QUERY ANSWERS

A-1012: HESTER. The following may be a clue to query. . . Ida Lanier, daughter of Lemuel Lanier, born 1785, married in Effingham County, Georgia, 9 September 1806 to Edward Hester, who was born in Georgia. They moved to Lawrence County, Mississippi before 1814, were in Hinds County, Mississippi before 1830, from which place he disappeared with a family of five sons and two daughters. (Reference: LANIER GENEALOGY by Louise Ingersoll). Rebecca Harvy wrote her will 31 May 1854 in Hinds County, Miss. naming "her neighbor" William Hester as an executor. An examination of the 1860 Census of Hinds County and that of the 1860 Census of Harrison County, Mississippi might show some Hesters of interest. KPWE

A-1006: MARBLE-CALDER-SMITH. Alexander Calder, born New York (state-?), 1806 married Luanza Marble, who was born in Mississippi, 1812. They moved to Texas in 1839. (Reference: HAYS COUNTY HISTORICAL AND GENEALOGICAL QUARTERLY, Volume II (1968), page 35.) . . . MARBLE, Adama County, Mississippi - Family from New York State and settled in or near Washington, Adams County, Mississippi. The father soon died, and several sons moved to the vicinity of Spring Hill. Abner Marble married Rachel Hamberlin. Another was Theophilus Marble (Ref. METHODISM IN MISSISSIPPI, Jones) Thomas Marble and Elizabeth Jones were married in Jefferson County, Mississippi (Book A, Page 78). KPWE
