In this deed, Mary Mitchell is called the mother of Edward Mitchell, with no qualifying clause such as "mother-in-law," used at that period in time to denote "step mother." Therefore, he and the children, who were born after him, are the children of Experience Mitchell by his second wife, Mary, whose parentage is unknown, and Edward, John and Hannah Mitchell are not entitled to claim descent from Francis Cooke of the *Mayflower* through his daughter, Jane (Cooke) Mitchell.

Strongsville, September 9, 1855

Dear Brother

I seat myself once more to write to you to let you know that through the goodness of God we are all as well as usual except bad colds. We received your letter dated 22 May " and was very glad to hear from you. I began to write to you on the 5th of July but was not able to finish it. I confess I have been very neglectful or I should have wrote before now. Last week we received another letter from you dated Aug. the 20". We was very sorry to hear that you had been sick but sick or well we want to hear from you often. you wrote about coming here. we should be very glad to see you here again and your children with you. Abram Beebes health is very good and has been all summer. Hollis Newton and his family is about as they was when you were here. Hannah Hicks has gone to Michigan. I don't know whether she will come back this fall or not. Robert N. Fuller and family was real well the last I heard from them. All the rest of our relatives and friends here are well. Nelson Hawkins, our son in law lives at Columbia Station where he did when you was here. Your Brother John and Sister Nancy lives in the west part of this State. John went to Michigan but did not like it. he said it was to cold for him. Our children live in Michigan was all well last month. Robert Fuller received a letter from Garret Fuller in Iowa. He wrote that your son in law Hubbel was going to settle by him. We should like to know if they have gone there. My head feels so bad I shall have to stop writing. We remain you affectionate Brother and sister.
