*Note: Jones Co. MS. was formed in 1826 from Covington and Wayne Counties. It was not a major cotton growing area, thus there were few slaves, (164 in 1840, 274 in 1850, and 407 in 1860.) Most of the Indians had moved further North by 1805. Since slaves had no last names then, I assumed that they later "adopted" the surname of their last, or previous owner.
