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

EX-MISSION DE SAN FERNANDO

MISSION San Fernando Rey de España was founded by Father Fermín Francisco de Lausén on September 8th, 1797, named by him in honor of the King of Castile and Leon, Ferdinand III. This area had been provisionally granted to Alcalde (Mayor) Juan Francisco Reyes, whose grandson was the grantee of the Rancho Boca de Santa Monica, previously mentioned. Here the Missionary Fathers built the Mission that today is marked as State Registered Landmark 157.


The Missions were secularized in 1834 and the Church portion of this huge Mission rancho was only 170.20 acres, while the remaining (or ex) Mission San Fernando lands comprised 116,858.46 acres. These acres were purchased on June 17th, 1846, from the Mexican Government by Eulogio de Célis. One day this vast rancho was to house the present day cities of Calabasas, Canoga Park, Chatsworth, Gerard, Granada, North Hollywood, Northridge, Pacoima, Reseda, Roscoe, San Fernando, Sepulveda, Studio City, Tarzana, Tujunga and Van Nuys.

Eulogio de Célis, a native of Spain, came to California in 1836, as a supercargo in the employ of Henry Vermond, a merchant of Acapulco. His wife was María Josefa Arguello, daughter of Governor Luis Antonio Argüello y Moraga and his wife María de la Soledad Ortega y Lopez. In 1853 the Célis family moved to Spain where Eulogio de Célis died at Bilbao on January 27th, 1869. His widow and their eldest son, Eulogio (born about 1845), returned to California, leaving behind four children: two boys and two girls.

In 1845 General Andres Pico y Gutierrez had purchased an undivided half of the rancho for \$15,000, and on May 21st, 1862, conveyed it to his brother, Governor Pio Pico y Gutierrez, who sold it on July 2nd, 1869, to the San Fernando Farm Homestead Association for \$115,000. The home that Andres Pico lived in, which sat upon the "Pico Reserve" (2000 acres retained in the sale of 1869), is today the Andrés Pico Cultural Heritage Center, at 10940 Sepulveda Boulevard, Mission Hills, and is State Registered Landmark 362.

The San Fernando Farm Homestead Association was organized by



NATIONAL ORIGINS OF WHITE SETTLERS IN ENGLISH COLONIES
IN 1775



Before 1700 nearly all the settlers in the English colonies came from England. After 1700 many came from other countries. In this period the largest group of immigrants, next to the English, were the Scotch-Irish. They were among the best frontiersmen and Indian fighters in America and did more than any other group to push the frontier westward over the Appalachians. In addition to the Scotch-Irish there came to America a large number of Germans, many Scotch, Welsh, Irish, Dutch, and French Huguenots.

Cemetery Inscriptions

AFTER a considerable amount of inquiry and searching one day last August in southern Chariton County, MISSOURI, LaVerne Paul Spencer of Long Beach, California, was able to locate a run-down, over-grown cemetery where some of her family were buried a century and a quarter ago. She copied the inscriptions on the stones she was able to read, but many were fallen, illegible and a number of them buried. This small country graveyard is located off a secondary gravel road from Highway KK, which forks left from Highway 87 about seven miles northwest of Glasgow, Missouri. It is reached by climbing a fence across the road from the Vernon Linneman house, crossing a pasture for a space of about four tenths of a mile, ascending to the top of a wooded ridge, where the object of the search was found hidden among the trees.

The Lucas and Mary Spencer stones were in a separate plot surrounded by an iron fence, which may have enclosed other graves unmarked. Outside of what was apparently the original front fence of the cemetery, near the gate, were the following two headstones:

ATTETIA WILLIAMS:

Probably Attetia Fowler Williams, dau. of James and Martha Fowler. Possibly died in childbirth, as son Charles (C. A.) Williams was living in household of Martha Fowler in 1850, age 2 years.

J. and M. FOWLER:

James and Martha Fowler, both born

in Virginia in late 1700's. Parents of Mary Jane Fowler Bagley, Andrew Fowler, Charles D. Fowler, James Davis Fowlder, Attetia Fowler Williams, Martha Fowler, and possibly one or two other daughters. The Fowler sons all went to California prior to 1860, but James D. returned to fight with the Union Army in the Civil War. Martha Fowler lived with her daughter Mary Jane Bagley during this period, but went to Ca. after the close of the war.

J. T. BURCH:

Widower of Margaret A. Burch. Was an attorney in 1853, and served as the "attorney in fact" for Samuel B. Burch when he and Charles H. Burch of Ore. Terr. sold 40 acres to Mason D. Bagley.

W. & M. DAVIS:

May have been some relation of the Fowlers. The Fowlers' son James had as a middle name "Davis", and in 1850 a Hannah Davis was living in the household of Martha Fowler.


SPENCER:



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FOREWORD

Due to the increased demand for statistical records from the Midwestern area of the country, the Heart of America Genealogical Society and Library, Inc., is publishing this volume of selected cemeteries records as a Silver Anniversary memorial, commemorating its founding in 1955.

These are cemeteries researched by many individuals dedicated to preserving and sharing historical and genealogical data. They have been published over a period of twenty years in the Kansas City Genealogist, the official publication of the Society. The early editions of the Genealogist had a very limited circulation therefore limiting the availability of many records contained in them. The Society feels that by incorporating the records into one volume they are made more accessible to all who are interested in this area.

There are selected cemeteries from twenty-six Missouri Counties, however, all cemeteries within the counties have not been researched to date. In some instances only one or two from a county may be included.

A unique asset of this volume is the data from the Missouri Survey Department pertaining to the removal of cemeteries for the formation of two large Missouri lakes and the reinternment in other cemeteries. For some, this volume may be the only source available for finding this data.

H-19. SALEM CEMETERY. This cemetery is located about 2 miles north of Excelsior Springs, Missouri. It is in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 25, Township 53 North, Range 30 West, 5th P. M. It was indexed by Kermit B. Karns in the Fall of 1964. At that time it was in excellent condition. Indexed into Kansas City Public Library Card Catalog.) (Numbers at the end of line are the order of indexing.)

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

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Index To Some Early Barry County Probate Records

Barry County Missouri was organized in 1835, and included all of what now comprises Lawrence County. The northern half of Lawrence was included in Dade County from 1842 to 1845. The southern half was in Barry County until 1845.

Any estates probated during this time would have been settled in Barry County, or possibly Dade County from 1842 to 1845, if in the northern part of the county.

Probate records for Barry County Missouri are still extant from 1835, though it appears there were not many early cases filed.

The early files are stored in a wooden, upright safe, which is divided into compartments. Most of the records are in packets, stacked in random order, with no apparent rhyme or reason. The index was evidently made around 1890, and the files indexed just as they were. We can only assume the index is complete.

These notes list all those up to 1860, which had a date given in the index. Many of these entries were not dated in the index. One or two files of later date were included because they seemed of special interest. These notes were made 28 March 1978, by Fred G. Mieswinkel. These files are found at the Barry County court house at Cassville.



William F. Buckner, Mexican War Veteran

Will be 101 Jan 27

Well Known Paris Resident is One of the Few Survivors of the War With Mexico—
He Still Enjoys Good Health—Was Former Bank Head, But Now Retired.

Paris, Mo., Jan. 4.—

On January 27, William F. Buckner, one of the few living veterans of the Mexican war, will have passed the century mark by one year. A year ago his one hundredth birthday anniversary was celebrated in fitting ways that showed the universal love and admiration Mr. Buckner enjoys in Paris, throughout the country and state, and from friends in various parts of the United States.

At 101, Mr. Buckner is no less hearty and hale than for a number of years. At his home on South Main street here, made home by his daughter, Miss Emma Buckner, he finds life much the same, occasional visits downtown to the Paris National bank, of which he was president so many years, vary his days' events. Night life for Mr. Buckner is invariably a game of "pitch" with some friends who, knowing his hobby, drop in.

Mr. Buckner served under Colonel Doniphan in the Mexican war, taking part in the battle at Tourse. After the war he returned to Paris and a short time later he made a trip overland to California with a brother. Four thousand head of cattle were driven by them to the West. Several months were required to make the trip and to return, but a neat profit enabled Mr. Buckner to enter a mercantile business here.

He maintained this for seventeen years, selling out then to accept a position as bookkeeper in the Paris National bank. From this position he rose to the presidency of the institution, resigning on account of his advanced age in 1912. His son, the late A. B. Buckner, succeeded him.

Besides his daughter, Miss Emma, he has four other daughters, Mrs. F. V. Ragesdale of Paris, Mrs. Sallie Houston and Mrs. Renfro Gibbs of Mexico, Mo., and Mrs. A. F. White of Columbia. Numerous grandchildren and great-grandchildren make up the host of relatives who came from far and near to pass homage to Mr. Buckner a year ago.

Since the last anniversary, Mr. Buckner's remaining son, C. M. Buckner, Marshall, Mo., has died in spite of the fact that the aged father would have very willingly passed on instead had it been possible.

Has Kept Well Posted.

Mr. Buckner is not particularly enthusiastic about his prolonged stay here—he has had such a century full of events and colorful happenings and changes—it is small wonder that he now feels a bit out of the active world.

From candle days to the present electric days, from oxen to airplane, he has passed, keeping in touch always with the advances in the industrial, educational, religious and scientific world.

And since the age of 7 years, when he came with his parents from Virginia, Paris has been his home and from Main street he has viewed the outside world with kindly interest, but not too longingly.

HISTORY OF THE CEMETERY: The original location of the cemetery was near where the Spalding boat ramp is located now. The cemetery was used as an unnamed cemetery from about 1840. The land was owned until 1873 by Nicholas Rouse and then sold to Michael Young who then sold it to Theo Burnett in 1895. In about 1900 the Oakland Baptist Church purchased the land consisting of 2 acres from Theodore & Velda Burnett for \$12.00. It was a free cemetery and anyone could be buried there. There were no reservations so consequently relatives would be widely scattered over the cemetery. People of various religious faiths were buried in the cemetery including several from the Mt Hope Christian Church which was located across Salt River. Not all burials were recorded so as a consequence several graves were listed in the new cemetery as "unknowns". All graves were located and moved to the new location and supplied with a stone if none was present in the original cemetery. The cemetery was moved to its present location (on land donated by Ellen & Christy Greeves) in 1970 as a result of the construction of the Mark Twain Lake. As noted in the burial record, graves from other small cemeteries in the area were moved to the new Cemetery. The list from the Wilson Funeral Home are burials they had listed as being in Oakland Cemetery and may or may not be accurate, and if so are undoubtedly listed as Unknowns. Information concerning Parents or Spouses was given by Okle & Fay Rouse and is believed to be accurate. If anyone has any more information concerning people buried in the Cemetery and would like to have it included, please contact the person listed below.



(This stone was broken and buried. The first name was hard to read but it looked as though it was Fanny.)

This cemetery is located far from the road on a hillside. This area is heavily wooded. It is fenced, but covered with many years of accumulation of leaves. In the few cases where half a stone was found, the other half was recovered by digging and finding it beneath about two inches of leaf mold. Other stones might be found with careful digging.

*The stone of the Confederate soldier was of gray, polished granite, much newer than the date of death would indicate.
