LIMA CENTER BURYING GROUND
 Washtenaw Co., Michigan

This is one of the older cemeteries in the county, and it contains the graves of many of the Washtenaw pioneers. The cemetery is located on Lima Center Road, two miles north of the Chelsea-Dexter Road, and about three and a half miles east of Chelsea.
