

Historic Cemeteries of Henniker

An Index to the Gravestones

There have been three major inventories of the cemeteries of Henniker. Francis Lane Childs copied the names and dates of the gravestones as he found them from 1914 to 1919. A volume labeled *Tombstone Inscriptions by Francis Childs* is at the Henniker Historical Society. His volume also included graves in the New Cemetery up to 1923.

A second major project was undertaken by Elizabeth Gilbert in 1976 to celebrate the nation's Bicentennial. She recorded all of the names, dates and verses inscribed on the gravestones in Henniker's historic cemeteries. She did not include any names from the New Cemetery. She also drew a map of each cemetery and gave each stone a number corresponding to a number locating it on the map. These maps have been updated through the end of 1997.

A third inventory was done from 1995-98 by Martha Taylor and Barbara DelloRusso with Bruce Elliott's computer program and support. The data from Mrs. Gilbert's cards was entered into the computer and then printed out. This print-out was compared to Mr. Childs' records, then each entry was compared to the actual stone and corrected, if necessary. When there was a discrepancy between Gilbert's and Childs' work and the gravestone could not be read, we used Childs' information and so noted it in the notes section of the record.

The third inventory has resulted in the following index of gravestones in the historic cemeteries of Henniker. It contains names and death dates from the gravestones and a notation of the cemetery in which each is found. A full record of the inscriptions on the stones of persons listed here, and also the cemetery plot plans, can be found in the larger work entitled "Historic Cemeteries of Henniker, New Hampshire, A Detailed Record of Gravestone Inscriptions."

I. The First Burial Yard, also called the Old Burying Ground or the Connor Yard, is the oldest public burial place in Henniker. It was laid out by town meeting vote in 1770. It is four acres, situated on Lot 10 Range 7, one half mile south of the Town Hall on what is now known as Depot Hill Road. The oldest inscription is that of William Petters, who died July 5, 1775. According to Francis L. Childs "apparently not more than a quarter of the graves are marked by other than uninscribed boulders."

II. The Plummer Cemetery is a small plot of about two acres that was laid out during the Revolution for the use of nearby residents. It is in the

southeast part of town in Lot 2 Range 10 on College Hill Road. The oldest inscription is that of Parses Brown, who died March 13, 1790. This cemetery continues to be used for burials at the present time (1998).

III. The Harriman Yard, or Harriman & Huse Cemetery, is only about a quarter of an acre that was laid out in the 1780's for use of the settlers in the southeast part of town in Lot 16 Range 12. It is on the Raymond Aucoin (1998) farm on a lane leading south from Baker Road a few rods east of the farmhouse. It appeared to Francis Childs, in 1918, that the yard was thickly filled with graves that were nearly all marked with uninscribed field stones. The oldest inscription is that of Joshua Harriman, who died March 15, 1812.

IV. The Colby Cemetery, a quarter acre site in Lot 3 Range 2, is in the northeast part of town. It is located down a lane on the west side of Dodge Hill Road just south of Bound Tree Road. There are many unmarked graves, as well as several from which the bodies have been removed to be re-interred in the cemeteries at the village according to Francis Childs. The oldest inscription is that of Nicholas Colby, who died March 30, 1836.

V. The Friends' Cemetery, now known as the Quaker Cemetery, was laid out by the Society of Friends for their own use about 1800. It is located in Lot 14 Range 11 on the east side of Quaker Street about a quarter of a mile south of the Friends' Meeting House. Until 1852, the erection of memorials to the dead was forbidden by a rule of discipline of the Society of Friends, therefore the older graves in this cemetery are marked only by uninscribed field stones. The stones with dates earlier than 1852 were erected by descendants at a later date. The oldest inscription is that of David Folsom, who died January 4, 1813.

VI. The Old Cemetery is also known as the Center Cemetery because it is located in the original Center Lot of the town. It was laid out by vote of the town in 1809 and was ready for use the next year. It consists of four acres on the west side of the town common, directly behind the Town Hall. According to Francis Childs nearly one third of the graves are unmarked. The first person to be interred here was John Dodge, Jr., 12, who died May 3, 1810.

VII. The Patten Family Yard is a private granite-walled burial yard on the old Patten farm in Lot 18 Range 11, and is located beside the driveway on the right side as one enters the driveway that is now named Lyman Road. All of the stones are of the name Patten.

VIII. The Chase Cemetery is a small, granite-walled enclosure to the north of the top of Corbin Road toward Craney Hill Lookout Tower. This private burial yard is located on the former Harvey Chase farm and has three inscribed gravestones, all Chases.

IX. The Gordon Cemetery is actually two inscribed stones in the yard under a large pine tree at 18 Hemlock Corner Loop. Jonathan Gordon and his wife Mehitable are buried here.

X. Louis Maurice Augustus Roy and his mother, Flora Roy, are buried on the south side of Bear Hill Road, just east of the Ocean Born Mary house on a knoll in the woods.

XI. There are several lone burial stones throughout town and any we could locate are coded with an "M".

Mr. Childs describes four other burial-places that he knew to be located in Henniker. His description follows:

"Annas Campbell's Grave. Annas Campbell, one of the earliest settlers of the town, died 28 January 1772, and was buried on the farm where he lived – the so-called Childs place at "The Oaks" at the west end of the village, where Robert S. Goss now lives (1925). His unmarked grave lies about two rods north of the highway on the little knoll between the house and the highway bridge over the brook. It was plainly visible as late as 1860, but is now indistinguishable from the surrounding earth.

"Graves on College Hill. A few rods south of the highway (College Hill Road) in Lot 1 Range 11, in the old Whitemore pasture on College Hill so-called, near a long-deserted cellar-hole not far from the Hopkinton line, lie two graves, probably of children, marked only by small boulders. They evidently date from the early days of the settlement of the town, but since this farm had several successive owners in the eighteenth century, the names of those who rest here will probably never be known.

"The McKillip Graves. In the "Ireland Pasture" so-called, near the southeast corner of the town, in Lot 2 Range 12, there lived from about 1767 to 1798, on a farm abandoned more than a century ago, David and Samuel McKillip (or "McCalup", as the name is often written on the town records). Here are still visible the graves, marked by uninscribed field stones, of two children who are said to have been the offspring of one or the other of the McKillips.

"The Alley Tomb. Daniel B. Alley, an eccentric member of the Society of Friends and insane in his later years, erected a tomb of rough stones on the farm where he lived in Lot 14 Range 9--the so-called Perry

place now (1925) owned by John A. Wood. The tomb is in the field north of the highway and visible from the road. Here he buried his wife Abigail who died 19 February 1836 and here his own remains were placed when he died, 27 February 1848. The later history of this tomb is not a pleasant one. It is said that about 1900 the undisciplined children of a transient tenant on this farm broke into the tomb and used it for a playhouse. The town authorities, hearing of this act of vandalism, made an investigation and were told that "the children had found a few old bones in there, which they carried down and threw into Morrill's Pond" nearby! Alley's queerness seems to have followed him even in death."

It should be noted that most of the historic cemeteries in Henniker are on private property and any person wishing to visit these sites should seek permission from the landowner.


