The names on this listing have been extracted from hitherto untranscribed Court Records of Somerset County, Maryland, for the period 11 March 1675 to 15 November 1677 (Old Style). At that time Somerset comprised all of present-day Somerset, Worcester, and Wicomico Counties as well as a large part of what is now Sussex County, Delaware. The major part of other currently available genealogical material for the area is taken from probate and land records, or from what vital records were maintained by the county. However, many did not own land, did not leave a will or sufficient estate to require administration, and did not have their births or deaths recorded. Many of them did serve on juries, were sued for debts, witnessed documents, or had their ages adjudged on arrival in the province as servants. For these and other reasons their names appear on the court records and quite possibly nowhere else.

The list which follows contains all of the more than eight hundred names which appear in the Somerset County Court Records for the period. When the record shows age, occupation, place of origin, or family relationship, that information is included.

## PLACE NAMES

In the absence of towns in the seventeenth century, locations were frequently described by the names of adjacent waterways. Some place names appearing in the text are listed below with brief descriptions for purposes of general identification. Reference to a good map is recommended for more specific detail.

Some English place names are found in the text. When there is a possibility of confusion (as in Dorset - now Dorchester County), the Maryland location is so indicated.

- Annamessex - hundred in southwest part of Somerset County.
- Back Creek - tributary of Manokin River.
- Boquetenorton - hundred on ocean side, now in Worcester County. Now usually written as Bogerternorton.
- Damned Quarter - on mainland adjacent to Devil's Island. These places are now known as "Dames Quarter" and "Deal Island".
- Manokin - hundred on bay side, north of Annamessex; also river.
- Monie - hundred between Manokin and Wicomico; also creek and bay.
- Morumsco - tributary of Pocomoke River.
- Nanticoke - hundred to north of Wicomico; also river; now in Wicomico County.
- Pocomoke - hundred in central section between Annamessex and Bogerternorton.
- Wicomico - hundred between Monie and Nanticoke; also river; now in Wicomico County.
