## Hebron Cemetery

This cemetery was in a very bad state of disrepair at time of copying. It was overgrown and weed-infested, many stones had fallen or were leaning. Throughout the entire cemetery, the weeds were waist high; in parts the weeds were taller than I! I'm sure there must have been some stones I missed due to its over-grown state.

In the August, 1959 issue of "The Cedar County Historical Review," which listed all cemeteries in Cedar County, this description of Hebron Cemetery is given: "Philip Simmermaker gave the land for this as well as the church site to the north. He is buried there as well as the Eli Auten family who have one of the most imposing marble monuments in the county." Sadly, this "imposing marble monument" can now hardly be seen for the weeds.
