DECLARATIONS OF INTENT, RECORDER'S COURT, DETROIT MICHIGAN 1888-1895 CONTRIBUTED BY PATRICIA IBBOTSON OF DEARBORN, MICHIGAN

The following Declarations of Intent are in six bound volumes in the Burton Historical Collection of the Detroit Public Library. The records below were taken from Volume D, M/S 4M. Records from Volume A 1860-1868, were published in *DSGRM* Volume 65:16-19; 58-61; and 112-115. Records from Volume B 1868-1884 were published in *DSGRM* Volume 66:16-19; 61-64; 114-117; and 160-164. Records for Volume C 1884-1888 were published in *DSGRM* Volume 67: 17-21; 63-66; 114-117; 159-164. The place for all is Detroit, Wayne County. The clerk of the court was George H. Lesher until 1893. Then deputy clerks were Charles R. Bagg, F.R. Fenton and Wm. W. Monaghan. The information includes the date of declaration, name and country to which allegiance is being renounced. This was a period of heavy immigration; 250 German men declared intent on April 23,1890.
