for White Lick..."

It is interesting to note the ages of these Quaker worthies at the time of their travels through the "west". Nathaniel Newlin (who later removed to the Bloomingdale community) and Charles Osborn were both fifty-one. Hugh Judge was seventy-two when he experienced the rigours above described.

Prior to the setting up of Honey Creek as a monthly meeting, Friends moving to that settlement had their certificates of membership sent to Lick Creek Monthly meeting (Orange County, Indiana). Honey Creek was established by the following minute from the records of Blue River Quarterly Meeting; held 15th of 7th month, 1820:

"The friends appointed to visit friends at Honey Creek on the Waubash on their request to have their meeting established on first day & weekday with the privilage of holding a preparative & Monthly meeting in congunction with friends on the west side of the Waubash, Report they have attended to the appointment to good Satisfaction and were free their request be granted with which this meeting unites & establishes the Same (to wit) the Monthly meeting to be held the second seventh day in each month & the preparative meeting to be held the fifth day preceding the Monthly meeting & be known by the name of Honey Creek Monthly meeting--Thomas Hadley, William Harned, Jonathan Lindley, Joseph Moore, William Lindley (of Salem), Joseph Cloud & Benjamin Albertson are appointed to attend the oppening of Said meeting in the 9th month next & report their Care to next Quarterly meeting."

Accordingly on the 9th day of the 9th Month, 1820, the first monthly meeting was opened and held at Honey Creek. The verge of this meeting at that time included all of western Indiana and the settlements in Illinois. Very soon Vermilion Monthly meeting, Illinois and Elevatis Monthly meeting in Parke county, Indiana, were set off.

Meetings set up under Honey Creek were as follows:

Turmins Creek meeting, indulged 1821; preparative 1827 and name changed to Fairland meeting. Located in Sullivan county.

Spring Creek meeting, indulged 1822. Location unknown - possibly Illinois. Vermilion meeting, preparative and worship 1823; set off a monthly meeting 1826. Located in Vermilion county, Illinois.

Leatherwood meeting, indulged 1826. Location unknown - probably Parke county. Elevatis meeting, preparative and worship 1826; set off as a monthly meeting

1827 and name changed to <u>Bloomfield</u> (later <u>Bloomingdale</u>). Located in Parke county, Indiana.

At the time of the Hicksite controversy, Honey Creek was seriously affected. The minutes of Blue River Quarterly Meeting in 1828 comment on "the sorrowful situation because of the spirit of insubordination on the part of some members of the meeting." Consequently the meeting was laid down and the Orthodox membership was attached to Bloomfield Monthly Meeting. The abstracts of records in Part One are comprised from:

PART TWO

After the Separation in 1829, Honey Creek Monthly Meeting continued as a Hicksite meeting. At this time monthly meetings were held alternately at Honey Creek and at Union, Crawford County, Illinois. The membership was scattered and the following subordinate meetings existed for a short time:

> Honey Creek Meeting, at Honey Creek Union, Crawford County, Illinois Turmins Creek, Sullivan County, Indiana Newberry Creek, Indiana "56 miles from Honey Creek" White Lick, Morgan County, Indiana Fairland, Sullivan County, Indiana

It would seem that by about 1855 Honey Creek Monthly Meeting was held all the time at Union, in Crawford County, Illinois. In about 1879 the meetinghouse at Prairieton "had ceased to exist... the building was destroyed a long time ago."

The following abstracts are from the records compiled by William Wade Hinshaw and now deposited at the Friends Historical Library, Swarthmore, Pennsylvania. They apparently are comprised from Men's and Women's Minutes from 1829 to 1874 and an incomplete Birth, Death and Marriage record. These abstracts were made for Hinshaw several years ago by Mrs. J. E. McMullen.

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

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Sketch of Honey Creek Meeting

At the outset let us clarify a common misconception. There are two meetings in Indiana with the name of Honey Creek, the one here under consideration and one in Howard County. The meeting in Howard County was established as a monthly meeting in 1846 and the name changed to New London Monthly Meeting in 1892.

The original Honey Creek meeting was in Vigo County, Indiana. "The first meetings were held in 1818 or 1819, in a log house in the north part of the town of Prairieton, which was built for a winter school. A log meetinghouse was afterward built in 1820, on the township line between Honey Creek and Prairieton townships."

Nathaniel Newlin of Spring Meeting, North Carolina, in the course of a religious visit in 1819 visited Lick Creek Monthly Meeting (Orange County, Indiana) and most of its subordinate meetings. On "Fifth Day 4th" of the Eleventh month, he writes, "traveled 8 miles and crost the Wabash at McClures abouve McCarters 30 miles, then 9 miles, in all this day 17, and lodged at Moses Hoggetts in the Indiana State.

"Sixth day 5th atended Honey Creek meeting dined at Moses Hoggats traveled 6 miles to Jeremiah Wilsons had a meeting there in the evening and lodged there. this day was remarkable smokey on account of the prairies being so much on fire. it was so smokey at noonday--altho clear--there was no shadow to be seen."

Hugh Judge gives an extended account in his Journal of his visit to western Indiana in 1822. Prior to the following narrative, he and a companion had been at the Lick Creek and Blue River settlements of Friends.

"We crossed the east and west forks of White-river, about forty miles apart. On the west side of the west branch, we got into the wet prairies, in some places near a mile of water without intermission, and some of the way, very deep. In passing through one of these, my companion stopped, and immediately his horse sunk in the mud and water up to his body. On going a little further, we stopped to consider what was best to be done, as we appeared to be in danger of losing our lives or our horses; but our guide told us we were past the worst, and had better go on. After wading many rods further, we got to a little spot of solid ground; but this was small, and the prairie around us looked like a little ocean. There were three places so deep that our pilot's creature swam. Thus, wading mostly in water or mud, we got along nearly thirty miles to the settlement of Friends at Honey Creek. Here we attended their first-day meeting which was small, for the creek dividing Friends' settlements, was so high that none could cross it.

"29th (4th month, 1822). The creek being a little lower, we got over on an unfinished bridge, and were taken by a Friend in his carriage about fourteen miles to a settlement of Friends near Spring Creek; most of the way over prairie or glade land that was sandy, dry and rich. After staying a day and two nights with Friends, and having two meetings with them, we returned to Honey Creek, expecting to cross the Wabash to a preparative meeting, called Union, in the state of Illinois. The water being so high, we waited a day and visited some families; then attempted to cross the river which wa's falling, yet high. In going along the shore in order to get to a ferry, we were interrupted by great sluices of water which flowed out of the bed of the river on the low lands. Having crossed some of them, we came to one that appeared to be very deep, and our guide turned out into the woods where the water spread wider; we followed him, and after getting through two or three miserable places of mud, or rather quicksands and water, we came to one still worse, with limbs of trees in it. Our guide ventured in and got safe through, my companion also got through, taking care not to stir up the quick sand; but my creature sank among the limbs and sticks, threw me off, and in stuggling to get out, fell on me and buried me under the water. Thomas returned in the slough to my assistance, and helped me out; but I was much hurt, and apprehensive that some of my ribs were broken. We found a log on which we crossed the remainder of this quicksand, but soon found there was another before us. Thus we were hemmed in, as on every side; to attempt to go back the way we came was dreadful, and to go forward seemed impracticable. At length, we concluded to get near the bank of the river, and return if we could. Here we found a log that appeared to reach nearly across the main sluice that we had crossed. So we got on it, and our guide, Moses Hogget, on one side, and Thomas on the other, endeavored to steady me across on this log; but I fell off, the log being small and wet, and I wet also; they, however, caught me and with difficulty got me on the log again, and thus we got over safely. Thomas returning for the horses drove one through, and rode the other; and though the water was deep, it was not so bad as the sloughs.

"Thus, being rescued from the dangers of the water, with gratitude to our merciful Preserver we returned about two miles to a Friends house, where we changed and dried our clothes, and then rode about fourteen miles to Joshua Dick's, in a settlement of Friends near Terman's Creek, five miles from the Wabash river. Here we stayed all night, and next morning, the 4th of the 5th month, rode to the river through a heavy rain, with sharp lightning and the thunder rolling awfully over our heads. In this attempt to cross the river, we were also disappointed; for the ferry-man told us that if we got over it, there would be much deeper water for us to wade, or swim through on the other side. We therefore returned to Terman's Creek settlement, and had two meetings there on first-day. After this, hearing that the river had not fallen much, and being furnished with a guide, we returned by another route to Lick Creek..."

Charles Osborn made a trip through southern and western Indiana in 1826 and recorded his experiences in his Journal.

"Fourth-day, 22nd (Second month) --We left Indian Creek and traveled about thirty miles toward Honey Creek, on the Wabash; this day we crossed the west fork of White River.

"Fifth-day, 23rd --We pursued our journey; I having taken a cold, traveling tired me very much. This day we were mostly in the Eel River prairies; we arrived at M. H.'s (Moses Hoggatt's), in the settlement of Honey Creek, about sunset, having rode about thirty miles.

"Seventh-day, 26th --We attended Honey Creek Monthly meeting, I trust, to the satisfaction of Friends, though my mind was not so fully relieved as at some other places.

"First-day, 26th --We were at a public meeting at the above place, in which truth's testimony was exalted.

"From here we proceeded on, and had meetings at the following places, Viz: Union, in Illinois; Termin's Creek, Indiana; Spring Creek, Vermillion, Illinois; Leatherwood, Indiana. These settlements are along the Wabash, and the weather being wet, and the cold I had taken continuing for several days, it was a fatiguing time. We crossed

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the Wabash four times, and a number of creeks that were deep, being raised up with the great rains which fell.

Fourth-day, the 8th of Third month -- We left the settlement of Leatherwood (which was new, the meeting was held in a Friends house) for White Lick ... "

It is interesting to note the ages of these Quaker worthies at the time of their travels through the "west". Nathaniel Newlin (who later removed to the Bloomingdale community) and Charles Osborn were both fifty-one. Hugh Judge was seventy-two when he experienced the rigours above described.

Prior to the setting up of Honey Creek as a monthly meeting, Friends moving to that settlement had their certificates of membership sent to Lick Creek Monthly meeting (Orange County, Indiana). Honey Creek was established by the following minute from the records of Blue River Quarterly Meeting, held 15th of 7th month, 1820:

"The friends appointed to visit friends at Honey Creek on the Waubash on their request to have their meeting established on first day & weekday with the privilage of holding a preparative & Monthly meeting in congunction with friends on the west side of the Waubash, Report they have attended to the appointment to good Satisfaction and were free their request be granted with which this meeting unites & establishes the Same (to wit) the Monthly meeting to be held the second seventh day in each month & the preparative meeting to be held the fifth day preceding the Monthly meeting & be known by the name of Honey Creek Monthly meeting -- Thomas Hadley, William Harned, Jonathan Lindley, Joseph Moore, William Lindley (of Salem), Joseph Cloud & Benjamin Albertson are appointed to attend the oppening of Said meeting in the 9th month next & report their Care to next Quarterly meeting."

Accordingly on the 9th day of the 9th Month, 1820, the first monthly meeting was opened and held at Honey Creek. The verge of this meeting at that time included all of western Indiana and the settlements in Illinois. Very soon Vermilion Monthly meeting, Illinois and Elevatis Monthly meeting in Parke county, Indiana, were set off.

Meetings set up under Honey Creek were as follows:

Turmins Creek meeting, indulged 1821; preparative 1827 and name changed to Fairland meeting. Located in Sullivan county.

Spring Creek meeting, indulged 1822. Location unknown - possibly Illinois. Vermilion meeting, preparative and worship 1823; set off a monthly meeting 1826. Located in Vermilion county, Illinois.

Leatherwood meeting, indulged 1826. Location unknown - probably Parke county. Elevatis meeting, preparative and worship 1826; set off as a monthly meeting 1827 and name changed to Bloomfield (later Bloomingdale). Located

in Parke county, Indiana.

At the time of the Hicksite controversy, Honey Creek was seriously affected. The minutes of Blue River Quarterly Meeting in 1828 comment on "the sorrowful situation because of the spirit of insubordination on the part of some members of the meeting." Consequently the meeting was laid down and the Orthodox membership was attached to Bloomfield Monthly Meeting.

PART TWO

After the Separation in 1829, Honey Creek Monthly Meeting continued as a Hicksite meeting. At this time monthly meetings were held alternately at Honey Creek and at Union, Crawford County, Illinois. The membership was scattered and the following subordinate meetings existed for a short time:

> Honey Creek Meeting, at Honey Creek Union, Crawford County, Illinois Turmins Creek, Sullivan County, Indiana Newberry Creek, Indiana "56 miles from Honey Creek" White Lick, Morgan County, Indiana Fairland, Sullivan County, Indiana

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It would seem that by about 1855 Honey Creek Monthly Meeting was held all the time at Union, in Crawford County, Illinois. In about 1879 the meetinghouse at Prairieton "had ceased to exist... the building was destroyed a long time ago."

The following abstracts are from the records compiled by William Wade Hinshaw and now deposited at the Friends Historical Library, Swarthmore, Pennsylvania. They apparently are comprised from Men's and Women's Minutes from 1829 to 1874 and an incomplete Birth, Death and Marriage record. These abstracts were made for Hinshaw several years ago by Mrs. J. E. McMullen.
