A life not spent in wain, being the testimony of the many he has befriended.

Burial services were conducted by the Rev. Finger of the M. E. church, Baker City, Nov. 10, 1908. Interment in Mt. Hope cemetery near Baker City where he has resided over forty years. The pallbearers being his intimate friends.

His many friends and relatives here mourn the loss of him who has been absent many years.

Abbott Brady was born Nov. 26, 1858 in Henry county, Ia. He was the son of William and Ann Brady both now deceased.
