Early History of the Methodist Church in Penfield, New York

transcribed by Ned Seachman

A pulpit bible dating from the 1843 dedication of the of the Penfield Methodist Church, then on Five Mile Line Road near the Penfield Four Corners, contains the following entry concerning the beginning of Methodism in Penfield. When improvements were made to this church building in 1870, Mr. Albert Raymond, Recording Steward for the church, added the following historical summary to the pulpit bible.

A brief History of the first Methodist Episcopal Church in Penfield, NY

Sometime during the first decade of the present century a society of Methodists was organised about one mile north from the present location of this church (the precise time is not known) in what was then known as the "Town of Northfield" embracing territory that now constitutes the Towns of Penfield, Webster and part of Perinton.

About the year 1806 our now venerable father Rev. S. S. Graves moved in from Lima and was appointed Leader of this Class and their place of meeting moved to what is now known as Penfield Center. This is believed to have been the first religious organization in this section of country. A

Baptist society was next organised at the east part of the village and a Presbyterian society about the same time was organised in a log house between this place and Pittsford—the parent society of the Presbyterian churches in Penfield, Pittsford and Webster.



Marriages from St. Patrick's R.C. Church

Extracted by Dick Halsey

A large percentage of RGS members say that they have Irish ancestry. The earliest Irish Church in Monroe County was St. Patrick's Roman Catholic Church. It was organized Apr. 29, 1822. It was located on the northeast corner of Platt and Frank Streets. By 1831 they had built a second, larger, building (pictured). An even larger edifice had the cornerstone laid on October 9, 1864 and dedicated in 1870. That structure was bought in 1937 by Eastman Kodak to expand Kodak Office and was demolished.

The earliest existing book of records for St. Patrick's Church is from 1833. These are the early marriage records. Note that as with any old records, it is difficult to interpret some of the correct spelling of names and places.



Godfrey Memorial Library

The Godfrey Memorial Library, located in Middletown, Connecticut, houses a very large and wide-ranging collection in a very small space. One might think that a genealogical library in central Connecticut would be devoted to the records of that area, state, or possibly, New England. In fact, although its archives do contain town records and other materials peculiar to its locality, a panoply of useful information from every state and twenty-two foreign countries may be accessed there. The library is particularly rich in sources for African-American genealogy, and a quick search of the online catalog returned over 160 hits for this topic.

During my first visit I was searching for some of my wife's ancestors who lived in Connecticut in the 1600s and early 1700s. I was very pleased to find a treasure trove: compiled genealogies, journal articles, and town records. I had intended to stay for only one or two hours and continue on to another library further south in the state. Instead I asked a staff member to direct me to a good restaurant for lunch and

spent the entire afternoon absorbed in the materials available to me. I will be returning there this summer, but this time I have no expectation of exhausting their resources!

The staff is small but very knowledgeable and all seem to be avid genealogists in their own right. I was delighted to find that my laptop was able to connect to the internet through the community wi-fi service. Workspace is very adequate and well lit.

I must also point out that the Godfrey Library has an excellent website that permits not only the usual catalog search, but has a very large and well-organized on-line collection of sources available to members. Not only does this collection provide access to a large number of city directories and photo archive collections, but also to specific resources such as the *Rochester Volunteer* (1841-1843) and the digital archives of the *London Times* for 1785 to 1985. The membership fee of \$35.00 is well worth the investment for any researcher who wants access to more than the genealogy megasites have to offer. 



New things online are all 461 pages of the 1872 History of Monroe County. N. Y. by Prof. W. H. McIntosh. Also, Early History of Rochester, 1810 to 1827 (published 1860) and histories of area regiments in the Civil War. There are some rural directories now online that will help finding ancestors that lived outside of the City. Outstanding are the 1918 The Farm Journal Illustrated Rural Directory of Monroe County, NY (pictured above) and Child's Gazetteer and Business Directory of Monroe County (1869). But also investigate the County Business directories from 1875 to 1896 for people owning various kinds of businesses.

Newspapers have also been added to the online collection. One of interest is *Moore's Rural New Yorker* for the years 1861 to 1865. That newspaper was selected for Civil War news and pictures but it also reflects well on rural life at the time and even has some marriages and deaths. Another newspaper of interest is the *Rochester Gem.and Ladies Amulet* (1831 - 1843 with many missing issues). It was a literary newspaper of poems and short stories but even that newspaper has marriages and deaths. Also, there are scattered issues of other newspapers including Frederic Douglass' *North Star*, *Rochester Evening News* and an issue of the *Rochester Gazette* from 1817.

Although most of the manuscript collection is not of much genealogical help, they are historic interest. A large portion of the collection is letters written by Susan B. Anthony and her sister, Mary, a large portion of which are handwritten. But also buried in the manuscript collection are a few Civil War muster rolls.

You will want to spend hours looking over the complete digital collection. You will need a fast internet connection as many of the files are large. There are more digital collections coming in the future so bookmark the link for the future.

Seventeen different times I, like Israel of old. waded through a red sea of blood, withstood the thundering of British fury, but at last arrived with the ark of our country's liberties safe on this, our favored land, and now I here present you this continental money I took for 46 bushels of wheat--the flour which was used to feed the first troops that General Washington called from Connecticut to Boston, and the Continental bills I took for my wages at the capture pf Burgoine. The money I leave with the request to have it kept with some of my posterity as long as it will hang together, that generations yet unborn may see what money was taken in payment where America was taken in payment where America gained a greater blessing than any other nation on earth now enjoys.

From the Editor

I recently received e-mail from a reader named Cathy. After seeing the movie "27 Dresses", Cathy made an interesting observation concerning the St. Patrick's R. C. Church Marriage Records that have been published in several past Hear Ye Hear Ye issues. Here is a summary of Cathy's observations and her thoughts about them.

Cathy explained that "27 Dresses" is a/current popular movie whose heroin, played by Katherine Heigl, helps to plan and was the bridesmaid in 27 weddings. She proudly stores each unique bridesmaid's dress in a special closet. This movie sparked Cathy's imagination as she revisited Dick Halsey's "Marriages from St. Patrick's R.C. Church" in the Spring 2008 issue of Hear Ye Hear Ye. She noted the frequency of a witness named Catherine Sheridan. In 1837, Catherine attended two weddings in December. In 1838, she attended two in February, one in March, three in April (the 2nd, 4th & 15th), one each in May and June, and two on the same day, October 24th. In 1839, she starts on January 21st. At this point, Cathy raced to her Summer 2008 issue and was/not disappointed. Catherine's next outings are April 1st, two in May, and July 6th, 7th and 20th. Nineteen weddings in 20 months! Cathy wrote, "That's a lot of dresses too! What will Catherine be doing in the next issue? I can't wait. P.S. Joseph Kennedy joined Catherine as a witness at two of those/weddings and a James Kennedy six times. Even a John Sheridan comes along in May of 1838! Fascinating stuff, this genealogy."

Cathy, I learned that Dick Halsey has more pages of the marriage records available. I thought that our readers might like to join you tracking Catherine Sheridan. I would like to invite our readers to come up with a theory for why Catherine Sheridan's name appears so often in the marriage records. I only have space to print a portion of the remaining records in this issue. I will print more of the records in the winter issue along with your theories. Thank you Cathy for your wonderful note and for being so observant.


