St Patrick's Cemetery in Lowell was opened in 1832 and records of the purchase of grave plots and also of burials are available from 1832. Shane McAteer and Brian Trainor were taken on a conducted tour by State Senator Paul Sheehy on a wet and windy morning in March 1998 and noted a few inscriptions where places of origin in Ireland were given. A brief history of this burial ground by Dave McKean will be published in next year's Directory.

Erected by Hannah Hurley in memory of her husband Dennis died January 1874 aged 49 years, native of Barry's Point, parish of Lislea, Co. Cork, Ireland [and] their children John and Mary Ann, [Kane?] and Ellen and Dennis and James and Hannah Hurley.

Erected by [?] and Hattie Ca[rroll] in memory of their father Patrick Carroll died December 8 1872 aged 64 years, native of County Meath. "May his soul rest in peace".

In memory of Peter McCaffrey died January 6 1872 aged 71 years and his wife Roseann died September 16 1875 aged 75 years, native of the parish of "Drumraw", [Drumragh] County Tyrone, Ireland.

John Leehey died July 3 1855 aged 26 years, native of the parish of Dingle, County, "Curry", [Kerry] Ireland. "May their souls rest in peace". Also his brother Jeremiah died March 5 1875.

Patrick O'Neil native of County Kerry, Ireland, died September 27 1850 aged 37 years.

[Erected by] Mary Doyle in memory of her husband William Doyle who died June 26 1858 aged 52 years. Also his brother Daniel Doyle who died June 2 1853 aged 44 years, Catherine his daughter who died August 22 1858 aged 14 years, natives of Carigtwohill [Carrigtobill], Co. Cork, Ireland. "May they rest in peace."

Ellen Corrigan buried this January 27 1859(?) aged 23 native of Rosselea [Rosslea Clones], County Fermanagh, Ireland.

IHS James Loughran Esq. in memory of his wife [?]... Colper(?)

There is a larger monument nearby bearing the following inscription:

James Loughran died July 26. 1876 aged 55 years, Elizabeth Loughran wife of James Loughran died October 25 1908 aged 77 years.

IHS Patrick McDonnell died January 29 18[] aged 12

years, native of the County Roscommon, Ireland.

Erected by Bridget McCue in memory of her beloved husband Edward McCue a native of the County Fermanagh, Ireland, who died December 22 1848 aged 50. Requiescant in pace. Bridget his wife died March 10 1876.

Bridget Barry erected this stone in memory of her husband Patrick Barry who died in November 1838(?) aged 35 born in Dungarvin, [Dungarvan] County Waterford, Ireland. Also their two children both named Mary aged 3 and 1 year.

Sacred to the memory of Hannora Kennedy wife of Thomas O'Connell who died May 20 1838 aged 28 years, a native of "Ounasca" (?), County Kerry, Ireland, her son Daniel died June 14 1836 aged 1 year and 5 months, also Mary Ann their daughter died October 29 1837 aged 2 months. "May they rest in peace, amen."

John Moran died June 29 1844 aged 49, Margaret his wife died November 23 1835 aged 30. Also their four children James died August 8 1833 aged 10 years, Dennis died November 21 1831 aged 5 years. Ellen died December 7 1832 aged 2 years 6 months. Mary died July 13 1830 aged 3 years. Born in Dingle, County of Kerry, Ireland. "May their souls rest in peace, amen". Erected by their only surviving son Patrick.

In memory of Mary wife of John Martin of the barony of De Courcy (?) in the County of Cork, Ireland, she died on the 14th February AD 1834 aged 34, also their daughter Nelly aged 7. "May they rest in peace".

In memory of Catherine wife of James Mahoney who died December 29 1849 aged 49, a native of Kinnagh, (?) Co. Cork, Ireland.

IHS. In memory of Peter O'Riley who died June 18 1839 aged 58, a native of the parish of Cloone, County of Leitrim, Ireland, who died May 25 1833 aged 63 years.

IHS Sacred to the memory of Ann Rielly wife of James Rielly a native of the parish of Cloon, County of Leitrim, Ireland

William Quin died [], native of Drumna[Drumagh?], County Tyrone, Ireland, died November.

Erected by Michael Devlin in memory of his brother Joseph who died July 12 1864 aged 49, a native of the parish of Lower Bodoney, County Tyrone, Ireland, also Rosanna daughter of Joseph and Elizabeth Devlin died February 4 1867 aged 1[3?] years and 9 months, Joseph died September 22 1871 aged 15 years.
