Muster Roll of Company C, 11th Missouri Militia

Transcribed and submitted by Barbara Larson

This Muster Roll is of Company C of the Eleventh Infantry, Missouri Militia, 16 July 1863 to 16 April 1864. Captain John D. Merten was the captain in charge of Company C and it was his family that recently discovered these papers in the back of a desk drawer. Prior to a recent family reunion the papers were sent to me, the family genealogist, instead of throwing them away. The originals have since been donated to the Missouri Historical Society Library.

1780 St. Louis Militia Rolls

Robert Parkin, co-founder of St. Louis Genealogical Society in 1967, donated his papers to the Society many years ago. While sorting, filing, and indexing those papers, we found this list of the men who defended St. Louis in the battle of Fort San Carlos, the only American Revolutionary battle west of the Mississippi.

The list includes the names of the participants (as spelled on the Parkin record), their approximate birthdate and place of birth, and their occupation. We suspect that some men were private citizens who fought to save the community and their own lives.

Every name does not list all of this data. For

example, the record for Autuste [sic] Chouteau does not list his date or place of birth.

Dit names listed are basically French nicknames, and often described some physical trait.
