WESTON COURT OF COMMON PLEAS

In working with documents from the Weston Court of Common Pleas, Louise Jackson came across the following items of interest. She also found some documents referring to Naturalization. These are included in another article in this *BULLETIN*.

FRONAX, JACOB, Pvt. of Capt. John H. Burt's Co. 39th Regt Enrolled Missouri Militia (EMM),

enrolled 28 July 1862, discharged 8 Sept 1862 at Platte City for reason of being unfit.

Born Switzerland, age 45 years, light complected, grey eyes, sandy hair, a farmer.

Dated 5 Sept 1862.

FRANK, JACOB, Pvt of Capt. Gunther's Co. G. 39th Regt. EMM enrolled 1 Aug 1862. Discharged

22 Sept 1862 at Weston by reason of "inability".

OVERBECK, WILLIAM J., 2 Nov 1880 received 939 votes and won election for Sheriff of Platte

County, MO.

RADICK, JOSEPH indicted for misdemeanor of "gaming by battery on a game of pool". John

Whitten put in \$100 as security Sept. 1869. Security forfeited as they did not appear at

the November Term of Court 1869. Recalled for March Term 1870.

PETER FABER and PETER SCHLICK of Canandaigua, Ontario County, New York presented

their affidavits dated 8 Sept 1857 stating they were acquainted with HENRY SCHLICK,

a native of Bavaria, born 1835 at Rockenhausen, Bavaria. That he immigrated to New

York about 7 Jan 1849 and currently resides at Weston, Platte County, MO.

SPOTTSWOOD THOMAS married MISS ELIZABETH CRANWELL in Platte County at the

Methodist Episcopal Church South 13 June 1846. Stephen P. Heath, Minister

(Note: This bride is shown in our PCHS marriage books as Culwell, Miss)
