I certify that JW. Fulton a soldier of Company E 12th Reg. NCT enlisted on the 22nd day of April 1861 and is hereby discharges from the service June 15th 1862 by reason of furnishing a substitute in person of S.S. Simmons and said substitute being killed in the Battle near Richmond Va. July 1st 1862 and having never received but ten dollars \$10 Bounty from the State of North Carolina said Fulton is entitled to draw from the State forty dollars \$40, according to an ordinance of the convention of said State. October 24th 1862

In 1867 North Carolina began granting pensions to Confederate veterans who were blinded or lost an arm or leg during their service. In 1885 the State began granting pensions to all other disabled indigent Confederate veterans or widows.

These letters include some copies of affidavits certifying death dates of pensioners and identifying their family members. The letters are written back and forth from the Clerk Superior & Recorder of Cleveland County, A.M Hamrick, and North Carolina State Auditor, Baxter Durham. The letters are arranged in chronological order as they were in the archives. They are numbered and placed in files by tens. (Ten letters per folder.)

On continuing my transcription I have run into some interesting tidbits. Cleveland County Letter #441 contained the following "The State of North Carolina pays a pension to its Confederate Soldiers and to their widows, and also to the colored body-servants who accompanied their young masters when they enlisted in the Confederate Army. There is no provision under the law for paying any pension to the widows of the body servants."

company E 12th Regiment, North Carolina Troops, was born in Cleaveland County, North
Carolina aged 22 years 5 feet 7 inches high, Fair complexion, Grey eyes Light hair ,by
occupation a Farmer and was enlisted by J.B. Fulton on the 23rd Day of June 1861 and
died of sickup July 3 1862 at Lynchburg Va. and the said William A. Blanton was last
paid by Captain Wm. Alston to include the last day of February 1862 and has monthly
pay due him from that day to the 3 day of July 1862 making -----dollars-----cents.

There is also due him for arrears of clothing, from the ---day of ---186---dollars
and--- cents. There is also due him fifty (50) dollars, bounty money, which he has never
received from the State North Carolina October 2nd 1862
