DEATHS GIVEN AT 1895 PIONEER MEETING

As part of a newspaper page found loose in Minute Book, (not complete for year)

ARBOGAST

Henry Arbogast, aged 83 years, died February 3, 1895, at the residence of William Fletcher Sr. Mr Arbogast had been a resident of Harrisburg township for nearly 50 years.

BAIRD

John Baird was born in Somerset county, N.Y. in 1813. Moved to Iowa in 1841. He married Miss Elizabeth Bryant, of Indiana, who came to this county with him where they have lived and assisted in the upbuilding of this great state of Iowa from its infancy. He died April 11, 1895.

BEER

Thomas J. Beer was born in Bellville, Ill., October 3, 1825 and died at his home in Keosauqua, July 25, 1895 making his age almost seventy years. The citizens of Van Buren county all knew "Jeff" Beer. He was a kind-hearted and good citizen respected by all. He was considered one of the staunch friends of our Agricultural Society, being a lover of fine horses.

He was truly a pioneer, having lived in Van Buren county for more than 58 years. He leaves a wife, several sons and daughters and numerous friends to mourn his death.

DREW

William Drew was born in Tennessee, March 30, 1838, and came with his parents to this county when a child and grew to manhood in Van Buren county. He served his country valiantly in the late war in the 19th Iowa Infantry. He leaves a wife and many friends to mourn his loss.

STEEVES

John Steeves was born in New Brunswick, Canada, March 16, 1814, and moved to Ohio when 18 years age. In 1839, he married Miss Eliza Girt, and moved to Iowa and settled among the pioneers of this county about 1842. Mrs Steeves died February 3, 1846. Three children were born to them. Mrs

James Mathias of this county and John Steeves of Page county still living. In 1847 he married Miss Mahala Morris. Six children were born to them and with the widow mourn the loss of a kind husband and father. Mr Steeves was a consistent member of the Methodist church from early youth to the day of his death. Mr Steeves' earnest life as a christian and as an upright citizen has exercised a good influence. Among friends and neighbors he will be greatly missed. He died Nov. 19, 1894 and was laid to rest in the Pittsburg cemetery.

WATSON

William Watson was born Feb. 4, 1844, in Van Buren county. He moved with his parents to Oregon in 1851, where they resided until 1869, when they returned to this county and settled on a farm near Hillsboro. In 1871, he married Miss Anna Bailey, daughter of Mr and Mrs William Bailey, going to house - keeping on a farm near Wilsonville, where they resided until his death, March 10, 1895, making him a little over 51 years of age. Nine children were born into the family, all of whom remain at home, and with their mother mourn their loss.

Under the ministry of Elder J. B. Vawter, Mr Watson united with the Christian church in 1877. He was a patriotic, energetic and highly respected citizen.

WHITE

Mrs Hannah White, aged 75 years, died June 10, 1895, at her home near Mt Sterling, Iowa, of heart disease. She was born in Columbiana county, Ohio. In 1848 she was married to David White. She has lived in this county for 52 years. She was a member of the Christian church for 55 years and died in that faith. She was the mother of County Recorder Mathew White and a sister of Mr Harrison Blackledge of this place, Truly a grand pioneer mother has been called from among us.

WOODS

Alexander H. Woods was born in Virginia, near Wheeling, August 11 1808, and moved with his father's family to Wayne county, Ohio when he was eight years of age, and from there to Constantine, Mich., in 1829. He was married to Miss Elizabeth Meek in Michigan, January 13, 1831. They came to Iowa on January 11, 1897 and settled on a claim one and half miles north-east of Bentonsport where they made their home for about 58 years, and where he died. Eleven children were born to them two sons and nine daughters. Both of the sons, five of the daughters and his companion survive him. He died on Thursday, February 21, 1895 aged 86 years, 6 months and 10 days.

YEAGER

Mrs Chandler Yeager, aged 58 years, one month and 20 days, died at her home in Keosauqua, Friday, July 12, 1895. She was a lady highly esteemed by all with whom she was acquainted. Her first husband, Francis Cook, died the last year of the war. To them were born three children. In 1875, she was married to Chandler E. Yeager who still lives. She became a resident of Van Buren County in the early forties, probably 1838. She was a member of the Methodist church and active in all religious work. She suffered greatly for many months with the dread disease cancer which finally ended in her death. The funeral was held at her residence at which there was a large attendance.

BRADFORD

William Bradford, 82, he was born in Rhode Island and came to Iowa in 1843. His wife died a number of years ago. Thirteen children were born to them, six of who are living. Leander and Walter being residents of their county. Wm. Bradford was a good citizen and highly respected by his neighbors. He was kind and affectionate to family and friend. HOW THEY LIVED 500 YEARS AGO

Life in the 1500's may have been rather disgusting, but this era may be the source for some of the descriptive modern-day sayings such as:

"Don't throw the baby out with the bath water" – Families took their yearly baths in May. Baths equaled a big tub filled with hot water. The man of the house had the privilege of the nice clean water, then all the sons and other men, next the women followed by the children. Last of all, the babies. By then, the water was so dirty you could actually lose someone in it. Hence, the saying, "Don't throw the baby out with the bath water."

"It's raining cats and dogs" – Houses had thatched roofs – thick straw, piled high, with no wood underneath. It was the only place for animals to get warm, so all the pets – dogs, cats and other small animals, mice, rats, bugs – lived in the roof. When it rained it became slippery, and sometimes the animals would slip and fall off the roof. Hence the saying, "It's raining cats and dogs."

There was nothing to stop things from falling into the house from the roof. This posed a real problem in the bedroom where bugs and other droppings could really mess up your nice clean bed. So they found if they made beds with big posts and hung a sheet over the top, it addressed that problem. Hence, those beautiful big four-poster beds with canopies.

"Chew the fat" – Sometimes our ancestors could obtain pork and would feel really special when that happened. When company came over, they would bring out some bacon and hang it to show it off. It was a sign of wealth and that a man "could really bring home the bacon." They would cut off a little to share with guests and would all sit around and "chew the fat."

Trench mouth – Most people didn't have pewter plates but had a trencher – a piece of wood with the middle scooped out like a bowl. Trenchers were never washed, and a lot of times worms got into the wood. After eating off wormy trenchers, they would get "trench mouth."

"Upper Crust" – Bread was divided according to status. Workers got the burnt bottom of the loaf, the family got the middle and guests got the top, or the "upper crust."

"Saved by the bell" – England is old and small and they started running out of places to bury people. So they would dig up coffins and would take their bones to a house and reuse the grave. In reopening these coffins, one out of 25 coffins were found to have scratch marks on the inside, and they realized they had been burying people alive. So they thought they would tie a string on the wrist of the corpse and lead the string through the coffin and up through the ground and tie it to the bell. Someone would have to sit out in the graveyard all night to listen for the bell. Hence on the "graveyard shift," they would know that someone was "saved by the bell" or he was a "dead ringer."

Judge Uriah Beggs, died recently in the West. Was the earliest county surveyor of the county.

Mrs Esther Calhoun, died Sept 17, 1898 near Birmingham. Came with husband in 1839.

SUSAN CHILDS

Mrs Susan Childs, wife of Dr. Harvey Childs, died Jan 30, 1879. Came with her husband and settled in Bonaparte 1842.

MARY A. CLAYTON

Mary A. Clayton, died near Pittsburg, Van Buren county, July 17, 1878. Came to county in 1842. In 1843 was married to J. H. Clayton.

THOMAS B. CLIFFORD

Thomas B Clifford, died Aug 29, 1877, aged 91. Came to Van Buren County in 1840.

BUSHARD W. CRAVENS

Bushard W. Craven, --

JEREMIAH ELLIS

Jeremiah Ellis, died in Keosauqua, Feb 13, 1879. Came to Iowa in 1839.

GEORGE W. GAMES

George W. Games, died in Bloomfield. Born in Fredericksburg, Md. in 1812. Came to Iowa and settled at Muscatine in 1836. Came to Keosauqua in 1839.

DUDLEY HARDY

Dudley Hardy, died Sept 30, 1878. Born in New Hampshire, in 1803. Was near 75 at his death. He was twice a member of the Iowa House. He came to Iowa in June 1837, and made the first settlement at what is now Pierceville.

Mrs Sarah Hull, came to Van Buren County in 1844 from Pennsylvania She died in her 80th year

JEREMIAH JACKSON

Jeremiah Jackson, died Feb 13, 1879 aged 73. Was born in Maryland in 1806. Came to Iowa 1837.

MARGARET JOBE

Mrs Margaret Jobe, died in January 1879. Was born in 1798. Came to Iowa with her husband in 1836.

RUSSELL JOHNSTON

Russell Johnston, died Mar 5, 1878 in Keosauqua aged 34. Was born in Van Buren County April 16, 1843

ADAM KEPLINGER

Adam Keplinger, of Union Township, died April 18, 1878 aged 70. He had lived on the farm where he died since 1838.

MRS JOHN LINEWEAVER

Mrs John Lineweaver, one of the oldest settlers of Vernon Prairie died July 16, 1878

A. N. McCRARY

A. N. McCrary, born in Van Buren County, July 25, 1843, died in Des Moines Township, Feb 7, 1879. Was a son of Major and Mrs J. C. McCrary, and was a soldier in the war for the Union.

MATILDA McCRARY

Mrs Matilda McCrary, wife of James McCrary, died in Vernon Township, July 5, 1878 aged about 74. Came to Van Buren County in 183-. Was mother of the present Secretary of War.

Mrs McCRARY

Mrs McCrary, mother of your well known citizen, Mr Samuel McCrary, of Des Moines Township, died Jan 2, 1879, aged 94. She was born in Ireland and thought to be the oldest person in the county at the time of her death. She came to Van Buren County more than 36 years ago.

SARAH McMANAMAN

Mrs Sarah McManaman, a sister of Mr John Goodall, died Dec 18, 1877. Was born in Kentucky in 1811. Came to Iowa and Van Buren County in 1834.

DAVID MILLER

David Miller, died April 28, 1878, was born May 2, 1791. Was a soldier of the war of 1812. Came to Iowa in 1846.

JANE HUNTER MILLER

Mrs Jane Hunter Miller, was born in Stanton, Va., Nov 11, 1796. Married Thomas Miller Dec 21, 1820. Came to Iowa with her husband in 1842. Died Feb 28, 1879.

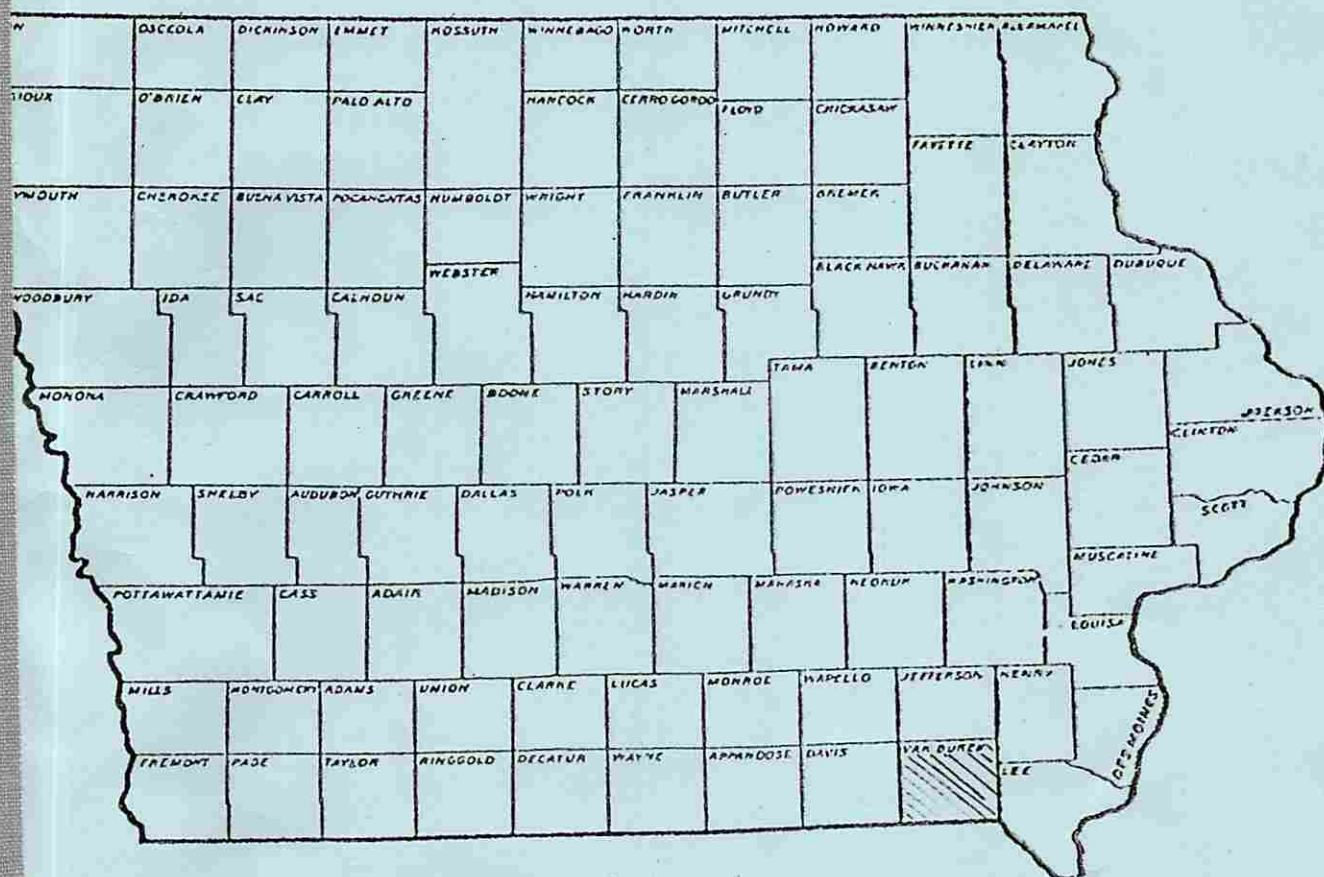
