DEATH RECORD FOR 1863

- 99 On August 20, 1863 on 13th Sunday after Trinity, Wednesday at half past 12 died Hedwig Friederike, daughter of Pastor G. Fr. H. Meiser and his wife Auguste born Herzberger. She was born August 14, 1862 and baptized September 7, 1862. She died at one year and 16 days of age. Peace be with you, beloved child. We shall see you again.
- 100 On September 13, 1863 on 15th Sunday past Trinity, died Matthes Heinrich, son of Johannes Volk and his wife Susanna born Fries. He was born September 7, 1862 and baptized September 28, 1862. His age was 1 year, 6 days.
- 101 On July 9, 1863 died Johann Georg Haus, son of Joh. Georg Haus and his wife Elisabeth born Neumann. He was born Nov. 5, 1837 at Altenstadten and was baptized soon after birth. In 1857 he emigrated to America and made his home near Galion. In the fall of 1862 it was his lot to be called to go to war and according to God's will he was never to see his home again. He was wounded in battle and died in the hospital at Vicksburg at which town he was buried. His age was 25 years, 8 months and 4 days. He was confirmed by Pastor Molly.
- 102 On August 21, 1863 died Maria Margaretha, daughter of Peter Tracht and his wife Elisabeth born Tracht. She was born August 1, 1861 and baptized 7th of September and lived to the age of 2 years and 20 days.
- 103 On October 10, 1863 died Maria Louisa, daughter of Gottlieb Scholz and his wife Anna Susanna born Bleuel. She was born April 7, 1860 and baptized May 6, 1860. She brought her life to 3 years, 6 months and 3 days.
- 104 On November 2, 1863 died Lina, daughter of Andreas Manzer and his wife Elisabeth born Müller. She was born March 1, 1861 and baptized August 17, 1862 by Pastor Baden. She reached the age of 2 years, 8 months and 1 day.
- 105 On November 10, 1863 died Luisa Littig, formerly Steiner, born Eberle. She was born July 18, 1786 at Trippstadt, Rhein-Baiern. She was married first to Heinrich Steiner on May 10, 1809. To this union one son was born. After only one year and 4 months of marriage it pleased the Lord to call her husband away. She married second Philipp Littig and they were the parents of two children. After 24 years she was widowed again and made her last years' home with her brother near Galion. She served as his housekeeper. She reached the age of 77 years, 6 months and 22 days.

- 106 On December 15, 1863 at 7 o'clock in the morning died Heinrich, son of Heinrich Bohl and his wife Felicitis born Rensch. He was born June 13, 1840. He was baptized soon after birth by Pastor Marshop and renewed his vows which were taken for him as a child at his confirmation by Pastor J. Schladermundt. He became a beloved member of the church. He became suddenly ill and after a short illness it pleased the Lord to take him. He died at the age of 23 years, 6 months and 2 days.
- 107 On December 19, 1863 died Minna, daughter of Jacob Koppe and his wife Wilhelmine born Kinkel. She was born July 23, 1863 and baptized on the day of her death by Pastor Meiser. She was 4 months and 26 days old.
- 108 On July 19, 1864 was buried Johann Jacob, son of Johann Jacob Schafer and his wife Elisabeth born Hess. He was 4 months and 20 days old.
- 109 On August 10, 1864 was buried Karl Herrmann, son of Johann Babtist Wagner and his wife Katherina born Dickmann. His age was 5 months and 19 days.
- 110 On May 1, 1864 was buried Katherina, little daughter of Georg Haus and his wife Elisabeth born Peuster. Her age was 2 years, 6 months and 3 days.

The LUTZ family migrated into Chatfield area according to the 1881 History p. 1011 and 1012 [includes the KALB family] The sketch of M. J. LUTZ merchant in Chatfield son of Michael and Savina/Sabina KALB LUTZ were native of Germany [Wuerttemberg] M. J. LUTZ married Christiana ZELLER the daughter of Frederick and Elizabeth BARDON ZELLER. The 1860 Census lists Jacob age 65 and Elizabeth ZELLER age 70 living beside them and buried in Windfall Cemetery: Jacob b. ca 1797 d. Sept. 24, 1862 65 y 8m 5d and Elizabeth ZOELLER born ca 1790 d.

Warren Lutz, descends from John George LUTZ who died in Germany and Katharina KUEGLE LUTZ who was born 27 Jan. 1796 in Beinberg Wuerttemberg located near Ebershbiehl presently known as Eberspiel Calwer Oberamt, protestant parish Altburg and d. Mar. 16, 1868 72y 1m 29d. Katharina married 2nd George SCHWAEMMLE/SCHWEMLY, where she is listed in the 1850 Census. Her son, Michael LUTZ b. 7 Feb. 1821 married Sabina Elizabetha KALB b. Mar. 24, 1829 d/o William b. Aug. 13, 1800 and d. Nov. 17, 1891 his wife: Sabina HOEGNER/HOENER HANER [see Mary Sue Ross's translations this edition] and [listed in some family stories as HAYNES]. T. John LUTZ b. Dec. 29, 1860 married Maria Elizabeth ZOELLER/ZELLER b. May 27, 1859 in Chatfield, daughter of Fredrich and Elizabeth BARDON ZELLER

Windfall Lutheran church: Linda Houyouse, records: Johann ZOLLAR b. 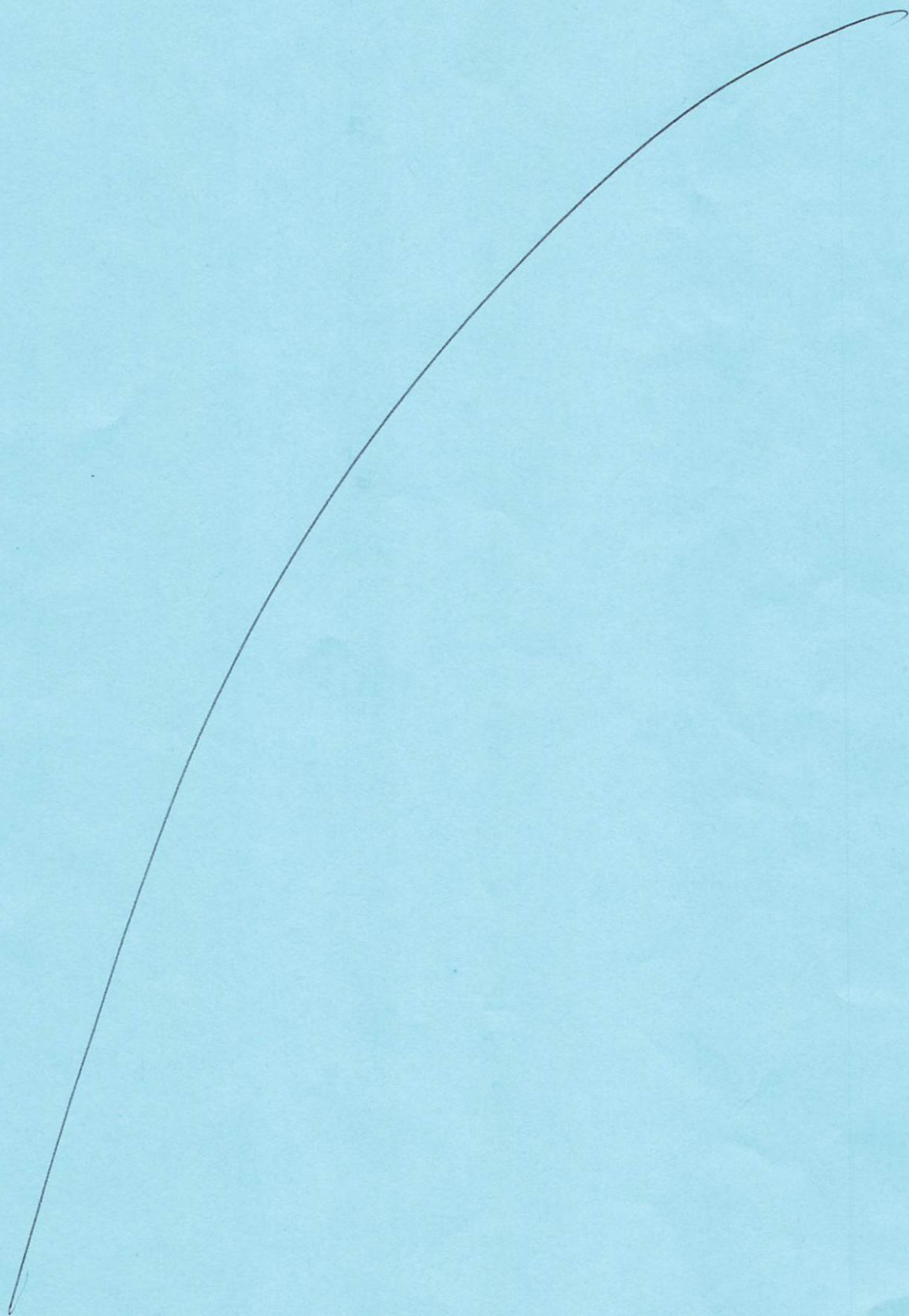

In the year of our Lord 1843 in the month of April: Rev. Jacob Neuman held a series of meetings in what was then called the Swisher School House and some 40 were converted; and fifteen or twenty united with the United Brethren Church. Among the first members were: Mrs. Mary M. SWISHER and her sons John William (his wife Rachel); and Samuel (wife Elizabeth). Samuel was the first leader of the Society. In Jan. or Feb. 1849 Nicholas James; John; and William SWISHER elected Trustees and at once procured a piece of land of Mr. SWISHER and the same year finished a neat house of worship, 30 x 40 feet with a good foundation on the aforesaid land. There is a good and growing Sabbath School here with Aaron LAUGHBAUM Superintendent and present trustees: Adam BILSING; John C. COLE; and John DEWALT. S. H. RAUDEBAUGH, Pastor, June 12, 1878.

Memories of Growing up ca 1910- One Room School

Helen Elizabeth WERT HARTUP written July 1983 from YcnanF@aol.com "When I was in the seventh grade my parents sent Ralph and me to Aunt Lib and Uncle Wilbur WERT as they were moving from Wapakoneta to Montpelier. We were to go to a One Room School, Hoot Owl, and have Uncle Jim TUTTLE for a teacher. Ralph and I walked two miles, carrying lunch pails that had such things as country-cured ham sandwiches, sometimes an egg sandwich, cookies or cake, and a jar of canned fruit. As I recall the place, Hoot Owl was the only building on a mile of road, set in thickly wooded area. But we didn't think it lonely". "Although strictly speaking I was in the 7th grade, I went up to recite with the 8th grade. Ralph went with the 5th and

6th. Lunch was always eaten hurriedly. There was always a ball game going on them and at recess. Uncle Jim played too, I don't remember any fights about decisions; he probably he made all of them. The ball, itself, was one made of bits of string someone had saved and wound into a ball {written on the side} P.S. In writing this, I've come to appreciate Jim TUTTLE more. He was an intelligent man; I can see his making that ball; the recess and noon were our physical education! Ralph tried Uncle Jim out to see what the price was for whistling on an ink bottle. It turned out to be a good shaking-up. My stomach churned all the while this was going on because I thought Ralph ought to be on his good behavior if he was going to school to his uncle. The school was a good experience as far as my education was concerned. There was awhile when we cut across fields instead of going by road; we saw them boiling down sap for maple syrup in SPITTER's woods".

[Tracking Volume 28, Issue #10 p. 152 gave a report from the Telegraph Forum newspaper regarding Middletown and this is a follow up.]

[During the November meeting Marjorie Keefer shared the pictures and story for her friend Nancy Naucke. The Kunkle family of Middletown, and the restoration of the marker in Middletown cemetery north of Galion. R. J. Kunkle was in charge of the project, and is the brother of Nancy. The stone was completely dismantled and required a scaffolding to attach the top! The cost was \$940.00 to restore the stone with a base of 400 lbs, the 2nd stone 200 lbs, the 3rd stone with inscriptions 500 lbs and top stone 60 lbs. Only 60% of inscriptions were legible so Nancy and R.J. with the magic of a blue/white sheet, dollar bill and tennis ball accomplished the lifting of the verses. (The monument guy showed them how, and by trial and error again and again they have 98% of the script. The monument is waterproofed with a transparent coating and should be 'clear coated' every five years. HATS OFF TO R.J. KUNKLE AND

Historical Society the Kunkel Report p. 34 Apr. 25, 1835 George DIETZ DICE and wife Sally: to Charles KUNKLE of Richland Co. OH for \$300: 80 acres in Sandusky Twp. Richland Co. OH] this would now be Crawford Co. OH. In fact the township lines moved so he was listed in Jackson Twp., but in 1880 it was Jefferson Twp. He owned 75 acres located at the northeast corner of North Market St. Road and Brandt Road north of Galion. PTSE1/4 - S19 T20 R20.

Charles married Elizabeth DOME in Richland Co. OH 7 April 1836 - ch: Charles C.; Nancy; Sarah A.; Joseph Wallace; Daniel T; Samuel Elias; Leah Ann E.; Mary C.; William A.; Elizabeth Ellen; Jacob Arkasson; and Dellah J. The family was listed in the Crawford County Ohio 1850 - 60 - 70 - 80 Census. Charles was a communicant of the First Lutheran Church in Galion in 1844. He died Sept. 4, 1883, burial listed above. Will filed in Volume 3, p. 575 file #48 in Crawford County Courthouse.

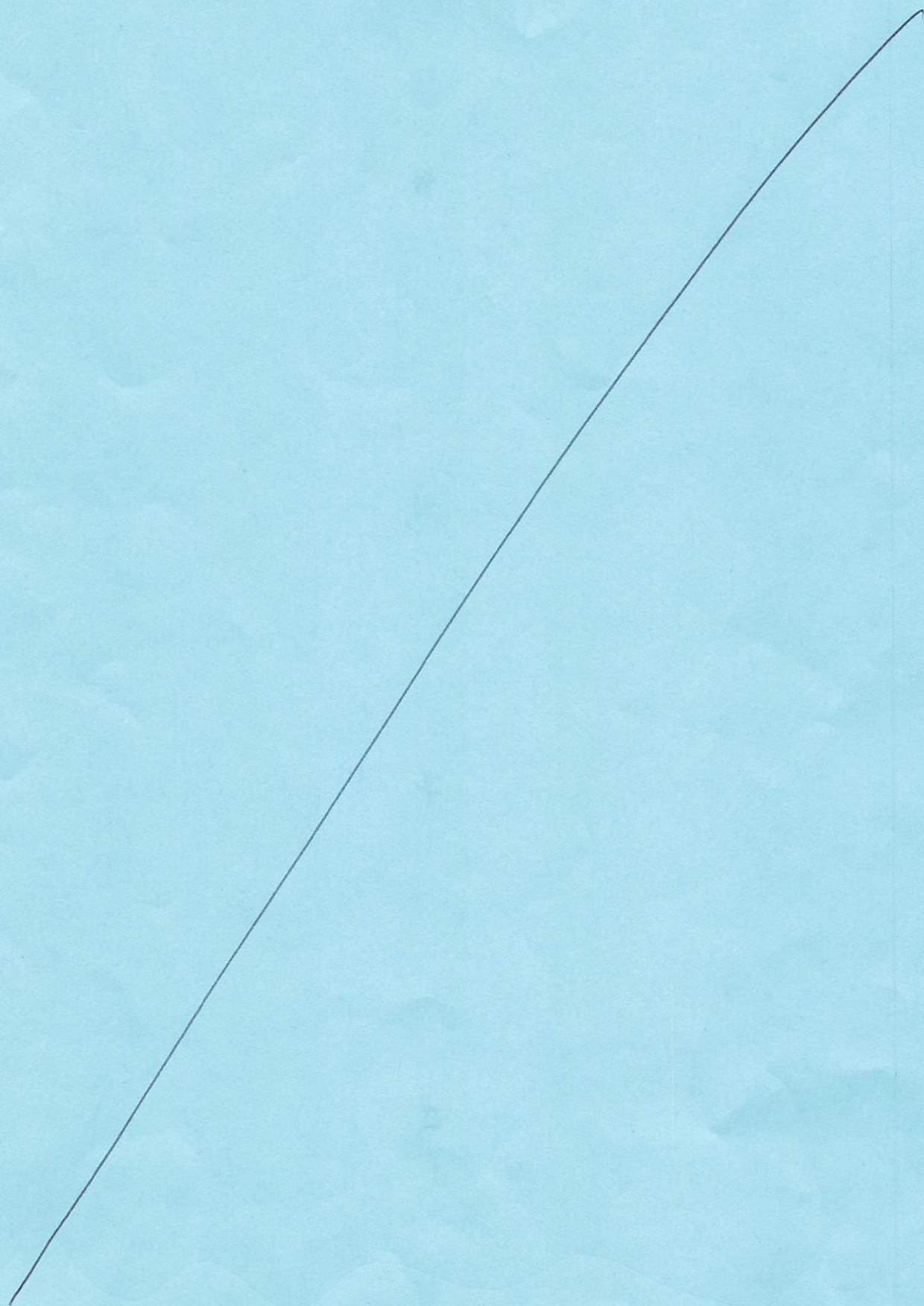
Elizabeth DOME born 21 Nov. 1820 in PA was a homemaker and died 1 Oct 1885 buried in Middletown. In 1880 Census she was living with here husband, daughter, son in law and Franklin DECKER in Jefferson Twp. She was listed as a member in 1831 in the first recorded communion of what is now the First Lutheran Church in Galion on June 23, 1833 and is again listed April 23, 1837. Sept. 26, 1845 she signed the constitution of the wholly English Lutheran (First Lutheran) church of Galion. Reference First Lutheran 1831-1931.

1881 History of Crawford County Ohio page 642 Charles KUNKLE settled in 1835 and it was reported to relieve the monotony of every day life and toil; social gatherings were often held in the rude homes of the pioneers. When the darkness of evening set in, the floor would be cleared and the tuning of the fiddles gave warning of what was to follow. Many a merry set was danced on the rough puncheon floor of the primitive cabins, and a feeling of greater and more genuine pleasure prevailed than in common now at our modern parties. Corn huskings and log-rollings usually wound up with a merry dance in the evening.

The village was laid out by Henry HERSHNER who opened the first store succeeded by his son John. Washington MODIE opened a blacksmith shop and Jacob HERSHNER a cabinet maker followed his trade, both with great success. For a while it seemed as if there would be quite a village, but gradually it went down, its mechanics left for better towns and now not a business house is in operation.

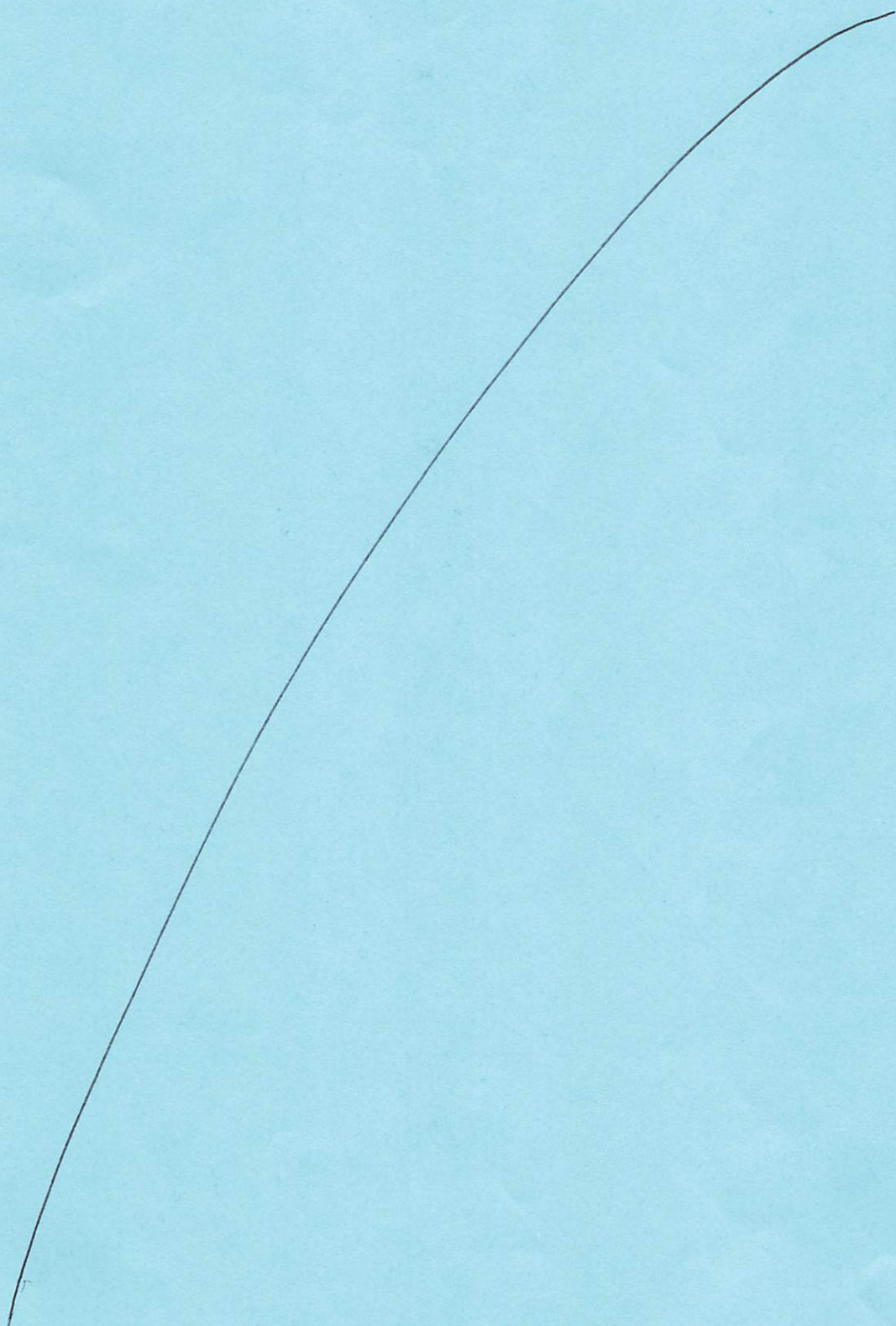

THE WEEKLY REVIEW (Galion, Ohio) Thursday, April 26, 1866 DIED: At his residence, at this place, on Tuesday, Apr. 24th 1866, of consumption, JAMES W. GILL. Funeral services will be held at the M.E. Church, at 2 o'clock this afternoon.

Thursday, May 8, 1866 OBITUARY: JAMES W. GILL was born September 22, 1823, and had he lived till next fall, would have been *forty-three years old*. A log cabin that stood just over the creek, north of town, was his humble birth place. As boy and man, he lived to see the wilderness of forty years ago, change by degrees to our present flourishing town, with its many neat and elegant mansions, its tasteful churches, to which he cheerfully contributed—its depots of trade and shops of business. Active and enterprising, he formed a large circle of acquaintances and was widely known and respected for his public spirit, his frank openheartedness and his honest upright dealings. His mind naturally strong was improved by reading. His memory was retentive, and he was therefore well posted in the events of the times. His patriotism was a marked feature of his character. Though in declining health at the beginning of the late war, yet he took a profound interest in the struggle and expressed the strongest desire to live to see the overthrow of the rebellion and the triumph of the Union, and in this respect, he was gratified. Frank, courteous and warm-hearted, he was an agreeable companion and had warm friends. As a husband, he was devoted and affectionate—as a father, fond and indulgent. He had a heart to sympathize with the afflicted and unfortunate. Though not without his errors, yet he admired what was noble, venerated what was good, and was always ready to acknowledge his errors.

Some four or five years ago, it is well known, he became deeply concerned religiously, and united with the Methodist Episcopal Church, a probationer, but he never professed that change of heart which renders religious duties pleasant—consequently he shrank from them. But as the shadow of death threw its warning over his pathway, he became more serious and thoughtful. Though reluctant to say much, yet to a few he unbosomed his inmost feelings. Some six weeks ago, at his own request, unsuggested by any one he dedicated himself to God in holy baptism, and deep was his emotion as we prayed that he might be baptized with the Holy Ghost. His desire to live was strong—not only for the benefit of his family, but to enjoy life in this world. A desire to live for the good of others, is laudable, nor do we blame any one for wishing longer to enjoy the blessings of this world, even tho' well assured of happiness in the world to come. *L.B. Daniel Riblet from a correspondence to the *Bucyrus Journal*, from this place: His illness was protracted and severe. He died of chronic inflammation of the stomach. For the last ten days he suffered a great deal. Mr. Riblet was born in Hamburg, in the county of Berks, and state of Pennsylvania, on the 16th of September, 1794, and was seventy-two years, one month and twenty-one days old at his death. He joined the German Lutheran Church at the age of seventeen. He was warmly attached to the doctrines of that church, lived in strict conformity to its discipline and died in its faith. He was married in 1815. He lived 51 years in the fullest enjoyment of the love, confidence and respect of a devoted wife and family.
