ESTLED in the mountains northwest of Pittsfield, Massachusetts, lies the Town of Hancock, a narrow strip of land nearly sixteen miles in length and about two in breadth. The first grant in town was to Asa Douglass, who became a settler in April 1762. Originally called Jericho, on account of the high natural walls on each side, formed by the mountains, it was renamed at the time of its incorporation in 1776 in honor of John Hancock, then president of the continental congress, and afterwards governor of the state.

Like its neighboring town across the state line, Stephentown in New York State, to whom it lost "a tier of fine lots, upward of half a mile in length in the reshuffle of the boundaries in 1787", it was an important settlement in the shifting of the population to "the west". Many families whose descendants extend from coast to coast sojourned here for a while during migration.

That is why the vital records of the town's earlier days are so important genealogically. These are inscribed in a little old ledger book of town records, and quite obviously were collected several years after the events occurred. As far as we know, they have never been published before. They were obtained by the editor on his recent New England trip.

Exeter, Hansoch Ins-The Searcher 1969-70



OME folks profess to be afraid to look up their ancestry lest they "find a horse thief", or worse. Others take great delight in discovering a bit of scandal to spice up their backgrounds. If you are one of the latter, and have Hull or Baker relationship in little Rhode Island, you might try the following on for size.

In those days there was no "Dear Abby" to hand out advice, but the Town Council certainly knew how to hand out the punishment when they met at Exeter on ye 8th of April in the year 1766, as witness the record of proceedings on page 20, Book No. 3, Town Council and Probate minutes:

"Present: Councilmen John Reynolds, Jr., John Gardner, Daniel Barber, John Chapman, Pedigreen Tripp.


"Whereas: Sarah Baker a Single woman hat(h) flung her Self and a male Bastard Child Born of her Body Called by the Name of Gardner Baker upon the Town of Exeter for their maintenance

"And so: therefore for the Releaf of Said Town that the Said Sarah Baker Be Immediately Bound out to Oliver Hull of James Town for the term of five years, and his child Caled Gardner Baker Is to be Bound out to Said Oliver Hull for the term of Nineteen years and three months—Which is until Said is Twenty one years old and the said Oliver Hull agreed with this Council to Larn said printice to Read and write and at the Experation thereof to Give him all his warring apparil and Otherwise according to his Behavour."

This particular old record book makes delightful reading. It was tucked away, almost forgotten, in a dusty corner. Published it would give an intimate insight of the people of the period, and might even make a best seller. The laconic old town clerk certainly could write, even though he couldn't spell.

Old Pink Brick Meetinghouse



HE "Morris Church", as it is called in Cedar Grove, West Virginia, is a local historic landmark. It stands among ancient trees and the unmark-

ed graves of the pioneer settlers who sleep beneath them. It is near Kelly's Creek, on U.S. Route 60, originally called the Midland trail.

The old edifice was built in 1853 on or near the site of the original "Morris Church". It was constructed of pink brick by William Tompkins, who mainly used slave labor.

The plaque on the boulder at the front is in honor of William Morris, Sr., and is inscribed with the following:

In Honor and Memory of WILLIAM MORRIS 1722 - 1792

Founder and Defender of Fort Morris
The First Fort Built on the Great
Kanawha River in 1774, Near this Site.
He also Built the First Church and
Schoolhouse, and Made
The First Permanent White Settlement
In the Great Kanawha Valley
And of His Wife
ELIZABETH STIPPS
1729 - 1795

At the right of the door of the church is a plaque honoring William Morris, Jr., inscribed with the following:

In Honor and Memory of

1746 - MAJOR WILLIAM MORRIS, JR. -1802
Revolutionary Soldier

Wounded at the Battle of Point Pleasant
Oct. 10th, 1774
And of His Wife

1751 - CATHERINE CARROLL -1823

There are two identical headstones near the church, with names and dates long erased by time. William, Sr., and his wife Elizabeth are supposed to lie beneath these stones...or did. They were strong Baptists, and the church has been in the possession of the Southern Methodists for many years. They may have gotten up and moved!

William Morris, Sr., was born in London in 1722. He came to Philadelphia by himself when about twelve years of age, or thereabouts. Old Court Records in Augusta County, Virginia, point a finger at this ancestor as being the William Morris who went aboard a ship due to sail for America and failed to get off before it left the dock.

He married Elizabeth Stipps of Orange County, Virginia, in 1746, then lived in Culpeper County, where they reared most of their family of eight boys and two girls. In 1774, with his family, some with wives, he went over the mountains and settled where the town of Cedar Grove, West Virginia, is now located. (Note: Augusta County, Virginia, was formed from Orange County in 1745, Culpeper from Orange County in 1748).

Walter Kelly from North Carolina had settled here only a short time. Warned that the Indians were restless, he sent his family back. Early in 1773 Kelly and a negro servant were killed. A Colonel Field, who had stopped over with him, made his escape. Although two of his granddaughters were captured by the Indians while bringing in the cows and were scalped, William Morris, Sr., with his large family, all well trained to use the musket, came to stay, and stay they did!

William Morris, Sr., died in the latter part of 1792. His will was proved in January of 1793. —LESTER H. HILYARD of Long Beach, California, Descendant, Sixth Generation.

Exeter Road Menders - R.I.

HESE entries in the Town Record Book of Exeter, Rhode Island, would appear to constitute a "1765 Census" of that locality, predating the 1774 Census of Rhode Island ordered by the General Assembly by nine years. To our knowledge they have never before been published. "At a Town Council (Meeting) held at the home or dwelling house of Capt. John Reynolds in Exeter the 18th day of January 1765, ordered that several squadrons for mending the highways be set off as follows:"
