NATURALIZATION RECORDS

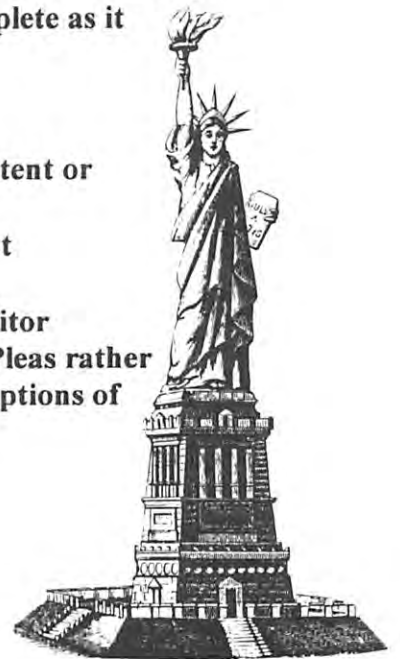
According to the book "Researcher's Guide to American Genealogy", children under 16 acquire citizenship through the naturalization of their parents, and between 1855 and the Cable Act of 1922, a woman automatically became a citizen either by marrying a citizen or by the naturalization of the husband. This wasn't always true, however. Prior to 1855 it was the rule that an American woman, upon marrying a person of foreign extraction, automatically became a citizen of her husband's country. Therefore, if her foreign born husband never became a naturalized citizen of the United States, she was not a citizen either.

There are two documents required of a prospective citizen. The first is called the Declaration of Intent, which usually gives the name and age of the applicant plus the country in which he was born. This Declaration of Intent can be filed when a person has been a resident of the US for 5 consecutive years. He must submit proof that this is true. He must also submit a form stating what ship he sailed on, where it sailed from, on what date, where it landed, on what date. The second document is called the Petition for Naturalization and contains much information for the genealogist, such as birthdate and birthplace, last foreign residence, current residence, date and port he immigrated from, date and port he landed in US and name of vessel he sailed on, physical description of complexion, height, weight, color hair and eyes. Wife's name and birthplace, children's names, birthdates and birth places and where they reside. Other requirements are that applicant must have resided continuously within the state naturalization is sought for at least one year from the date of Declaration of Intent to date of Petition for Naturalization.

Following is a partial index of Naturalizations filed and/or granted in Platte County. This list was gleaned from several places and probably is not as complete as it should be, but is the best information we have to date.

- If age is shown the entry is a Declaration of Intent date
- If no age is shown it is unknown if entry is Declaration of Intent or Petition for Naturalization
- * denotes Intent, Petition and/or Admission in one document
- ** denotes intent only written in full
- Note: * and ** I have transcriptions of in my files. Editor
- WCCP denotes Intent found in Weston Court of Common Pleas rather than Platte County Circuit Court. Editor has transcriptions of these on file also.
- (I) denotes Intent
- (N) denotes Naturalization

The first church building erected in Edgerton was the M. E. Church, South, and the first school building was erected just east of the Southern Methodist Church.

Edgerton has had her full share of fires during the history of the town. The first fire of any importance was the burning of Black & Holland's store near the railroad. The second fire that visited the town caught in the general store of Boydston & Fields and soon spread to a few adjoining buildings.

The third, or great fire, visited Edgerton the morning of Nov. 18, 1891 when the larger part of the business portion of the town went up in smoke. In this fire three general stores, two drugs stores, one furniture house, the printing office and the hotel were all in the track of the flames.

There have been several minor fires that have been quite disastrous to those concerned but Phoenix-like, in every fire that has visited us, the town has risen from the ashes to building better and bigger, and while the visitation has brought loss and hardships on those who were immediately concerned, yet every fire has been turned into a blessing for the new town. These principal events are given as a matter of history, and to show by comparison the changes that have taken place in 30 years.

Many who participated in these events have passed away, many have sought other homes, and there are a few men and women with us still who took an active part in the upbuilding of the city, notable among these early settlers that are now with us, we find the names of J. H. Handley, H. Wilkerson, T. J. Doke, Dr. W. W. Shafer, H. Johnson, and many others, whose public life has been closely identified with the upbuilding of our town.

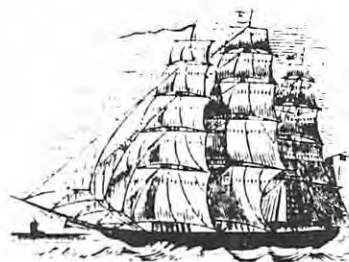
