INTRODUCTION

Queen Anne's County was formed in 1706 from parts of two older Eastern Shore of Maryland counties: Kent and Talbot. Persons using this book to find a will of an ancestor before 1706 should examine the Kent County volume. Kent County was formed in 1642. One should also examine the Talbot County will index book. Talbot County was established in 1662.

Queen Anne's County is fortunate to have a relatively good history written by Frederic Emory. Originally published as newspaper articles in the Centreville Observer, 1886-1887, these articles were published as a book: Queen Anne's County, Maryland: Its Early History and Development (Baltimore: Maryland Historical Society, 1950. 629 p.) The Wye Institute has issued a reprint in 1981. Chapter L, "Queen Anne's County," was written by Raymond B. Clark, Jr. and published in Vol. II of Eastern Shore of Maryland and Virginia (New York: Lewis Historical Publishing Company, 1950)


Introduction (Continued)

The names in this alphabetically-arranged index to Queen Anne's County Wills were taken from the 8-volume Maryland Calendar of Wills and James M. Magruder's Index of Maryland Colonial Wills, 1634-1777, and were doubly checked against the names in the early probate file at the Hall of Records at the Maryland State Archives in Annapolis, Maryland. The author of this volume examined the two Queen Anne's County will libers that compliment the state set of will volumes 1-41, at the Hall of Records, and those additional names found in this index are indicated by the Libers: WHN#1 and WHN#2.

Occasionally in the early will libers (volumes) an account or inventory is also included, in addition to the will. These additions when they occur are noted with the abbreviations of "Acct." and "Inv." in a () Parentheses after the name. There are also some instances in the spelling of either the surname or the Christian name or both. These instances are easy to identify for I have included them inside a () parentheses.

In rarer instances a place names is added to indicate more closely where the person who was making his will lived, e.g., Chester, Kent Island, St. Luke's Parish, St. Paul's Parish, Tuckahow (Tuckahoe). Another extra is the adding of either a title or designation or an occupation, e.g., brewer, carpenter, cordwinder, planter, school master, weaver, or Gentleman, Widow.

This index to Queen Anne's Co., Md. colonial wills, should become a handy reference guide to persons who left a will for posterity in this county in colonial Maryland. Anyone wishing to order a full copy of the complete will can write the Hall of Records with the name, date, and the necessary Liber and Folio (Volume and Page) references. Good luck in your genealogical researching.
