Sixtown Civil War Honor Roll

- (In compiling records of the Sixtown men who served in the Civil War, I have a list of 222 men who died in the service of their country during the Civil War. Of these 76 were killed in action (the highest single day loss of our sixtown men was at the 2nd Battle of Bull Run on Aug. 30, 1862 - 15 KIA, and 7 died later of wounds), 93 died of disease (most common - Typhoid Fever & Smallpox), 46 the cause of death was not stated, 2 killed by snipers, 1 was poisoned, 1 drowned and 3 died in Railroad accidents).

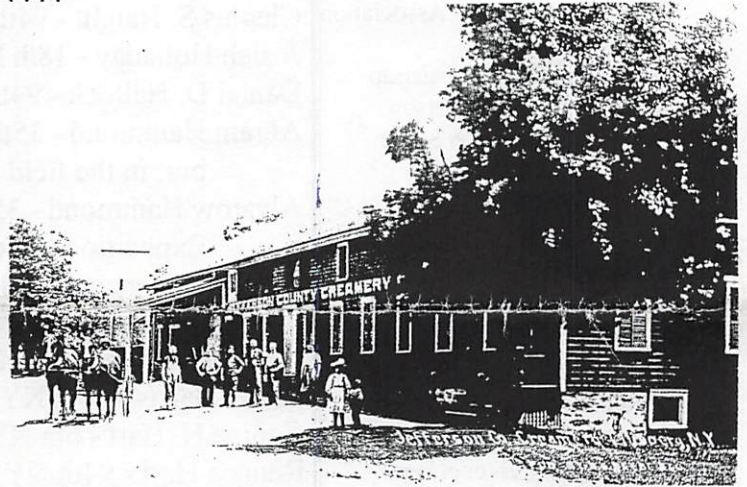

- 8) I researched my family tree...apparently **I DON'T EXIST!**

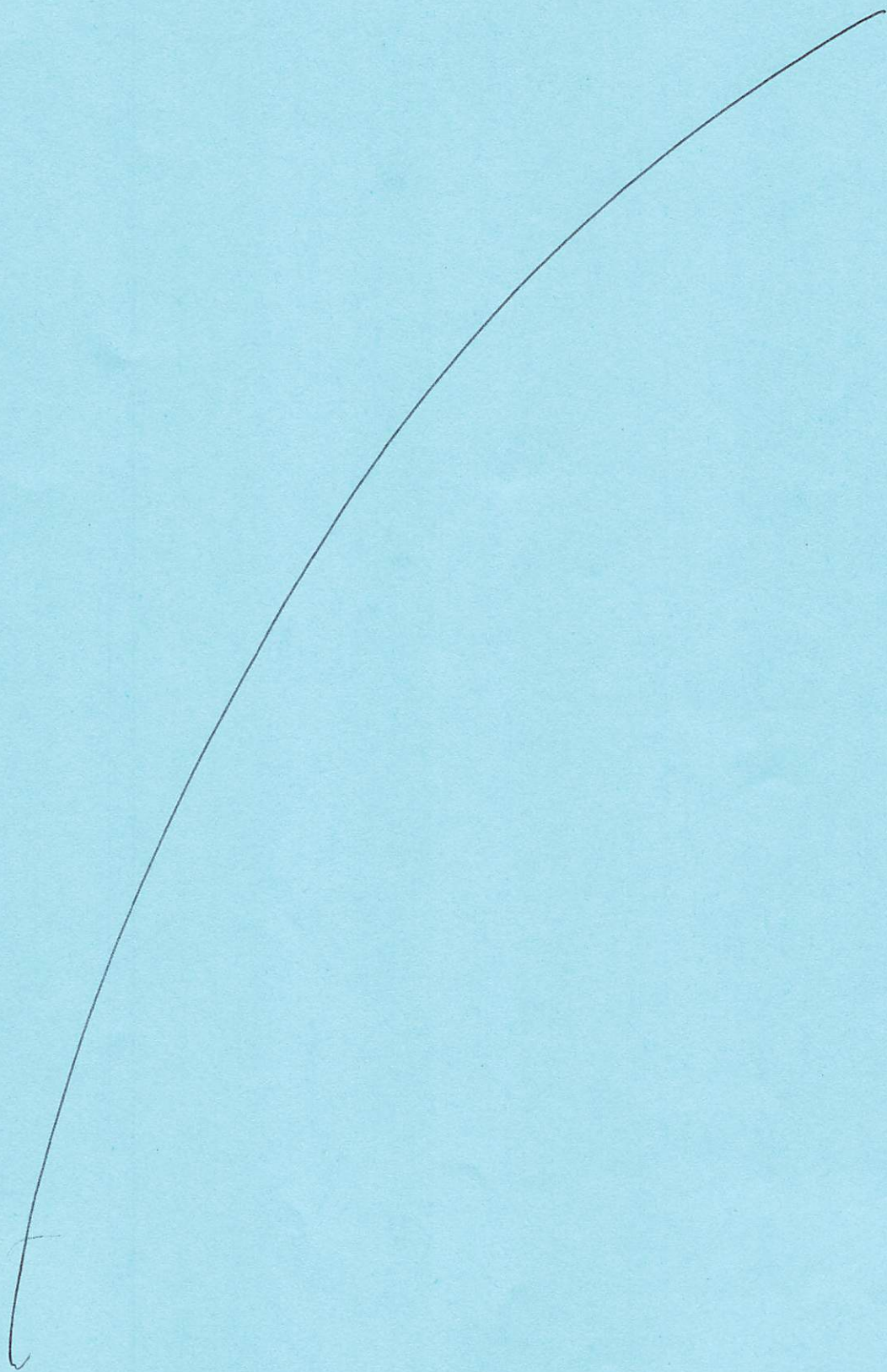
