


SOME CEMETERIES OF THE LITTLE SOUTH FORK COUNTRY, SOUTHEASTERN WAYNE COUNTY, KENTUCKY AND JASPER COUNTY, IOWA

The information contained herein has been obtained in connection with our genealogical research on the descendants of Washington Young of the Little South Fork Area of Wayne County, Kentucky. It is being compiled with the sincere hope that it will be of benefit to others, whose ancestors were early settlers of this section of the country. Considerable time has been spent in locating, visiting and copying these cemeteries. Some of them can be reached only by walking; some are not shown on any maps and their existance and location were made known through the kindness of the residents of the area. Many of the cemeteries were overgrown with briars, weeds and/or bushes.

A considerable number of people from the Little South Fork Country migrated to Jasper County, Iowa between 1860 and 1890, most of whom settled in the Rock Creek Township. I have visited several of the cemeteries in that county and included in this work will be found a complete listing of the Rock Creek Cemetery and a partial listing of the Antle and Our Silent City Cemeteries at Kellogg.

The name of the cemetery has been used when known. In cases where the local name has not been known, the name of the family or families with the most members buried there has been used for the purpose of identification. In three instances the cemeteries have been designated by number and so indicated on the map.

Copying has taken place over a period of years and any burials since the time of visit will not be included. Thirteen of the twenty-one cemeteries included were copied in total, two have a partial listing and the remainder are only named and located.

I am appreciative of the assistance and cooperation that have been received from many of the local residents and thank them for their kindness and consideration.

BETHEL BAPTIST CHURCH CEMETERY

The Bethel Baptist Church was organized in 1810 and is located at Parmleysville, Kentucky. Parmleysville is in southeastern Wayne County on the county road leaving highway No. 167 near Mt. Pisgah and running to Rockybranch and highway No 92. Raccoon John Smith was one of the earliest preachers at Bethel.

There were several graves, where the markers had weathered to the point that the names and dates could not be read. Some of these were coffin shaped stones lying on the graves. There were other graves marked with native stone and no identifying information.

CEMETERY No. 1

This cemetery was copied on February 12, 1974. At the time of this vist the cemetery had been cleaned up, with all the brush and vines removed. A new stone had been erected for Harmon Cooper. On a previous visit, which was made some six - seven years ago, his stome read, "Harmonaes Cooper." As noted on the map this cemetery is located on Highway No. 167, a short distance south of Mt. Pisgah.

This cemeter is located to the west of highway No. 167 and a short distance south of Cemetery No. 1. There is only one marked stone, and several unmarked ones;

This cemetery is located on the west side of highway No. 167, in the woods, very near the highway just before reaching the Tennessee Line. There are only six graves, two of which do not have engraved stones. Copied 1974.

HURT CEMETERY

The Hurt Cemetery is located on the right of the Blevins Hollow Road a short distance off of Highway 167. This cemetery was copied in 1971, at which time it was over grown with vines, and while a concentrated effort was made to copy all stones, it is entirely possible that some may have been lying on the ground and were missed. Descendants of Joel and Catherine Young Keeton, state that they are burried in unmarked graves in this cemetery.

MARCUM- CHRISWELL - SMITH CEMETERY

This is a reasonable size cemetery located on a logging road off of the Slagle Hollow Road. The Slagle Hollow Road is the first road to you left as you leave Cemetery No. II going to Monticello. None of the persons burried here appeared to be connected with the families on which I am working, so I did not copy this Cemetery.

This cemetery is located to the east of highway No. 167 between the Slagle Hollow and the Rice Hollow Roads. For the reasons stated above I did not copy this cemetery.

CEMETERY ACROSS ROAD FROM BETHEL BAPTIST CHURCH.

This cemetery is located diagonally across the road from the Bethel Baptist Church, beside an abandoned store. It was visited in 1973, but there does not appear to be any engraved stones here.

BLEVENS - DOBBS CEMETERY.

The Blevens - Dobbs Cemetery is located to the left of Langham Fork Road. It is located on a slight rise and several persons are buried here, but I did not copy the stones.

WASHINGTON YOUNG CEMETERY

Further up the Langham Fork Road (you probably will have to walk, if you go in this way) to the left of the road is the cemetery where Washington Young (the older) is buried, according to the older residents of the area. There were no engraved stones in this cemetery, but the writer had a modest stone placed at the graves of Washington Young, and his first wife, Sarah Adkins, in 1972. Originally there was a hand carved cedar monument at Washington Young's grave, but I am told that it was carried off by someone about twenty - five years ago.

The Mt. Pisgah Cemetery is located on the Mat Hurt Farm at Mt; Pisgah and is within sight of Highway 167. It was copied of February 12, 1974.

ROCK CREEK CEMETERY

The Rock Creek Cemetery is located near the Rock Creek State Park in the Rock Creek Township of Jasper County, Iowa.

Mr. LeRoy Adkins of Searsboro, Iowa told the writer in July, 1971, that the evergreen trees in this cemetery were brought from the Rocky Mountians by his grandfather, Alvin Adkins, on a return trip from California.

Many Kentuckians from southeastern Wayne and adjoining counties came to the Rock Creek Township in the latter half of the 1800s. Among them were the: Adkins, Kogers, Parmleys, Phipps, Keetons, Rices, Slagles, Youngs and possibly others. Many of these early settlers and their descendants lie burried in the Rock Creek Cemetery.
