To all whom these presents shall come Know Ye that I *William WITHERS*, in County Stafford in Virginia... In consideration of nine thousand pounds of good sound Merchantable tobacco in cask by *John SYMMONS* in afore said county Planter unto me paid..... do sell one parcel of land containing 300 acres lying and being in County Stafford and upon South side Potomack Creek being part of 500 acres of land granted by patent to *John WITHERS* deced and purchased of him by *William WITHERS* my father the said 300 acres bounded northerly upon Potomack Creek Westerly upon and Easterly upon *John MARTINS*, land..... to have and hold.....to all intents and purposes that I *William WITHERS & Mary*, my wife or WM. My deced father had..... 6th day of December, 1699.

One hundred acres of land to be made good if he happens to want any to *Christopher FLETCHER*, by *John SIMMONS*

William WITHERS came into court in proper person acknowledged deed.....and *Mary*, his wife by *Robert COULSON*, her attorney came into Court and relinquished her right of Dower March 14th 1699/1700 and then recorded.

18TH CENTURY GERMAN NAMING CUSTOMS

At baptism, if two given names were given to the child, the first given name was a spiritual, saint's name, originally developed from Roman Catholic tradition and continued on by the Protestants in their baptismal naming customs. The second given name was the secular name, which is the name the person was known by, within the family and to the rest of the world. The spiritual name, usually to honor a favorite saint, was usually repeatedly given to all the children of that family of the same sex. Thus the boys would be Johann Adam Kerchner, Johan George Kerchner, etc., or Philip Peter Kerchner, Philip Jacob Kerchner, etc. Girls would be named Anna Barbara Kerchner, Anna Margaret Kerchner, etc., or Maria Elizabeth Kerchner, Maria Catherine Kerchner, etc. But after baptism, these people would not be known as John, Philip, Anna, or Maria, respectively. They would instead be known by what we now would think of as their middle name, which was their secular name. Thus these people would be known respectively as Adam, George, Peter, Jacob, Barbara, Margaret, Elizabeth, and Catherine in legal and secular records. For males, the saint's name Johan or John was particularly heavily used by many German families. The child's secular name was really John, if and only if, at baptism he was named only John, usually Johannes, with no second given name. Many researchers, new to German names, who find a baptism of an individual with a name such as Johann Adam Kerchner, thus mistakenly spend a lot of time looking for a John Kerchner in legal and census records, when he was known after baptism, to the secular world, as Adam Kerchner. Also when reading county histories, etc., especially those written by individuals in the 20th century, and the author is referring to someone as John Kerchner and you are not looking for a John Kerchner, but the history sounds otherwise familiar, further research may turn up that this person was really not a John Kerchner, but instead was someone else such as a Johan George Kerncher. You would thus find all his 18th century records recorded under the name George Kerchner and not John Kerchner and therefore after checking the data and correlating the facts, you may find this is really a story about your missing George Kerchner.

The term "Senior" and "Junior" following a name did not necessarily imply a father and son relationship as it does now. It could have been an uncle and nephew who had the same name and lived near each other. It could be a grandfather and a grandchild living together, where the father has died. It could even be two unrelated individuals with the same name but of different ages who lived near each other. So to help friends and business associates keep track of who was who in their discussions and records, they added on the "Sr." or "Jr." which merely meant the older and younger, respectively.

The term "cousin" was widely used to mean an extended family, not the specific legal definition we understand it to be today.

It was a common practice in some German families to

name the first born son after the child's paternal grandfather and the second born son after the maternal grandfather. Here are two more detailed naming patterns practiced by some families:

Pattern A

1st son after the father's father
2nd son after the mother's father
3rd son after the father
4th son after the husband's father's father
5th son after the wife's father's father
6th son after the husband's mother's father
7th son after the wife's mother's father

1st daughter after the wife's mother
2nd daughter after the husband's mother
3rd daughter after the mother
4th daughter after the father's father's mother
5th daughter after the mother's father's mother
6th daughter after the father's mother's mother
7th daughter after the mother's mother's mother

Pattern B

Pattern B for the sons is the same as Pattern A but its pattern for daughters was different:

1st daughter after the father's mother
2nd daughter after the mother's mother
3rd daughter after the mother
4th daughter after the mother's father's mother
5th daughter after the father's father's mother

Pattern C


1st son after the father's mother
2nd son after the mother's father
3rd son after the father's oldest brother
4th son after the father

1st daughter after the father's mother
2nd daughter after the mother's mother
3rd daughter after the mother's oldest sister
4th daughter after the mother

Whenever a duplicate name occurred in these two patterns, the next name in the series was used. If a child died in infancy, the name was often reused for the next child of the same gender.

If you are lucky enough to find a family with a lot of children, who strictly followed one of these naming patterns, then it may give you useful clues to determining the possible names of family members in earlier generations.

An "in" or "en", added to the end of a name, such as Anna Maria Kerchnerin, is a German language name ending suffix denoting that the person is a female. Thus the correct spelling of the last name in the example would be Kerchner, not Kerchnerin. (For additional information, see *German-American Names* by Professor George F. Jones, published by the Genealogical Publishing Co of Baltimore, MD.)

I know that it's been said before, but investing in children is an investment in our future. I don't know who said it or why, but the same thought applies to genealogy. By spending time helping kids understand family history, all of us benefit. A little less history is lost and you've given them a sense of how the world works.

WILTON-Services for Emil G. Hilken, 76, former Wilton mayor and lifelong Wilton resident, will be held at 2 p.m. Tuesday at First Presbyterian Church, Wilton.

He was born Sept. 26, 1903, at Wilton, where he grew up and at-

tended schools. He married Bonnie Drewer on March 24, 1928, and they farmed on the family homestead near Wilton until 1943, when they moved into town. 1930 U.S. Census Coming Soon!

The U.S. National Archives and Records Administration will release the 1930 Federal population census for the first time on 1 April 2002. At that time, the microfilmed copies will be available for research at the National Archives Building in Washington, DC, at thirteen of the National Archives regional facilities across the nation, and through the National Archives rental program.

The 1930 census is the 15th Federal census mandated by the U.S. Constitution, which states, "The actual Enumeration shall be made within three years after the first Meeting of the Congress of the United States, and within very subsequent Term of ten years, in such Manner as they shall by Law direct..."

The 1930 census consists of 2,667 rolls of population schedules and 1,587 rolls of Soundex indexes for 12 southern states, totaling 4,254 rolls. Even though the statistical summaries collected by enumerators are made public shortly after the census is taken, information on individuals and families is restricted by law for privacy reasons for 72 years. (92 Stat. 815; Public Law 95-416; October 5, 1978).

Rapid City Daily Journal 8 August 1931

Edgemont, August 8 Douglas Hand was born in Lexington, Ill., January 7, 1858 where he resided on a farm with his parents until he was 19 years of age at which time he left home for the Black Hills, arriving at Rapid City April 10, 1877, going from there to Deadwood where he engaged in mining. The years of 1882 and 1883 he was foreman for Homestake Mining Company.

March 1 1884, he went to Bloomington, Illinois where May 1 of that year he was married to Miss Elizabeth J. Bowman, Towanda, Ill. In the spring of 1885, they moved to Burlington, Kan. and later to Kansas City where he was employed by a packing company.

The call of the west reached him again and in 1889 he went to Hot Springs where he filed on government land at the mouth of Red Canyon. It had been his home ever since, being one of the pioneer farmers of the county.

On October 20, 1921, his wife died and Mr. Hand had made his home with his sons since, the oldest son, Elmer and his family residing on the old home place.

For many years, Mr. Hand had been nearly deaf and it was a great handicap to him in his dealings as a farmer. In the last few years, as he grew older, he became a sufferer from different maladies and it was these maladies coupled with financial reverses and crop failures, that were a great source of worry to the old man and it was them that led to his death.

He leaves three sisters and one brother, all of Norman, Ill. And four children; Elmer C., Russell J. Hand both of this city, Mrs. Cora Zimmerman, Staples, Minn., and Mrs. Bertha Grim of San Diego, Calif. Besides 13 grandchildren of whom 11 are living.

He was a member of the Knights of the Maccabees, holding membership for 35 years.

The funeral services were held at the Congregational church, with Rev. S. J. Vernon in charge.

Annie Creek (Lawrence Co. to Spearfish Creek) was named for Mrs. Annie Clark, whose father located a claim on this creek in 1877, and named it in her honor.



Encourage preservation. Let it be known that Museums and Universities are interested in any that are unwanted. At the very least, antique dealers will buy them. Pass the word. By so doing, you are helping to preserve a fragment of our heritage.

WHAT ABOUT YOUR HERITAGE?

(Editor's comment): As mentioned in this article, "people took pride in their family

photographs and intended to preserve them for posterity." Do you, or any of your relatives, have an old Family Album? If so, can you identify the subject(s) in each photograph?

My maternal grandmother had quite a number of siblings. Three Albums contain photos of these people as children, their weddings, and even some of their funeral cards.

When I asked my mother to write the names of these people behind their pictures she felt she was "ruining Mamma's precious Albums." Ruining? Indeed not! She was preserving a heritage for her children, grandchildren and future generations of her family.

If you have an old family photograph album in your possession, and the subjects are unidentified, run, don't walk, to your nearest elderly relative and attempt to have identification made. Do it today - tomorrow may be too late!


