




MAPLEWOOD CEMETERY Baker Township Section 24 Guthrie County Iowa

In the Recorder's office at the Courthouse in Guthrie Center in Book 85 page 22 will be found the following deed:

"John F Rollins and Addie E., his wife, of Polk County, Iowa to W H Mark for \$40 one acre of NW corner of NW_{ψ}^{1} NW_{ψ}^{1} Section 24 Township 79 Range 32 commencing 33 feet E of the NW corner of the above described land running E 16 rods then S 10 rods then W 16 rods then N 10 rods. Signed 13 Jan 1892"

An item on page 117 of <u>Guthrie County An Illustrious Past A</u>
<u>Great Future</u>, printed by the <u>Guthrie County Historical Society</u>,
says there are six or eight graves in this cemetery that no
one has been buried there for more than 50 years.

In the fall of 1983 Juanita Worsheck and Marilyn Turner drove to Baker township. They located the nearby schoolhouse, now used for hay storage and then follows a path through some trees. They found a small fenced in area surrounded by trees. This was well moved and one stone remains.



The stone read as follows: Henry Mark died 19 Feb 1882 aged 76y 3m 22d.

The History of Guthrie and Adair Counties 1884, page 689, says "old burying ground near #6 school. First death in township was wife of Joseph Fleak who died in latter part of 1855."

This cemetery should not be called abandoned in the sense of those other that are completely destroyed.

MESSINGER FAMILY CEMETERY Cass Township Section 12 Guthrie County Iowa

The Messinger Family Cemetery is abandoned and in no way now recognizable as once being a cemetery. It was located in the SW_{4}^{1} SW_{4}^{1} Section 12, Cass township.

In 1938 it was being farmed over except for a small plum thicket. Mrs Prince Colbert of Menlo removed the head stones from a rock pile and took them to Menlo to be stored. Mrs Colbert's maiden name had been Messinger so these were her ancestors. This was reported to us by Prince Colbert of Menlo, Iowa.

In 1938 the WPA under the direction of Ivyl Minary completed the project of copying Guthrie County cemeteries. A mimicograph copy was made and is referred to as the WPA Cemetery Book. (A copy is available for your searching at the Guthrie County Genealogical Library at the Jamaica Public Library in Jamaica, Iowa). It shows the following graves to have been in the Messinger family cemetery:

Jonathen son of M & M Messinger died 2-23-1855(Feb 23, 1855) aged 21y 5m 8d.

Joseph G Messinger son of M & A died 2-24-1861 (Feb 24, 1861).

Steven G, son of M & A died 6-5-1858 (July 5, 1858) age 14da. Cermantha daughter of M & A died 9-16-1856 (Sep 16, 1856) age ly llm 14 d.

History of Menlo, Iowa Centennial 1865-1969 on pages 62 and 103 tell that Princy and Herb H Colbert had a son Bernard who ran a grocery store in Menlo for about thirty years.

SUTTON CEMETERY Highland Township Section 19 Guthrie County Iowa

Sutton Cemetery is abandoned and not now recognizable as a cemetery. It was located in the SW_{4}^{1} SE_{4}^{1} of Section 19 Highland Township.

WPA records compiled in 1938 under the direction of Ivyl Minary indicates the following to have been buried in the Sutton Cemetery:

Isaac H Sutton 5-11-1874 (May 11, 1874) age 68
Mary Ann Sutton died 10-21-1874 (Oct 21, 1874) aged 44
wife of Elijah
Elijah son of Isaac - Civil War Veteran

The road was widened which hastened the demise of this cemetery. In 1938 it was reported that the headstones were in the hazelnut brush.

VANOCKER GRAVE Highland Township Section 34 Guthrie County Iowa

This single grave of a child was along the side of the road in the SE_{4}^{1} SW_{4}^{1} Section 34 Highland Township. No indication whatsoever of a grave now.

In 1936 when Ivyl Minary was compiling the WPA Cemetery Records, George Fell a county supervisor at that time, reported the location of this grave. The grave of Mary Vanocker who died 3-10-1879 (Mar 10, 1879).

SEELEY TOWNSHIP CEMETERY

Section 18 Seely Township Guthrie County, Iowa

In the Recorder's office at the Guthrie County Courthouse in Book 70 page 463 is a deed recorded 20 February 1886 between Henry Carothers and the Trustees of Seely Township.

"Henry Carothers (unmarried) of Guthrie County, Iowa in consideration of the sum of \$1.00 in hand paid by the Trustees of Seely Township of Guthrie County, State of Iowa do hereby sell and convey to the unto said Trustees of Seely Township:

Commencing 96 rods west of the SE corner of the $SE^{\frac{1}{4}}$ of Section 18 Township 80 Range 32, thence north 12 rods thence west 12 rods thence south 12 rods thence east 12 rods to place of beginning, containing 144 rods for cemetery purpose and none other. signed 23rd day of April 1880."

One hard surfaced route to Wichita Cemetery is to take county road #N70 at First Street in Guthrie Center and follow #N70 approximately six miles until it intersects with county road #F32 going west. #N70 proceeds north at this intersection. Proceed west on #F32 for approximately $2\frac{1}{4}$ miles. The Wichita Cemetery will be on the north (right) side of the road.



QUAKER/FRIENDS CEMETERY of the Spring Valley Meeting Section 26 Thompson Township Guthrie County Iowa

At the end of a lane on the west side of the Carl Kirkpatrick farm in Section 26, Thompson township (just north of the town of Casey) is located a small tidy Quaker cemetery.

Thomas B Chantry, a native of Lincolnshire England, who was a Quaker, or more properly called a Friend, settled here along the Middle River. In the spring of 1858 neighbors met at the Chantry home to organize the Spring Valley Meeting of the Society of Friends. Present were Thomas and Hannah Chantry, Elisha and Hannah Smith and Eliza Betts.

In 1866 these Friends built a meeting house in the center of the $SW_{4}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ of Section 26 on land donated by Chantry. The burial ground adjoined the churchyard. The first burial in this was Thomas Chantry. The meeting house was used for many years but now only the tidy tree shaded cemetery remains.

Information for the above was from an article written by Mrs Margaret Hays in December 30, 1972 issue of the Atlantic Farm Monthly published in Atlantic Iowa.

Included herewith is a county map as well as a township map which shows the location of the Quaker cemetery just north of Casey.

There are approximately ten short rows with space for sixteen stones in each row. The following information is a transcription of the genealogical data from these stones. Information in parenthesis is supplied by the copier. We began copying the stones at the west end of the cemetery, and read each row from north to south.

Following is the legend of abbreviations used:

STANFIELD CEMETERY Thompson Township Section 35 Guthrie County Iowa

Quoted from The 1884 History of Guthrie and Adair Counties on page 607: "This resting place for the hallowed remains of departed friends is located in Section 35. The land, one acre, was donated for the purpose by William Stanfield, and the first internment was that of Peter Tate."

In 1938 Ivyl Minary, project supervisor for the Work's Progress Administration, reported this cemetery as have a terrible appearance, being over grown with brush and poison ivy. At this time there seems to be no tangible evidence of the cemetery.

Dean and Phyllis Wright, members of the Guthrie County Genealogical Society located the following list of burials for this cemetery in the book *Middle River Homestead, on pages 60 and 61. The following is the list and we have added the comments from the WPA record following each entry in parenthesis:

March/April 1981 edition of the Americana Magazine states the following:

The beehive was originally a symbol of the Mormon Church, chosen to represent the industry and community spirit of the Mormon pioneers who arrived in Utah region in 1847. Since, then, residents of the state have put the beehive everywhere—on their houses, grave—stones, letter heads, furniture, china, quilts, clothes, route signs, and just about anything else.

UNION TOWNSHIP CEMETERY Section 15 Union Township Guthrie County, Iowa

The only record we located in the Recorder's office at the Guthrie County Courthouse was a record made by Mr. Ivyl Minary when he did the Graves Registration for the Iowa Department of Veterans Affairs in 1938. He noted the following information.

"Union Cemetery is located in the $NW_{4}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ $SW_{4}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ of Section 15 of Union Township. The township trustees at that time were Hans Michaelson, Harry Palmer, Oscar Trues and Walter McKinney. Vivian Cretsinger was the Secton."

History of Guthrie and Adair Counties, 1884 on page 731 and the 1907 Past & Present of Guthrie County page 162 both report the cemetery was laid out by A. McClaren, County Surveyor on April 23, 1880. The first burial was a child of C. B. Trues.

The most direct route to Union Township Cemetery is to leave Guthrie Center at First Street on Highway #N70 and follow it north for approximately six miles until it intersects with county hard surface road #F32 going west. #N70 will again turn north at this intersection. You will proceed west on #F32 for approximately six miles.



VANDEVANTER CEMETERY Victory Township, Section 22 Guthrie County Iowa

In older records this name is sometimes written Van Devanter/Van Deventer.


This cemetery was located in the $NW_{\overline{+}}^{1}$ SE $_{\overline{+}}^{1}$ of Section 23, Victory township on land owned by the Vandevanter family.

WPA records compiled in 1938 under the direction of Ivyl Minary indicates the following graves:

Rachel Vandeventer - buried 1853 Peter Vandeventer died Dec 1, 1860 age 39y lm 19d. Mary died 10 ? 1860 (Oct ? 1860)

Minary also stated: "thirteen graves accounted for"--however he lists only the three above. All stones have now been removed and the land is included in the Lake Panorama area.

The History of Guthrie and Adair Counties, 1884 on page 621 has an interesting report on the pioneer settler, Peter Vandevanter and his family who located on Section 23, Victory township in the spring of 1851.



VAN ORDER CEMETERY Victory township Section 22 Guthrie County Iowa

This family burial plot was in NE_{+}^{1} NE_{+}^{1} of Section 22 Victory Township and is now abandoned.

In 1938 when Ivyl Minary compiled the WPA Cemetery Records, he reported that John W Vandevanter, now living in the area of the cemetery said this field was being cultivated and no stones had been found. His knowledge of local history caused him to think the following three graves were in this cemetery.

John and Jacob Van Order, two brothers from South Bend, Indiana settled in Victory township on Section 22 in 1852. Supposedly Jacob, his wife Mary and child were buried in the family plot.

The Centennial History of Guthrie County published by the Guthrie County Historical Society lists of page 87, Mrs Jacob Van Order as the first death in Victory township.

Administration and Executors and Guardians Book 1 page 11 at the Guthrie County Recorder's office indicates that Jacob Van Order died November 9, 1869.

The following three deeds are in the Guthrie County Recorder's Office at Guthrie Center. They give the official history of the Victory Township Cemetery also known as the Victory Union Church Cemetery.

Book 85 page 83: John M. and Lizzie Byers of Douglas County Nebraska to Lyman N Russell, N W Patterson, John H Beck, Henry Snyder, J H Ball, trustees of the Union Church and Cemetery Association for \$1 - the south 16 rods of the East rods of $NE_{\frac{1}{4}}$ of $NE_{\frac{1}{4}}$ of Sec 20 Twp 80 R 31 - 2 acres for the church and cemetery. 12 Jan 1892.

Book 85 page 131: Ernest and Arminda Schmidt to same trustees \$1 for a parcel of land lying in the NE corner of $SE_{\frac{1}{4}}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ of Sec 20 Twp 80 R 31 for church and cemetery. 19 Feb 1892.

Book 85 page 172: Union Church and Cemetery Association to Trustees of Victory Township, Lyman N Russell, W L Camp and Alex Wheeler for \$1 - south 16 rods of east 20 rods of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 20 Twp 80 R 31 - 2 acres for a public cemetery only. Union Church and Cemetery Association signed by J H Ball, Matt Mallon, Henry Snyder, John H Beck, Lyman N Russell. 2 April 1892.

The Victory Union Church was built in 1892 and dedicated as a nondenominational church. William Earl Mallon, the eighteen month old son of Matt Mallon, was buried in September 1892 in the cemetery plot before the church was completed.

The church was used approximately forty years before the arrival of automobiles and good roads permitted the people to drive the distance to town to attend church. The church was sold and removed in 1936.

The cemetery is now maintained by the Victory township trustees.

Guthrie County An Illustrious Past A Great Future published by the Guthrie County Historical Society has a short item about this church and its early members on page 115.

To reach Victory Township Cemetery in Section 20 with the least travel on gravel roads: proceed north of Guthrie Center on Highway 25 for three miles, then turn east (right) on a gravel road and proceed for one and one-fourth mile, then turn north (left) and go for one-half mile then turn east (right) and go one-fourth mile, then turn north (left) and proceed for one-fourth mile. The cemetery will be on the west (left) side of the road.





Page 506 of the "History of Guthrie & Adair Counties, Iowa" published 1884 gives the following history for West Cemetery:

The beautiful "city of the dead" lying west of Panora was laid out in 1854. A touching incident relating to the selecting of the site is told to this day by such of the old settlers that survive the lapse of years. Conrad Brumbaugh, one of the committee chosen for the purpose, was talking idly with some of his neighbors, stopped short, and said as he turned away: "I must hurry and meet the graveyard committee; some of us may die, and there would be no place to bury us." The ground was chosen and marked out and a plat made, and in two weeks time his wife was laid to rest in the newly-made cemetery. Mrs Brumbaugh was the first buried here, her coffin made of rough boards or slabs, and the ground wherein she laid not fenced, or scarcely marked out.

Land records from the Recorder's Office in the Guthrie County Court House show the following land sold to Cass Township:

June 1857 Conrad Brumbaugh, Henry & Matilda Brumbaugh sold land for \$20 (Book B page 429)

Apr 1883 Henry & Matilda Brumbaugh sold land for \$125 (Book 67 page 23)

Nov 1927 Stella E & M W Morris sold land for \$500 (Book 219 page 531)

Dec 1946 Emory & Lois M Robinson sold land for \$900 (Book 281 page 250)

During the 1920's the Panora Legion began services honoring deceased veterans. This was held at the West Cemetery on Memorial Day. These services were conducted beside the 40 foot flag pole which has a GAR service marker at the top. This was a community activity with veterans, Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, Camp Fire Girls, the high school band participating. Since 1973 these services have been held at the town square.

A newspaper clipping dated April 24, 1941 relative to the West Cemetery: "Thousands of dollars worth of damage was done to Guthrie county farms in the vicinity of Panora Friday afternoon when a tornado swept a mile wide path of destruction from the west edge of town, northeast through the West Cemetery and arched off toward Jamaica."

The cemetery map shown on page v shows the cemetery as it appears at the present time. Blocks are arranged in the order in which the land was obtained.




The following information is a transcription of genealogical data from the stones in this cemetery. Parenthesis around a surname indicates the surname was not on the stone, but its proximity to identical style family stones led the copier to assume the surname to be as indicated. Although most surnames were verified through vital records, WPA or obituaries, the surname was left in parenthesis because it did not appear on the stone. Information found in parenthesis following an entry is supplied by the copier or is errata submitted by others. Anything underlined is information the copier was unsure about.

This revised edition includes corrections to the original publication, errata submitted to GCGS and additions up to fall 1989. In an effort to make as accurate a record as possible, Guthrie County vital records, WPA and newspaper obituaries were used to verify surnames and dates in question. Due to the deterioration of many stones, the copiers interpreted them to the best of their ability. A list of burials which was taken from the "Tombstone Records of Guthrie County, Iowa - Graves Registration WPA Project" shows burials of those for whom no stones were located in West Cemetery. This list is captioned "WPA Listings" and starts on page 44 of this publication.
