FORWARD

Grayson County, Kentucky was founded in 1810, from parts of Hardin and Ohio Counties. Bounded on the north by Hardin and Breckenridge, on the east by Hart, on the south by Edmonson, and on the west by Ohio and Butler. It was named in honor of Colonel William Grayson, of the commonwealth of Virginia, and a distinguished politician and statesman.

Litchfield the County Seat, was named for Major David Leitch of Campbell County, who donated the land for the town.

On December 24, 1864 the courthouse was destroyed by fire, started by Confederate Soldiers; the courthouse was rebuilt and destroyed again by fire in 1896, rebuilt and destroyed again in 1936.

Virtually all the early records have perished with the courthouse fires. The courthouse has a few tax lists, and some early marriages.

Having collected miscellaneous material which can be found in this book, it is my hope this will aid researchers.
