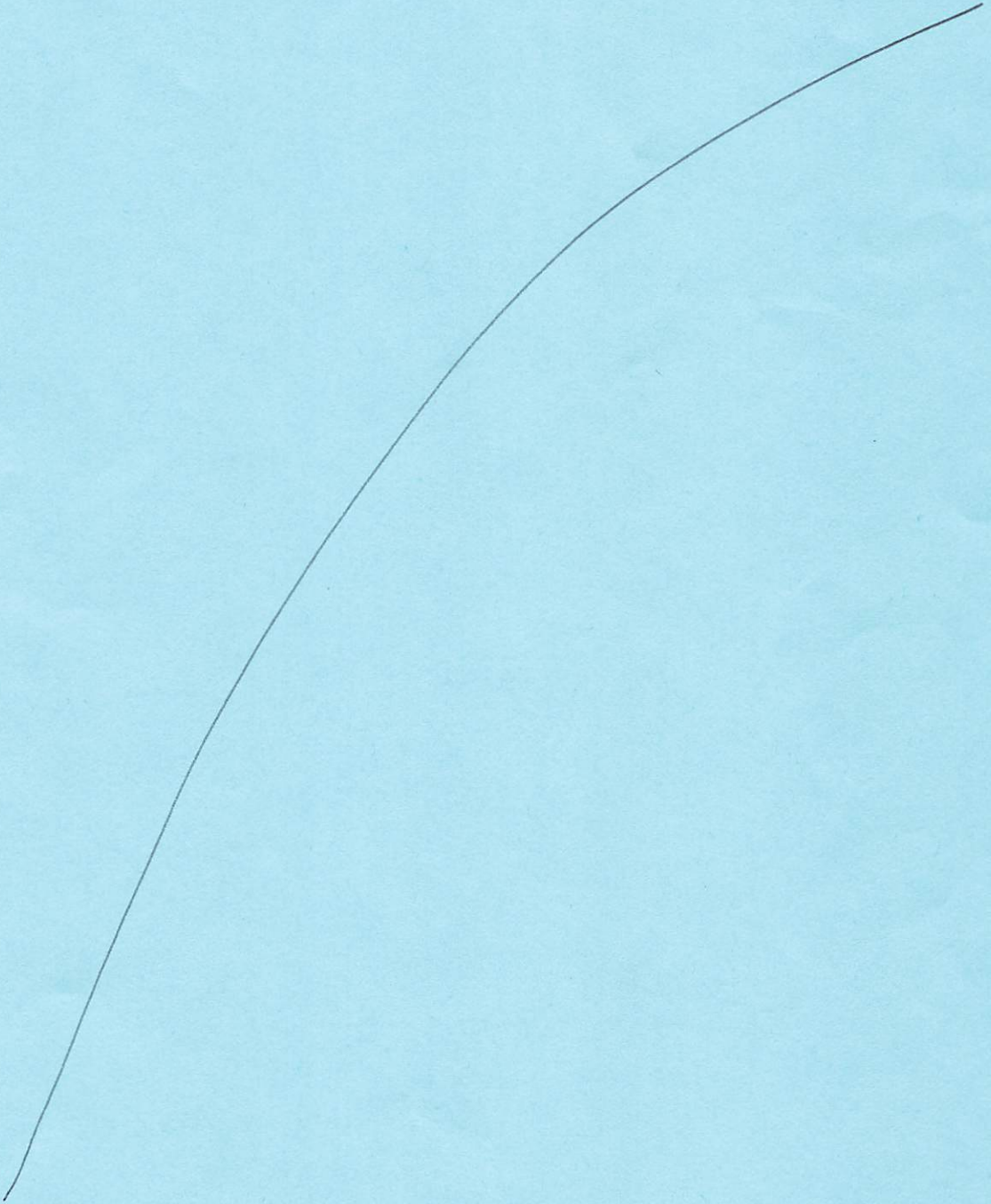

28<sup>th</sup> Regt. N. C. Vols Jany 20<sup>th</sup> 1863:

I certify that private Beverly F. Stowe late of my company, B, 28<sup>th</sup> Regt. NC Vols enlisted in Dallas Gaston County, NC July 30<sup>th</sup> 1861 for twelve months and reenlisted at Washington Feby 27<sup>th</sup> 1862 for the war. Born in Gastonia, NC, Died Aug 5<sup>th</sup> 1862 at Petersburg, VA. The State of North Carolina is due him forty, (40) dollars State bounty, having rec'd ten dollars, given under my hand.

I certify that Corporal Andrew Beaty late a soldier of Co. B, 28<sup>th</sup> Regt. NC Vols enlisted at Dallas Gaston County, NC on July 30<sup>th</sup> 1861 and was honorably discharged from the service the 22<sup>nd</sup> July 1872 in consequence of gun shot wounds in battle and the loss of a limb. NC is due him forty (40) dollars bounty, he having rec'd ten dollars.

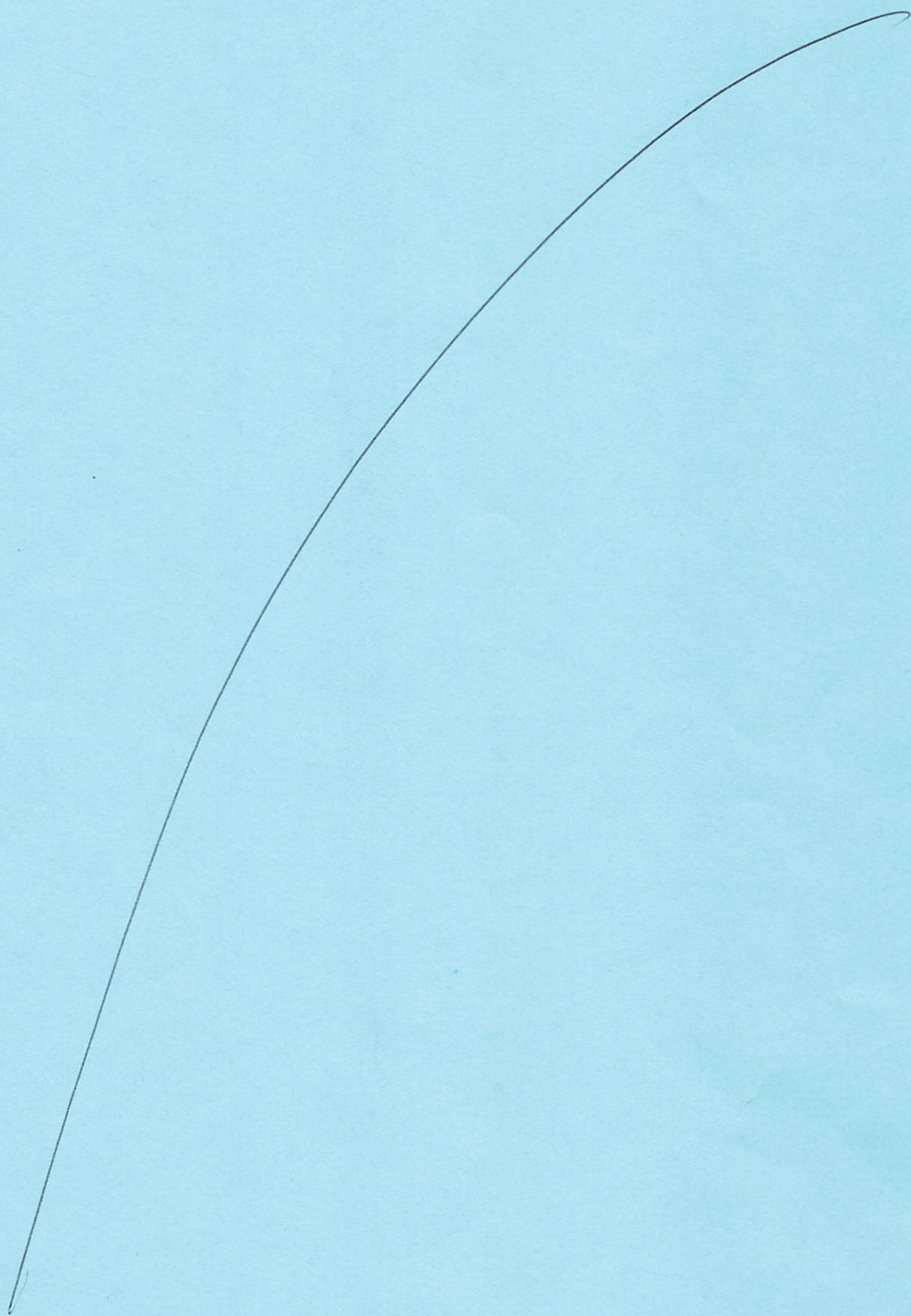

In 1867 North Carolina began granting pensions to Confederate veterans who were blinded or lost an arm or leg during their service. In 1885 the State began granting pensions to all other disabled indigent Confederate veterans or widows.

These letters include some copies of affidavits certifying death dates of pensioners and identifying their family members. The letters are written back and forth from the Clerk Superior of Gaston County, Charles C. Cornwell, S.C. Hendricks & State Auditor, Hal W. Ayer, and or W.P. Wood.

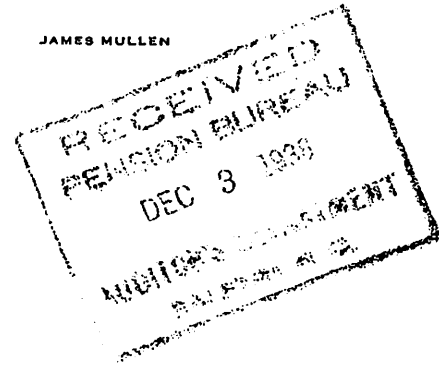

Mrs. J. T. Proctor, R. F. D. #2, Kings Mountain, N. C. wishes to learn the whereabouts of her uncle who was a Confederate veteran. The following is an excerpt from a letter addressed to Mrs. Proctor from the War Department, The Adjutant General's Office, Washington:

"The records show one Adolphus Wacaster, surname also borne as Waccaster, served as a private in Company K, 1st Regiment North Carolina Infantry (6 months, 1861), Confederate States Army. He enlisted April 25, 1861, at Lincolnton, and on the muster roll for July and August, 1861, last on file, he is reported present. His age is shown as 19 years, and residence Lincoln County, N. C. Date of disbandment of regiment not shown, but the last Field and Staff roll is for Nov. 1 to 13, 1861.

"The records also show Adolphus Wacaster served as a private, Co. 1, 11th (Bethel Regiment) North Carolina Infantry, Confederate States Army, which regiment was formed in part by the reenlistment of men from the disbanded 1st Regiment North Carolina Infantry. He enlisted March 15, 1862, at Lincolnton; was wounded and captured at Gettysburg, Pa. about July 1, 1863; paroled at Baltimore, Md., Aug. 23, 1863, and was delivered at Cit. Point, Virginia, Aug. 24, 1863, for exchange.

"The company muster roll for Mar. and Apr. 1864, shows him present, and the one for May and June, 1864, reports him absent, missing in action in battle of the Wilderness, May 5, 1864. The roll for July and Aug. 1864, reports him missing in action in the Wilderness May 5, 1864, and the roll for Sept. and Oct., 1864, reports him absent, missing in action in Wilderness May 5, 1864, and the roll for Nov. and Dec., 1864, and Jan and Feb. 1865, last on file, reports him absent prisoner of war. No later record of him has been found."

Mrs. Proctor is very anxious to locate her relative and to


