- NEW JERSEY -

BIRTHS IN CHESTERFIELD, BURLINGTON COUNTY

This birth record was kept by a Quaker physician in Burlington County. Mr. H. E. Deats purchased the book from a dealer in antiques in Philadelphia, who had secured it with other material from the attic of an old house being torn down near Crosswicks, New Jersey. The name of Joseph Reckless on the inside cover has not been sufficient information to identify the writer.

The first entry is dated 3 January 1770. Entries to 3 November 1780 were published in the Proceedings of the New Jersey Historical Society, New Series, Vol 3 (1918) pp 55-59, 108-122, 173-178, 205-210. The note that the publication was to be continued indicated to this editor that the book must extend to a later date. Therefore, inquiries were made to procure copies of the remaining pages. We thank the Historical Society for their kind permission to publish the remaining entries, these being from October 1780 to 25 Oct 1785.

The original form of the entries was adhered to as much as practicable. (i.g.: "8 Bikley Steward had a son born a fourth day") Following each entry are three columns labeled Pounds, Shillings, Pence. This varies from nothing to 170 / 2 / 6. In order to conserve space numbers which were spelled out in the original have been abbreviated. A few other abbreviations have also been adopted. The surnames have been given in capitals for greater ease of reference.

LAND RECORDS

The Archives Division, New Jersey State Library, has deeds 1670-1800. Records after 1800 are kept in the office of the clerk of the respective county.

Sources of title in New Jersey were Grants, by right of discovery; title through the Indians; title through the Dutch; title from the Governor; title from the Proprietors.

A number of systems of ownership were used. Under Dutch rule the PATROON SYSTEM was in effect. Unfortunately, during that period, certain ships carrying records bound for Holland were lost at sea. Surviving records have been sent to the New York State Library.

The QUIT RENT SYSTEM was used, mostly in East Jersey.

A more common system was PROPRIETOR'S OWNERSHIP. During the proprietorship of William Penn, many records were sent to Pennsylvania. They are housed at the Historical Society of Pennsylvania. At the division of East and West Jersey, each proprietor had the original grants and surveys. Those which were not moved to other depositories were lost or destroyed before 1783.

PRIVATE OWNERSHIP was rare. Private deeds often were not recorded -- at least, not until land was to be sold.

During the Revolutionary War innumerable records of all kinds were destroyed -- only about 25% of pre-1800 records are still in existence.

MILITARY RECORDS

The original records are housed at the New Jersey Department of Defense, War Records Armory, Trenton, New Jersey.

CENSUS RECORDS

The Federal Census records were destroyed in Washington in 1812. Records of the 1820 census were destroyed in Trenton. Records of the succeeding years (beginning 1830) are available.

REFERENCE SOURCES

State and county histories often yield valuable information. For West Jersey records, Gilbert Cope's Collection, in the Genealogical Society of Pennsylvania, is good.
