

LICENSED INNEEPERS AND RETAILERS OF SPIRITUOUS LIQUORS IN THE TOWN OF GLOUCESTER BETWEEN THE YEARS 1783&1835

The following list was compiled from loose, handwritten, papers held in the Archives at City Hall in Gloucester, Massachusetts. [BV#3 CC63 Box 25 FF2]

These records are incomplete covering only the years 1783, 1799, 1800, 1805 to 1808, 1812 to 1814, 1817 to 1821, 1831 to 1833, and 1835. There is an undated page that I infer from the names belongs between the years 1800 and 1805. It is referred to as 'No Date' in the listing.

Some of the pages are a neat, more-or-less alphabetical, listing of names divided into Innholders and Retailers, and signed by the Selectmen. These are probably copies of the documents presented at the County Court of Sessions for registration. They often include a formal attestation as to the worthiness of the applicants. For example, four of the papers contain wording identical to this quote from 1800: "... to the best of our knowledge, the following Persons named therein have maintained good rule and order in their respective houses & shops, and have conformed to the laws and 'regulations respecting Licences' persons, and are firmly attached to the Constitution and Laws of this Common Wealth." Similarly three of the early documents include the same statement as this from 1805: "...recommend the aforesaid Persons to be of sober lives and Conversation suitably qualified and provided for the Exercise of such an employment."

Others pages are rough working drafts listing the previous year's license holders and new applicants. These often have names crossed out or marked with an X indicating those that didn't reapply or were denied for some reason. The 1806 rough draft is especially informative as it includes the approximate locations of most of the enterprises.

The dates of the documents are rather erratic at first, occurring anywhere from April to July, but by 1807 have settled into a pattern where the list is compiled in either August or September for a license running from the following October to October of the next year.

By 1813 a simple printed form was being provided by the Court for the Selectmen to complete and return. It starts: "TO THE SELECTMEN OF (then a space for the name of the town to be filled in) WITHIN the last year, the following persons were licensed in the town of .." The rest of the page is blank until near the bottom where it states the place, the date and to whom the form must be presented.

By 1818 the law required that the Selectmen decide how many innkeepers and retailers were actually "... necessary for receiving and Refreshing travellers and Strangers & to serve the publick occasions of said Town, or are necessary for the publick good." In that year the Selectmen found ten innholders and forty-one retailers necessary; by 1835 this number had been reduced to seven innholders and seventeen retailers.

There were occasional objections made about an applicant. In 1818 a group of seven citizens wrote a letter protesting the approval of a Tavern license for Henry Wilson of

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Sandy Bay. In their opinion his shop had been a "seat of considerable disturbance since he opened it." However, he also had supporters, six of them signing a letter recommending approbation. The Selectmen apparently agreed with the latter as Mr. Wilson was issued an innholders license for this and the following year.

The penultimate document, dated March 6, 1837, is a request that a town meeting be called to vote "To instruct the Selectmen to approbate no persons for licences, the ensuing year," and to form a committee to prosecute anyone who broke this injunction. It is signed by twelve citizens, at least one of which was a former license holder of several years' standing.¹

The final document in the collection, dated September 2, 1868, is a letter to "Gentlemen," presumably the Selectmen, from the Clerk in Salem informing them of the date set for the hearing on Geo. W. Floyd's application for an innholder's license.

1: At a Town Meeting held Monday March 27, 1837 it was voted to accept the resolve "that the Licence Laws relating to the vending of ardent Spirits, Wines etc. now in force in the Commonwealth, are unnecessary & unjust, & that our Representatives in the Legislature now setting at Boston be requested to petition the said Legislature for a repeal of the same." Two other articles in the warrent viz: "To instruct the Selectmen to approbate no persons for licences the ensueing year." and, "To instruct the Selectmen to forward a copy of this vote to the County Commissioners, with a respectful petition on behalf of the Town, that no such license be granted in this town." were both indefinitely postponed.
