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INTRODUCTION

Wills are among the most important genealogical resources. The dates of signing and probate help to approximate the date of death — especially valuable in the absence of information from tombstones, church records, or newspaper notices. The signature or lack of it on an original document may provide clues to the literacy and state of health of the signer. The personal property mentioned in the will, such as a sword, family bible, or silver and gold objects provide clues to the life styles of the testator. Of course the family relationship and names of legatees in the document are of paramount importance in reconstructing the family group.

In Maryland when an individual died prior to 1776 there may well be three copies of the will (and other probate records). The first is the original copy which may have been deposited at the Maryland State Archives in Annapolis. The second is the copy of the will found in the county court house, and the third copy is that found in the records of the Prerogative Court, which were kept first at St. Marys City, then in Annapolis, and are now of course at the Maryland State Archives. Whenever possible all three copies should be consulted, with any discrepancies noted. The original will may be faded or cracked (due to having been folded), but may provide the proper spelling of a name miscopied by either the county clerks or those of the Prerogative Court. On the other hand, the copies may contain more legible writing than the original, which may have been written in haste by someone poorly educated or hardly able to hold a pen - or both.

The wills in this volume cover the years 1666-1742, and were copied from the original will books of Somerset county. The exact date the copies were made is not known, but in 1807 the General Assembly passed a law requiring Somerset and Worcester County clerks to split the books, and perhaps the Worcester County clerks, made this copy at about that time.

The wills are arranged in chronological order, and each abstract contains the name of the testator, the folio in the book on which the will begins, and the dates of signing and proving. The compiler has included not only names of legatees, but names of lands bequeathed. This will be of great assistance in identifying individuals of the same name.

This volume of early Worcester County wills will help to round out the calendar of wills abstracted for that county. Sharon Jones has abstracted Worcester wills of 1742-1758 and 1759-1769, and Ruth Dryden has published the abstracts of wills for the period 1769-1783, 1790-1799, 1799-1803, 1803-1807, 1806-1813, 1813-1822, 1822-1833, and 1834-1851.
