3. William MCCORT was born on 11 May 1844 in Potsdam, NY. He died on 14 Feb 1863 in Camp Chase, OH. He was buried in Mt. Pleasant Cem., Union Twp., Carroll Co., OH. William entered the military service as a substitute for his cousin Thomas McCort. He died of measles while in camp during the Civil War with Company K, 100th Regiment of the Ohio Volunteer Infantry.

4. Elizabeth MCCORT was born in 1847 in Potsdam, St.Lawrence Co., NY. She died on 25 Feb 1901 in Carroll Co., OH. She was buried on 27 Feb 1901 in Palermo Cem., Perry Twp., Carroll Co., OH. There are no dates on her grave stone. She was married twice, to two different

McHugh brothers. She was 53 years old upon death and never bore any children. Elizabeth was married to John MCHUGH on 17 Aug 1865 in Carroll Co., OH. John MCHUGH was born on 24 May 1836. He died on 9 Apr 1896 in Perry Twp., Carroll Co., OH. He was buried in Palermo Cem.. He died at Bowerston, OH stepping off the train into a creek while shipping a car load of livestock to Pittsburgh.

After John died Elizabeth was married to William McHugh.

5. Robert MCCORT was born on 6 Jan 1850 in Potsdam, St.Lawrence Co., NY. He died on 4 Nov 1909 in Sumner Co., Kansas. Robert lived and farmed near Anson, Sumner Co., Kansas. Both Robert and his wife died of typhoid fever. Robert fathered ten children. Robert was married to Martha Melissa LINDSEY on 2 Jan 1879

in Carroll Co., OH. Martha Melissa LINDSEY was born on 28 Feb 1856 in Union Twp., Carroll Co., OH. She died on 21 Sep 1909 in Sumner Co., Kansas.

6. Henry S. MCCORT was born in 1851 in Potsdam, St.Lawrence Co., NY. He died on 27 May 1937 in Stark Co., OH. He was buried in Forest Hill Cem., Plain Twp., Stark Co., OH. He lived at Sherrodsville, Carrollton then Canton.

Henry was married to Anna R. KING on 8 Nov 1883 in Carroll Co., OH. Anna R. KING was born on 9 Jul 1864. She died on 20 Jul 1950 in Stark Co., OH. She was buried in Forest Hill Cem., Plain Twp., Stark Co., OH.

7. Richard MCCORT was born on 10 Jan 1854 in Potsdam, St.Lawrence Co., NY. The 1870 census says born in NY age 17. This means born 1853 but his tombstone reads 1855. Richard's death certificate says born Jan 10, 1854. He died on 12 Jan 1936 in Bowerston, Harrison Co., OH. He was buried on 14 Jan 1936 in Palermo Cem., Perry Twp., Carroll Co., OH. He was a prosperous farmer in Orange Twp., Carroll Co., OH. Richard fathered six children.

Richard was married to Margaret A. RUTLEDGE on 25 Jan 1879 in Carroll Co., OH. Margaret A. RUTLEDGE was born in 1856. She died in 1943 in Carroll Co., OH. She was buried in Palermo Cem., Perry Twp., Carroll Co., OH.

8. Mary Jane "Jennie" MCCORT was born on 11 Oct 1855 in Potsdam, St. Lawrence Co., NY. She died on 20 May 1919 in Carrollton, OH. She was buried on 22 May 1919 in Grandview Cem., Carrollton, OH. Jennie first lived at Petersburg, then Canton and eventually lived in

Carrollton on Scio Rd. Jennie bore no children.

Jennie was married to James Alexander FAWCETT on 19 Dec 1878 in Carroll Co., OH. James Alexander FAWCETT was born in 1853. He died in 1923.

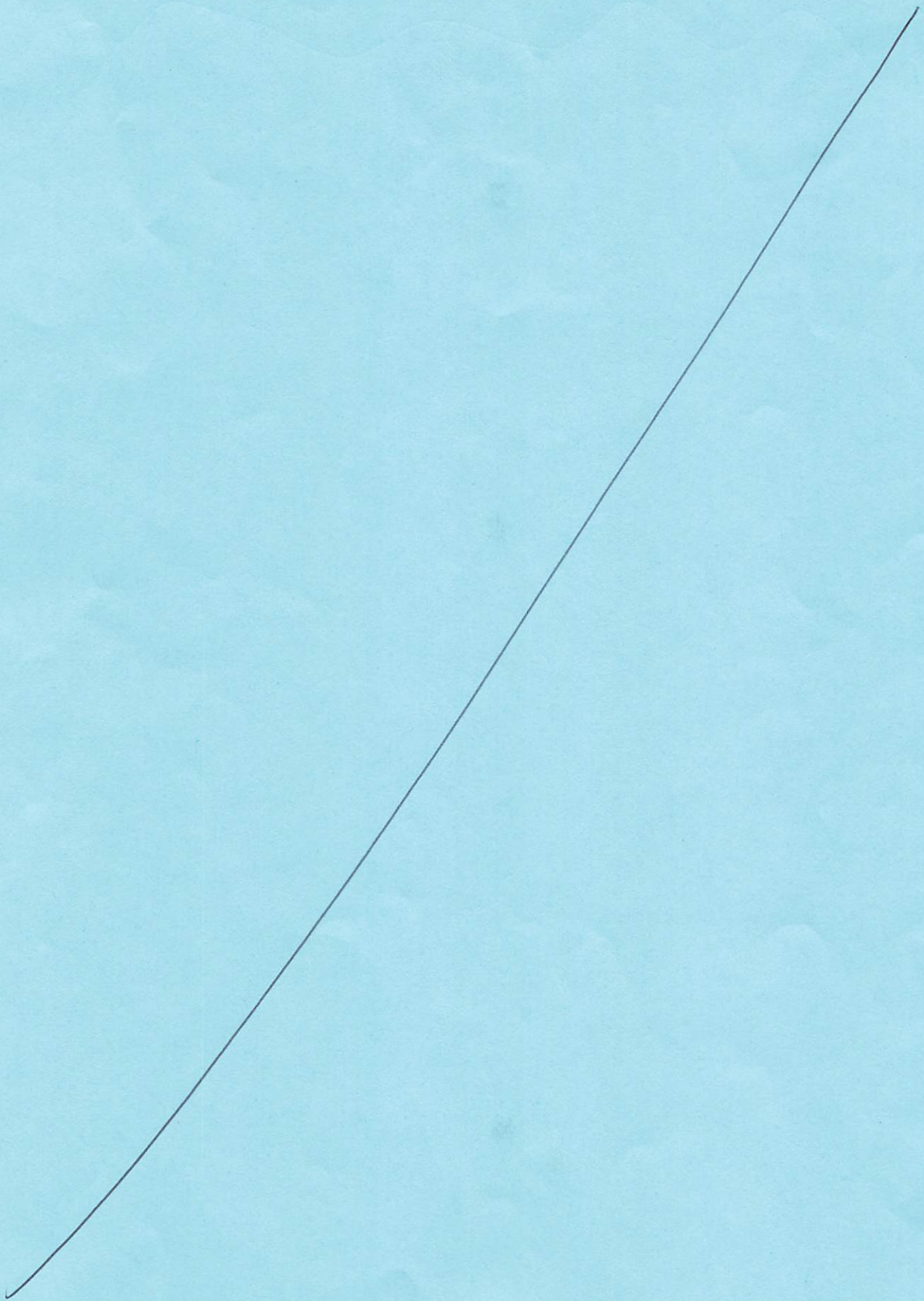
9. John MCCORT was born on 8 Aug 1856 in Potsdam, St.Lawrence Co., NY. He died on 11 Feb 1936 in Carrollton, OH. He was buried on 13 Feb 1936 in Grandview Cem., Carrollton, OH. John graduated from the college at Harlem Springs and taught school in Harlem Springs and various other rural schools for several years. He later engaged in farming and stock buying and also engaged in the mercantile business in Scio and Carrollton. John McCort served as Infirmary Director in Carrollton for five years. After Eliza died he married the widow, Mrs. Runyan, and lived in Carrollton and operated yet another store. John fathered five children of which two died in infancy.

John was married to Eliza Jane RUTLEDGE (daughter of John RUTLEDGE and Jane B. "Jennie" FAWCETT) on 14 Nov 1878 in Carroll Co., OH. Eliza Jane RUTLEDGE was born on 5 May 1859 in Union Twp., Carroll Co., OH. She died on 16 Jul 1914 in Harrison Twp., Carroll Co., OH. She was buried on 18 Jul 1914 in Grandview Cem., Carrollton, OH.

After Eliza died John was married to Annetta MCCORT RUNYAN on 12 Dec 1916 in Carroll Co., OH. Annetta MCCORT was born on 17 Nov 1868. She died before 1960.

10. Andrew MCCORT was born circa 1859 in Potsdam, St.Lawrence Co., NY. He died sometime after Feb 1936. His last known residence was Baden, PA. Andy was 21 in the 1880 census. Andy first lived in

### WILLIAM D. RENNIE

Frank Rennie, father of William D. Rennie, was born in France near the Rhine River on 25 December 1826. He came to America and settled on a tract of land south of Morges in Rose Township, Carroll County. Frank married Louisa Zangler on 1 April 1841, she passed away 11 November 1895 and Frank died in 1909, both are buried in St. Mary's Cemetery in Morges.

William D. Rennie was born on his father's farm in Rose Township in 1867. He married Clara M. Eckaway in St. Peter's Church, Canton, 13 January 1890. They had five daughters and a son, Eva of Canton, Florence of Canton, Beatrice of Canton, Esther Ruth and Ralph. Mrs. Clara Rennie died in 1908.

In the late 1890's William and Clara purchased property in nearby Waynesburg. After receiving Barber Schooling, Mr. Rennie opened his own shop which he continued to operate until his death in 1918. At that time the cost of a haircut was 35 cents. Patrons would relate that he would strop his razor so hard, the interior of the shop would shake. He was also an expert watch and clock repairman. In religion the Rennies were Roman Catholic and often the family would walk the three mile trek to Morges and back to attend St Mary's where they were members.

Around 1904 he built in his back yard a power house which housed a coal fired boiler which operated a generator by steam. He was the first person to have electricity in the village. When he was busy at his barber chair, the members of the family had to keep the boiler going since if the steam pressure got low the lights would dim. Also he had a public bath tub which became very popular.

William Rennie owned the second automobile in the village, it was purchased in 1908 and was named "The Old General". During the last years of his life he sold his electric plant to Laird Kennedy, then in 1921 the Ohio Power Co. purchased all electric services for Waynesburg.

William and Clara's original home, barber shop and power house were torn down about 1949. On the site was built the Mohawk Theater which at present is Cibo's Restaurant.

Mr. Rennie and his wife are both buried in St. Mary's Cemetery, Rose Township, Carroll County.
