Dakota County Records at the Minnesota Historical Society Archives and Manuscripts Division, 1500 Mississippi Street, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101

The following is a brief description of some holdings of the Archives and Manuscripts Division of MHS that pertain to Dakota County. Some items are available on interlibrary loan. Most records may be viewed and photocopied by researchers but data privacy laws apply to some. contact MHS in person, by mail, or at (612) 296-6980 for complete information.

For a listing of Dakota County-related holdings, check 1) the binder on the wall shelves labeled "Dakota County," and 2) the card catalog. Here are some examples of what you will find:

Register of Deeds: Treasurers' Bond Record Book, 1866-1879: Bonds of village and township treasurers

County Auditor: Registers of claims against the county for services rendered, such as juror, witness, boarding prisoners, etc.

Tax lists, 1880-1971 (for some cities)

- Motor vehicle index, 1919-1921. Alphabetical by owner; gives seller's name, description of vehicle transferred
- District Court Civil & Criminal Case Files, 1853-1937. Some indexed by name of defendant
- Coroner's Records, 1887-1970's Register and record of coroner's inquests, 1887-1955

Index to coroner's certificates, 1950's-1970's

Forfeited real estate tax judgment book, 1900

Indictments - criminal cases, 1918-1914 and 1927-1934 Court minutes

- Naturalization index, 1855-1939 (can buy or rent microfilm)
- Naturalization records, 1854-1943 (can buy or rent microfilm)
- Record of certificates of conviction in justice court, 1903-1911. Indexed

Probate court: Administrators and Guardians Record, 1858-1872

1918 Alien Registrations: Public safety Commission Records

Also at MHS Archives & Manuscripts are the 1918 alien registrations for all of Minnesota, including Dakota County. There is an every-name alphabetical card file index. Check the card file for the name of your alien (i.e., not a naturalized citizen) ancestor; it will give you the county and city of residence in 1918. Check the "Public Safety Commission" binder on the wall shelves to determine the location and box number for that county and city. Forms are filed in folders in alphabetical order by surname.

The alien registration form is a two-sided questionnaire which was completed and signed by the immigrant and may provide a great deal of information of help to family historians, such as date and place of birth, date and place of arrival in U.S., whether letters of intent had been filed, whether any property was owned, and names of family members - including children - here and abroad.
